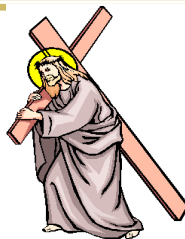

Why don't we sing the "Alleluia" during Lent?

The "Alleluia" and also the "Gloria" for that matter are both joyful chants, with Alleluia being the primary chant of the Easter Season - "He is risen,

Alleluia." However, because Lent is a penitential period, we express sorrow for the sin that put Jesus on the Cross. Therefore, instead of the joyful

Alleluia, we sing an alternative hymn which still recognizes Jesus as Lord. Also, remember that during Lent, we are to prepare our hearts through Pray, Fasting, and Alms-giving so that we may resume the Alleluia on Easter Sunday.

During Lent, we also omit the "Gloria," again because it is a joyful hymn.

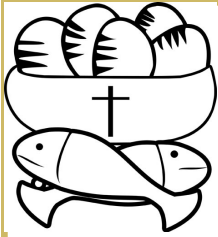

Fast & Abstinence

you are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during the Lenten season. **Good Friday** is a day of fasting and abstinence. Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 are permitted 1 full meal and 2 lesser meals per day (which together should not equal 1 full meal) with no eating between meals. **All Friday's of Lent** are days of Abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely.

Lenten Recipe Corner

Classic Minestrone



- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 onion, sliced
- 2 carrots, chopped
- 1 zucchini, thinly sliced
- 4 ounces green beans, cut into 1 inch pieces
- 2 stalks celery, thinly sliced
- 1 1/2 quarts vegetable stock
- 1 can chopped tomatoes
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh thyme
- 1 can small kidney beans
- 1 (15 ounce) can cannellini beans, with liquid
- 1/4 cup elbow macaroni
- salt and ground black pepper to taste

Directions

- 1 Heat olive oil in a large saucepan, over medium heat. Add leek, kidney beans, carrots, zucchini, green beans and celery. Cover, and reduce heat to low. Cook for 15 minutes, shaking the pan occasionally.
- 2 Stir in the stock, tomatoes and thyme. Bring to a boil, then replace the lid, and reduce heat to low; simmer gently for 30 minutes.
- 3 Stir in the cannellini beans with liquid and pasta. Simmer for an additional 10 minutes, or until pasta is al dente. Season with salt and pepper to taste before serving.
