



**\*\*\*The Senior Citizen Special\*\*\***

Those who have reached 70 1/2 and have an IRA, can reduce their taxable income by contributing to the Family Life Center Campaign. Once you are 70 1/2 you must start taking what the IRS calls Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) from your standard IRA or pay a penalty. The money you withdraw is taxed as ordinary income. BUT, if you donate any of that money directly to a recognized charity (such as Holy Spirit Parish) you do not pay any tax on that amount. Think of it as a way of giving that saves you from 15-35% or as a way to increase your pledge by 15-35% at

**no extra cost to you!**







**Liturgical Corner**

**THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD**

The reality of Christ's Ascension is so important that the creeds, our basic statements of belief reaffirm this reality. In the words of the Apostles' Creed, "He ascended into heaven, sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead." And in the words of the Nicene Creed "He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end." The denial of the Ascension is as grave a departure from Christian teaching as is denial of Christ's Resurrection.

Christ's bodily Ascension foreshadows our own entrance into Heaven not simply as souls after our death, but as glorified bodies after the resurrection of the dead at the Final Judgment. In redeeming mankind, Christ not only offered salvation to our souls but began the restoration of the material world itself to the glory that God intended before Adam's fall.

The Feast of the Ascension marks the beginning of the first novena, or nine days of prayer. Before His Ascension, Christ promised to send the Holy Spirit to His apostles. Their prayer for the coming of the Holy Spirit, which began on Ascension Thursday, ended with the descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday, ten days later.

Today, we recall the first novena by praying the Novena to the Holy Ghost between Ascension and Pentecost, asking for the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit.




