



### Liturgical Corner

How many readings should be proclaimed at the Easter Vigil?

One of the unique aspects of the Easter Vigil is the recounting of the outstanding deeds of the history of salvation. These deeds are related in seven readings from the Old Testament chosen from the law and the prophets and two more readings from the New Testament, namely from St. Paul's epistles and from the Gospels.

Thus, the Lord meets us once again on our journey and, “beginning with Moses and all the prophets” (Lk 24:27) opens up our minds and hearts, preparing us to share in the breaking of the bread and the drinking of the cup. The faithful are encouraged to meditate on these readings by the singing of a responsorial psalm, followed by a silent pause, and then by the celebrant’s prayer. Meditation on these readings is so significant for this night that we are strongly urged to use all the readings whenever it can be done. Only in the case of grave pastoral circumstances can the number of readings be reduced. In such cases, at least

**Fiscal Mid-Year Report**


We thank our Pastor Fr. Anthony Bonela and the Holy Spirit Parish Community for all the support that we have received since our last report.

We were blessed with donations that we want to acknowledge: The St. Vincent DePaul, St. Augustine conference for their \$4,500.00 donation, The Men’s Club, the children’s monthly collections, and school children’s donations. We applied for and received a grant of \$24,200.00 to purchase a 2017 Ford Van. We are also grateful to The Wa Wa Foundation for their \$500.00 grant to feed the poor.

**We received a totaled of \$7,864.00 from your donations from the four blue poor boxes at the entrances of the church and \$906.00 from our St. Vincent DePaul Members. With your donations, and others we were able to provided \$11,452.00 in assistance to 33 families:**

- Rental assistance to prevent eviction: **18 families**
- JEA payment to prevent disconnection: **12 families**
- Purchased a bicycle to get to work: **1 family**
- Clothes and furniture or other: **1 family**
- Provided 55 bags of food: **62 people**

When we visit the families, we listen to them, give support and advice, and they are always grateful to **The Holy Spirit Church**. They are tired and you give them comfort and a place to rest, they are hungry and you feed them, but most important you give them hope.




