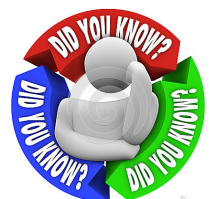


The Senior Citizen Special !

IRA

Those who have reached 70 1/2 and have an IRA, can reduce their taxable income by contributing to the Family Life Center Campaign. Once you are 70 1/2 you must start taking what the IRS calls Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) from your standard IRA or pay a penalty. The money you withdraw is taxed as ordinary income. BUT, if you donate any of that money directly to a recognized charity (such as Holy Spirit Parish) you do not pay any tax on that amount. Think of it as a way of giving that saves you from 15-35% or as a way to increase your pledge by 15-35% at no extra cost to you!

Liturgical Corner

Consubstantial With the Father

In the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed, why has "one in being with the Father" been changed to "consubstantial with the Father?"

The new translation is more in keeping with the ancient Latin text of the Creed and a more accurate translation. The bishops at the Council of Nicea (AD 325), in order to ensure that Jesus was professed as the eternal Son of God, equal to the Father, stated that he is "the Son of God, begotten from the Father, the only-begotten, that is from the substance of the Father, God from God, light from light, true God from true God, begotten not made, the same substance (homoousion) with the Father..." The Creed of the Council of Constantinople (381), which is professed at all Sunday Masses and Solemnities within the Catholic Church, similarly stated: "We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of the same substance (homoousion) with the Father."

When these two ancient creeds were translated into Latin, the term "homoousion" was rendered as "consubstantialem," that is, "the same substance of the Father." Prior to the Second Vatican Council, the Latin "consubstantialem" was rendered as "consubstantial" within the English translation of the Creed. Many theologians and the Holy See thought that the term "consubstantial" was more in keeping with the Latin tradition and a more literal and accurate translation than the more recent "one in being."

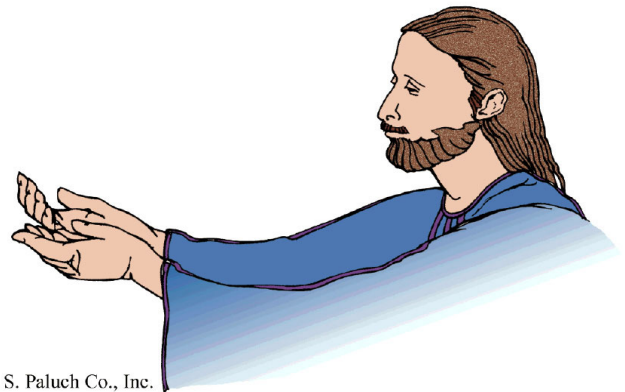
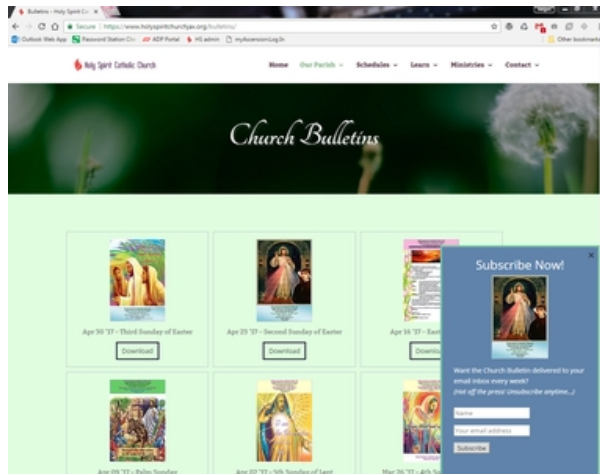

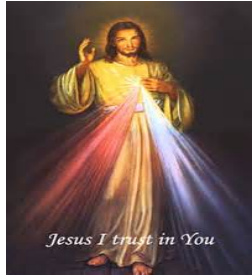
CLOTHING & FURNITURE DRIVE ST VINCENT DE PAUL

This program also applies to those 8 years and older. So, if your children are in need of their sacraments, they will need to attend.

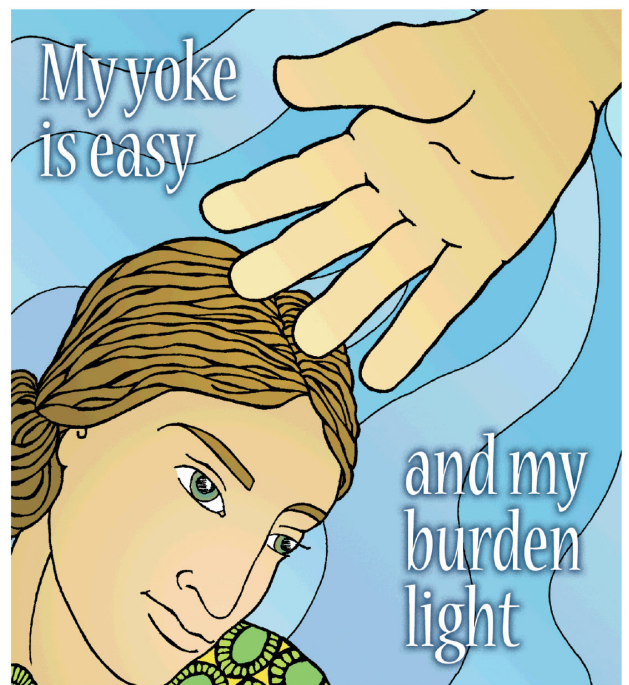

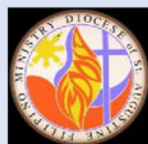
