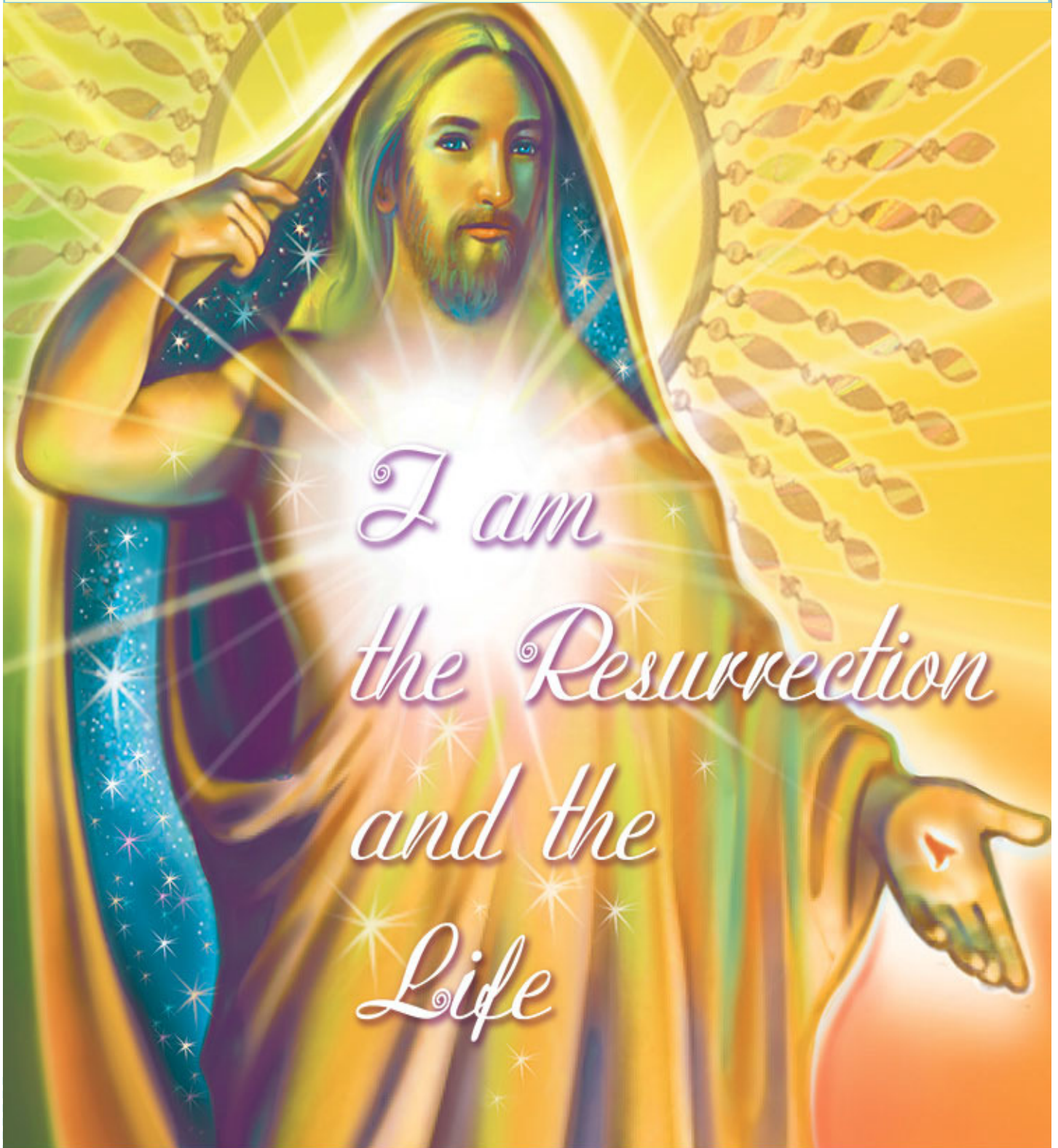

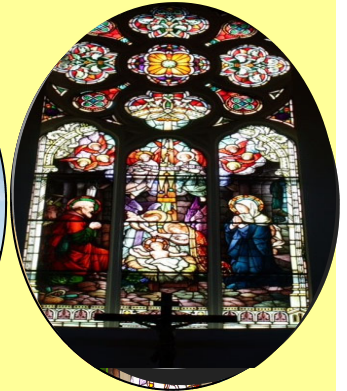

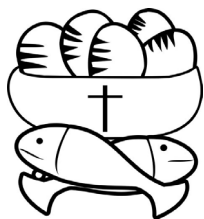

LENT

Fast & Abstinence
 you are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during the Lenten season. **Good Friday** is a day of fasting and abstinence. Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 are permitted 1 full meal and 2 lesser meals per day(which together should not equal 1 full meal) with no eating between meals. **All Friday's of Lent** are days of Abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely.

Lenten Recipe Corner
STUFFED SHELL PIEROGIES



3 lbs potatoes (about 8) peeled & quartered
 8 oz shredded Cheddar cheese (2 cups)
 1 tsp salt
 1/2 tsp pepper
 6 cups sliced onions (Vidalia, if you can get them)
 Butter or margarine (I use lots)
 1 box jumbo shells, cooked until tender-firm and cooled under running cold water.
 Cooks potatoes until soft, drain. Add cheese, salt & pepper and mash until smooth. Melt margarine or butter in large skillet. Add onions and cook 10 to 15 minutes until tender but NOT browned. Spread half the onions over the bottom of a 13x9 baking dish. (May take 2 pans)

Stuff each shell with heaping TBL of the potato mixture, close edges. Arrange in single layer over onions, spread remaining onions on top (you can use two pans or freeze the pierogies for later use). Bake at 350 degrees uncovered 15 to 20 minutes or until heated through.

While this is not difficult, it is a multi-step recipe.
 (1) cook pasta shells (2) potato preparation and cooking (3) potato mashing (4) onion slicing and cooking (5) stuffing pasta shells (6) layering onions and shells (7) baking.

Liturgical Corner

Why do Catholics pause at the end of the Lord's Prayer for the priest to add his part and then finish?

