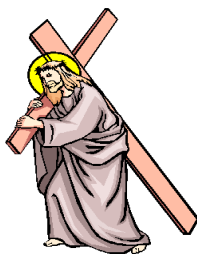

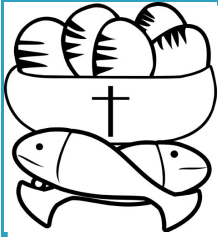

### Fast & Abstinence

you are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during the Lenten season. **Good Friday** is a day of fasting and abstinence. Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 are permitted 1 full meal and 2 lesser meals per day (which together should not equal 1 full meal) with no eating between meals. **All Friday's of Lent** are days of Abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely.

## Lenten Recipe Corner



### BEAN CAKES

- 1 can black-eyed peas, drained
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 2 carrots, peeled & chopped
- 1 egg, whisked
- ½ tsp salt
- ½ tsp black pepper
- 1 cup flour
- ¼ cup olive oil

Place black-eyed peas in a blender with the onion, carrots, and egg. Blend to a smooth paste and add salt and pepper. If bean mixture has too much liquid to form balls, then add a ¼ cup of flour to thicken. Shape mixture into 2 inch balls and roll in flour. Pat into flat discs and fry in vegetable oil until golden (about 5-7 minutes), turning occasionally.

Serve with rice, steamed vegetables or noodles. *Makes 4 servings.*

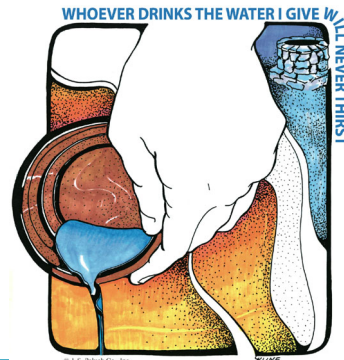

## Liturgical Corner

### Why don't we sing the "Alleluia" during Lent?

The "Alleluia" and also the "Gloria" for that matter are both joyful chants, with Alleluia being the primary chant of the Easter Season - "He is risen, Alleluia." However, because Lent is a penitential period, we express sorrow for the sin that put Jesus on the Cross. Therefore, instead of the joyful Alleluia, we sing an alternative hymn which still recognizes Jesus as Lord. Also, remember that during Lent, we are to prepare our hearts through Pray, Fasting, and Alms-giving so that we may resume the Alleluia on Easter Sunday.

During Lent, we also omit the "Gloria," again because it is a joyful hymn.
