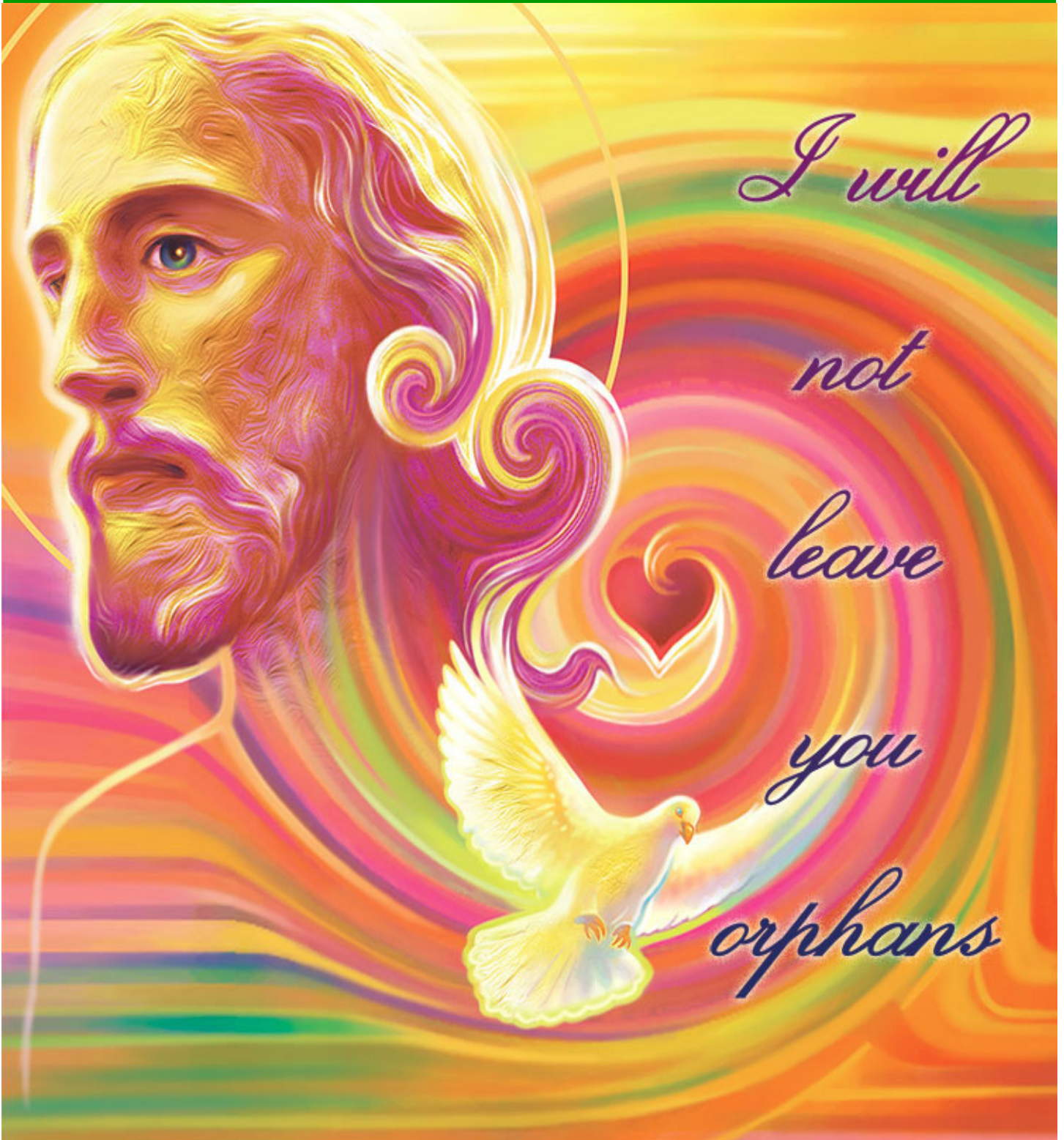

#### CHAPTER I.

#### THE FORMATION OF CLERICS

**Can. 234 §2.** Unless in certain cases circumstances indicate otherwise, young men disposed to the priesthood are to be provided with that formation in the humanities and science by which the youth in their own region are prepared to pursue higher studies.

**Can. 235 §1.** Young men who intend to enter the priesthood are to be provided with a suitable spiritual formation and prepared for their proper duties in a major seminary throughout the entire time of formation or, if in the judgment of the diocesan bishop circumstances demand it, for at least four years.

In the United States, priests must have a four-year university degree plus an additional four to five years of graduate-level seminary formation in theology. Studies would include a sizable portion of dogmatics, church history, sacramental theology, liturgical theology, spiritual theology, canon law, and scripture. Some theologates insert a year of pastoral work in the middle of their studies. After completion of a Master's degree (and many priests hold several Master's degrees), priests may undertake doctoral study. While completion of a doctorate it is not a prerequisite for priesthood, it is common for many priests to hold a PhD.

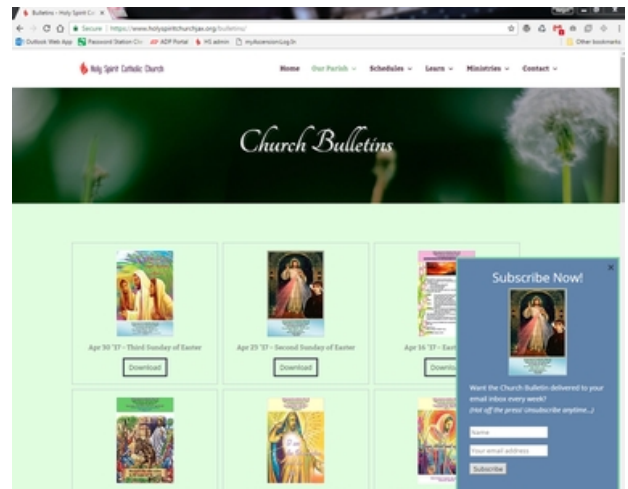
