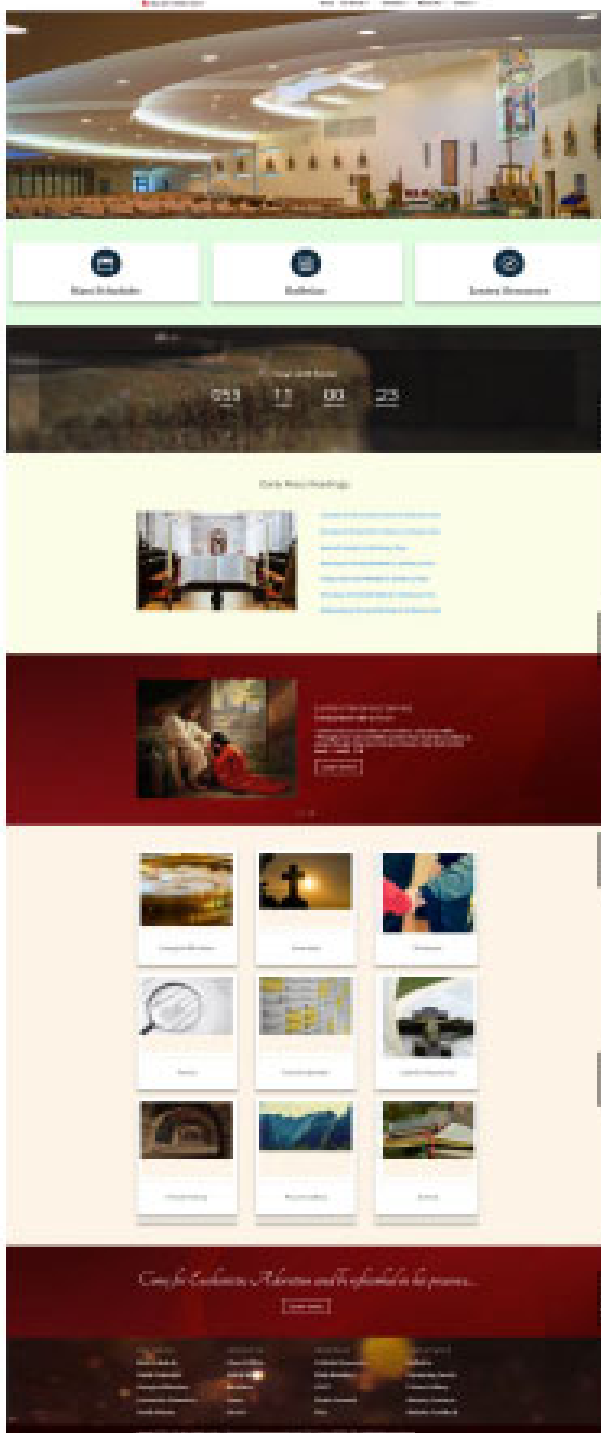
I believe this process is extremely important and I encourage each and every parish family to participate. Your input is invaluable as we plan the future of Holy Spirit Parish.

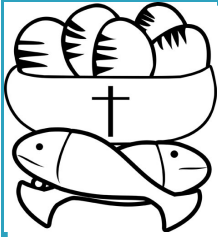

Fast & Abstinence

you are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during the Lenten season which begins on

March 1st, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 are permitted 1 full meal and 2 lesser meals per day (which together should not equal 1 full meal) with no eating between meals. **All Friday's of Lent** are days of Abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely.

- 1 T fair trade olive oil
- 1 garlic clove, diced
- 3 tomatoes, chopped
- ½ onion, chopped
- 4 c vegetable broth
- 1 c peas
- 2 carrots, chopped
- 1 chili pepper, chopped
- Salt to taste

Add oil to a large pan on low heat. Add rice and toast until golden. Add garlic, tomatoes and onion; cook until mixture is soft. Add the broth, peas, carrots, chili pepper and salt. When it begins to boil, reduce the heat and cover until rice is fully cooked.

Liturgical Corner

Why do we call priests "Father"?

Bishops, who are the shepherds of the local Church community and the authentic teachers of the faith, were given the title "Father." Actually, until about the year 400, a bishop was called "papa" for Father; this title was then restricted solely to addressing the Bishop of Rome, the successor of St. Peter, and in English was rendered "pope." Later, in the Middle Ages, the term "father" was used to address the mendicant friars - like the Franciscans and Dominicans - since by their preaching, teaching and charitable works they cared for the spiritual and physical needs of all of God's children just as a father cares for his own family. Our priests are always mindful of the "physical" needs of his flock - food, housing, clothing and education. In the English-speaking world, addressing all priests as "Father" has become customary. Please remember to pray for our priests, especially those that serve in our own parishes, that by God's grace they may strive to fulfill the responsibility of being "Father."
