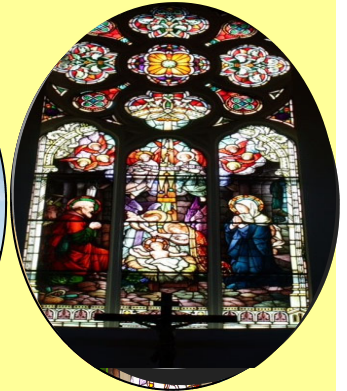

Rev. Fr. Amar Nath Nagothu was born on 28th June 1982 to Bala Swamy and Albina. He hails from Fatima Nagar Parish of the Catholic Diocese of Warangal, Telangana, India. He was baptized on 12th July 1982 and was confirmed on 13th July 1995.

After having completed his Secondary education at Saint Gabriel's High School, he joined the M.S.F.S. Minor Seminary, Nidadavole, in June 1997 where he did his minor seminary course and his Higher Secondary Education. He joined the Novitiate (Salesianum, Visakhapatnam) in June 2000 and made his First Religious Profession on 10th June 2001. He did his philosophy and B. A. at Suvidya College, Bangalore from June 2001 to May 2004 and his regency at Fransalian Vidya Jyothi (MSFS Minor Seminary), Nidadavole, from June 2004 to May 2005. He did his theology at Vijnana Nilayam by staying at S.F.S. Study House, Janampet, Eluru, from June 2005 to November 2008. He made his Perpetual Profession on 14th June 2007, ordained a Deacon on 20th January 2008, did his diaconate ministry at Christ the King Church, Mangalapalem, Visakhapatnam, from December 2008 till his Ordination and was ordained a Priest on 20th April 2009 by Most Rev. Dr. Thumma Bala, Bishop of Warangal at Thimmaraopet Pet, Warangal.

After his ordination, he was appointed to the MSFS community at Medipally for pastoral experience and to be administrator of SFS school from 1st June 2009 to 31st May 2010, after which he was transferred to Fransalian Vidya Jyothi, as Vocation Director and to teach in the SFS Junior College, where he rendered his services in the minor seminary and College from 1st June 2010 to 31st May 2011. From 1st June 2011 to 4th September 2012 he was teaching in the St. Aloysius High School, Visakhapatnam. From 6th September 2012 to 20th February 2014 he was Parochial Vicar at Christ the King Parish, Arlington, Jacksonville and then was appointed as pastor of Saint Monica, Palatka from 21st February 2014 to 30th June 2017.

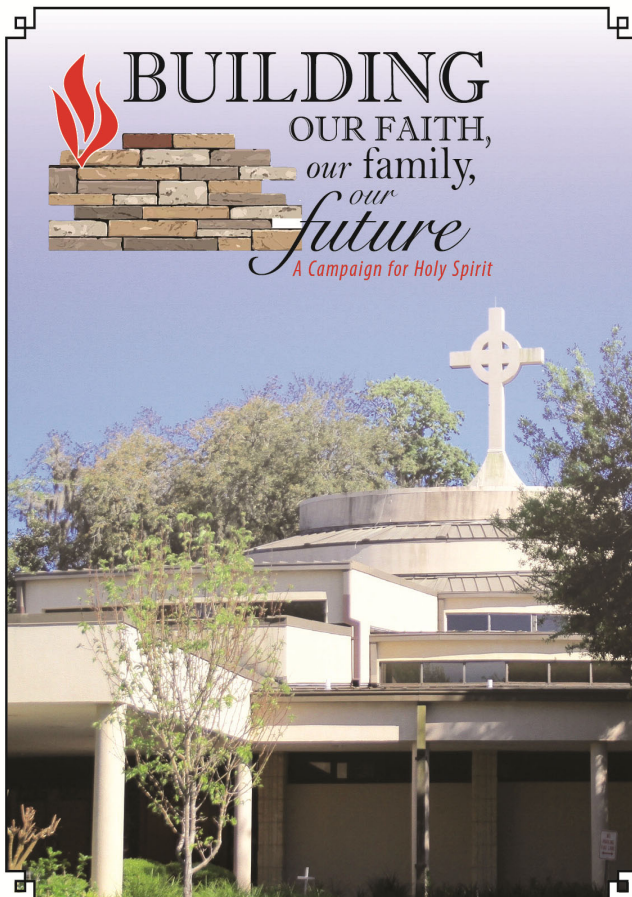
Now, as I go, I am reminded and proud to have a bigger and loving family. You were always there anytime to support me and to show me your love.

