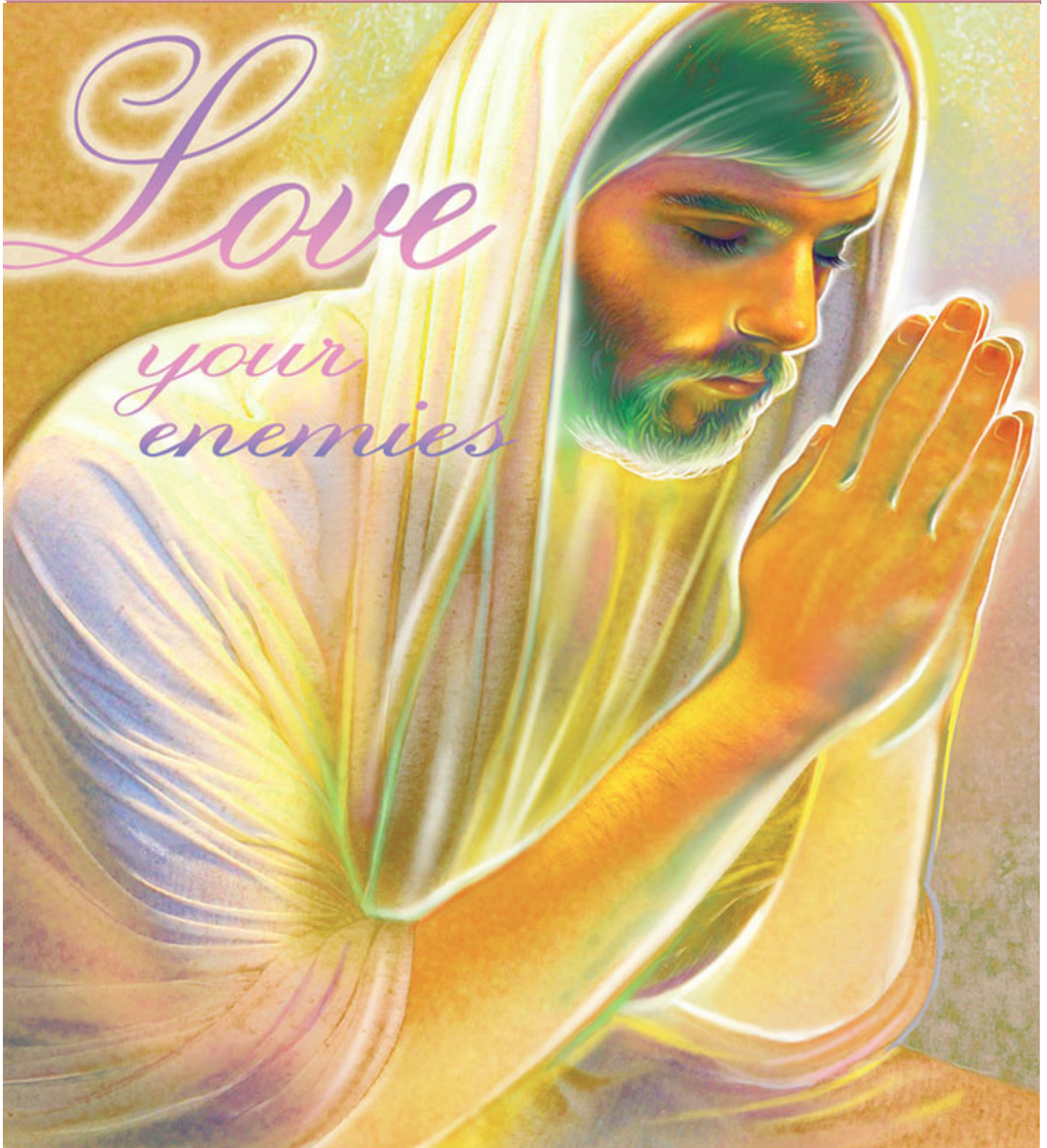

FEBRUARY 25, 2017**

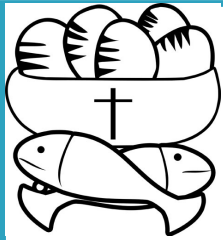

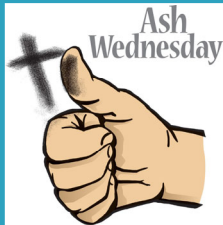


LENT

Fast & Abstinence

you are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during the Lenten season which begins on

March 1st, Ash Wednesday. Good Friday is a day of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 are permitted 1 full meal and 2 lesser meals per day (which together should not equal 1 full meal) with no eating between meals. **All Friday's of Lent** are days of Abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely.

Liturgical Corner

When did the sign of the cross originate?

The sign of the cross is a very ancient practice. There is no direct indication of it in Scripture, but St. Basil the Great in the fourth century said that we learned the sign from the time of the apostles (91st Canon of St. Basil). Some scholars interpret St. Paul's saying that he bears the marks of Christ on his body, as his referring to the sign of the cross, " **for I bear on my body the brand-marks of Jesus. (Gal 6:17)**" The sign of the cross is certainly one of the most recognizable gestures by Christians today.
