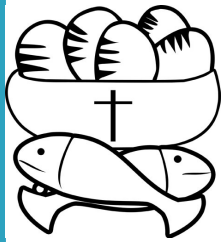

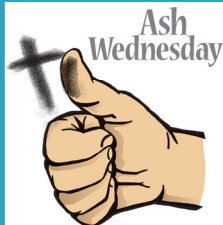


## LENT

**March 1<sup>st</sup>, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are days of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 are permitted 1 full meal and 2 lesser meals per day (which together should not equal 1 full meal) with no eating between meals. **All Friday's of Lent** are days of Abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely.

## Liturgical Corner

### When did the sign of the cross originate?

The sign of the cross is a very ancient practice. There is no direct indication of it in Scripture, but St. Basil the Great in the fourth century said that we learned the sign from the time of the apostles (91st Canon of St. Basil). Some scholars interpret St. Paul's saying that he bears the marks of Christ on his body, as his referring to the sign of the cross, " .... for I bear on my body the brand-marks of Jesus. (Gal 6:17)" The sign of the cross is certainly one of the most recognizable gestures by Christians today.

## DALMA WITH SPINACH


### VEGETABLE STEW

- 1 c water
- 1½ c pigeon peas or black eyed peas, cooked
- 1 c pumpkin or butternut squash, cubed
- ½ c potatoes, cubed
- ¼ tsp salt
- 1/3 tsp turmeric
- 1 tbs fair trade olive oil
- 3 dry red chilis, broken into bits
- 1 tsp cumin seeds
- ½ c tomatoes, chopped
- 3 c spinach, chopped
- ½ tsp cumin
- ¼ tsp chili powder

Mix pigeon or black eyed peas, pumpkin, potatoes, salt and turmeric in a pan with water. Cook until vegetables are soft—about 15 minutes—and set aside. In a separate pan, heat oil. To the oil, add chilis, cumin seeds and tomatoes. Fry until tomatoes are soft. Add spinach and stir until soft. Combine both mixtures, adding cumin and chili powder (if a spicy dish is desired) and simmer for 2 minutes.

Serve hot over rice.

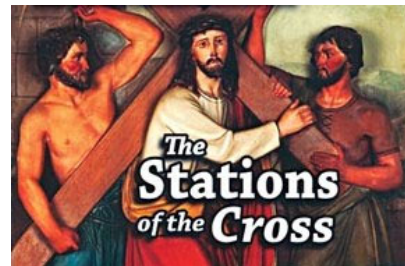