Those who have reached 70 1/2 and have an IRA, can reduce their taxable income by contributing to the Family Life Center Campaign. Once you are 70 1/2 you must start taking what the IRS calls Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) from your standard IRA or pay a penalty. The money you withdraw is taxed as ordinary income. BUT, if you donate any of that money directly to a recognized charity (such as Holy Spirit Parish) you do not pay any tax on that amount. Think of it as a way of giving that saves you from 15-35% or as a way to increase your pledge by 15-35% at no extra cost to you! Scripture admonishes us to be both faithful and wise servants!

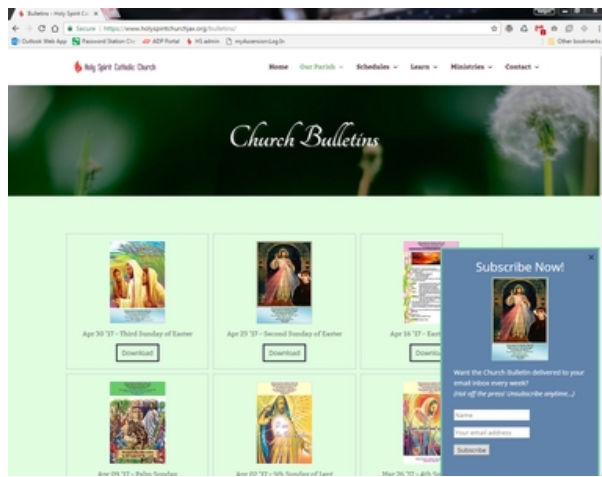

Liturgical Corner

Consubstantial With the Father

In the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed, why has "one in being with the Father" been changed to "consubstantial with the Father?"

The new translation is more in keeping with the ancient Latin text of the Creed and a more accurate translation.

The bishops at the Council of Nicea (AD 325), in order to ensure that Jesus was professed as the eternal Son of God, equal to the Father, stated that he is "the Son of God, begotten from the Father, the only-begotten, that is from the substance of the Father, God from God, light from light, true God from true God, begotten not made, the same substance (homoousion) with the Father..." The Creed of the Council of Constantinople (381), which is professed at all Sunday Masses and Solemnities within the Catholic Church, similarly stated: "We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of the same substance (homoousion) with the Father."

When these two ancient creeds were translated into Latin, the term "homoousion" was rendered as "consubstantialem," that is, "the same substance of the Father." Prior to the Second Vatican Council, the Latin "consubstantialem" was rendered as "consubstantial" within the English translation of the Creed. Many theologians and the Holy See thought that the term "consubstantial" was more in keeping with the Latin tradition and a more literal and accurate translation than the more recent "one in being."

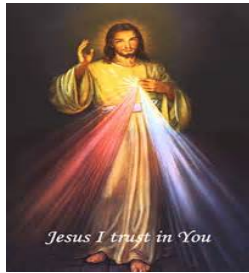
**CLOTHING & FURNITURE DRIVE

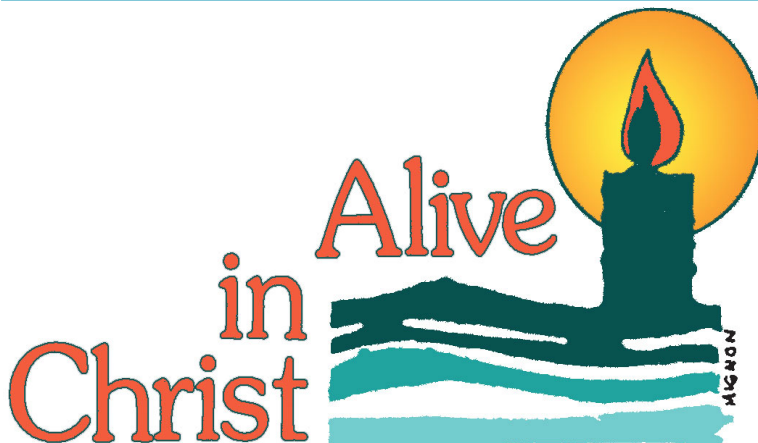
Dear Father Anthony -

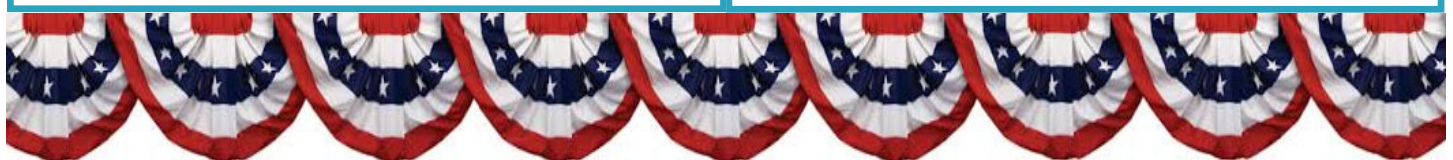

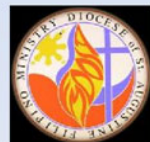