What the priest says at the end of the Lord's Prayer is not an interruption but a prayer continuing the final sentiment of the Our Father. The *doxology*, which follows that second prayer - "For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and forever" - was never part of the Lord's Prayer. Through a miss-translation of the Missal after the Reformation in England, the "Deliver us O Lord..." prayer was omitted, and the *doxology* was put adjacent to the Lord's Prayer. Over the course of time, it morphed into being part of the prayer, and also is the common usage in many of the Protestant and Evangelical churches.

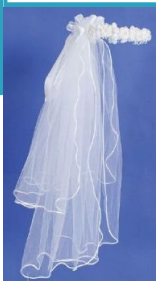

A letter to the youth of the world released on January 13, Pope Francis asked young people to tell him, their bishops and pastors about their hopes and struggles and even their criticisms. In preparation for a meeting of the Synod of Bishops focused on youth, the pope wants “to listen to your voice, your sensitivities and your faith, even your doubts and your criticism.

“Make your voice heard,” the pope told young people. “Let it resonate in communities and let it be heard by your shepherds of souls.”

Before the synod convenes in October 2018, Pope Francis also released a preparatory document for the synod. The document contains preliminary questions to be answered by national conferences of bishops and other church bodies. The responses, along with input from young people themselves, will form the basis of the synod’s working document.

Bishop Felipe Estévez has formed a committee in preparation of the synod that will study the preparatory document. The committee will conduct formal and informal surveys of young people (ages 16-29) and others between now and mid-April. Youth and young adults (ages 16-39) – Catholic and non-Catholic alike – as well as mentors of youth, such as DRE’s and youth ministers, are encouraged to take the survey.
