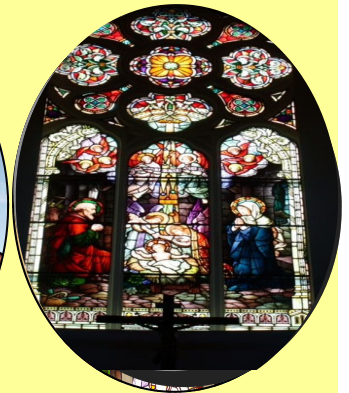

Father Amar answers your Family Life Center FAQs

Father: Why do we need a \$2 million building just to have more meeting rooms?

Dear Parishioner,

When plans for our Family Life Center were being drawn we needed to label the various rooms. Some, like the St. Vincent de Paul office were obvious; it described the specific user. The 6 adjustable size rooms had no single user so they were simply called "meeting rooms". With 20/20 hindsight perhaps we should have called them "activities rooms" since they are for all sorts of activities as well as meetings: Teen, young adult and senior activities, faith formation classes, adult catechism, prayer blanket sewing and dozens of other activities and meetings that need space for 5 to 50 people.

Don't forget that we will also have 2 dedicated ministry offices, climate controlled storage for the Knights of Columbus and St. Vincent de Paul ministry, a Grand Hall which will seat 380 complete with stage, audio-visual equipment and professional grade kitchen.

The future uses for our Family Life Center will be limited only by our imagination and enthusiasm!

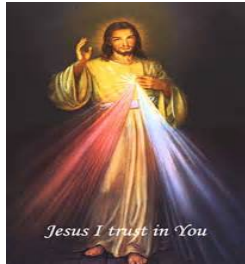

LITURGICAL CORNER

The word Parable comes from the Greek word meaning comparison, illustration, analogy. It is a short tale that illustrates a universal truth; it is a simple narrative. It sketches a setting, describes an action, and shows the results.

Jesus spoke to his many followers in parables. The parables themselves presented clear stories from everyday events that many in the gathering crowds would recognize. Jesus did not code His teachings to prevent people from understanding since all equally would understand the imagery. However, it was each followers own response to the parable which challenged the people. Those committed to the Kingdom of God would seek and find further understanding while those uncommitted would reject the parable’s meaning as unintelligible.

Out of the 46 parables in the bible, most can be found in the gospels of Luke and Mathew with a unique few, solely found in Mark and John. You are encouraged to read and reflect on these parables in such a way as to determine how they may apply to your life today. Write down the name of each parable and your reflection notes in a journal. Then from time to time, refer back to your writings to allow you an opportunity to again reflect over your thoughts.

RCIA

Is there someone in your family, among your friends or neighbors who might be interested in joining our Catholic family? Have you ever wondered -- How does one become a member of the Catholic Faith Community? **The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)** is the process through which the Catholic Church welcomes and initiates new members into its faith community. RCIA is a restored ancient Rite, after Vatican II, designed to welcome and enlighten inquirers interested in knowing more about our Catholic Way of Life. RCIA is the perfect opportunity to gradually become aware of what it means to become Catholic. RCIA involves our entire parish community through its prayer and example, as well as involving sponsors who help to introduce inquirers to the life of the Parish. RCIA is intended for adults who are not baptized, those who are baptized in another Christian denomination, as well as those who are baptized Catholic and who wish to complete their initiation through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

This program also applies to those 8 years and older. So, if your children are in need of their sacraments, they will need to attend.

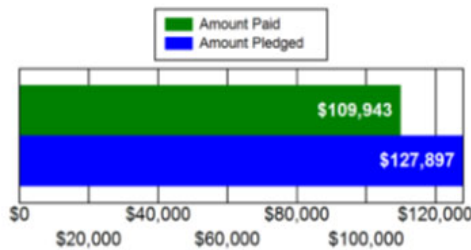
