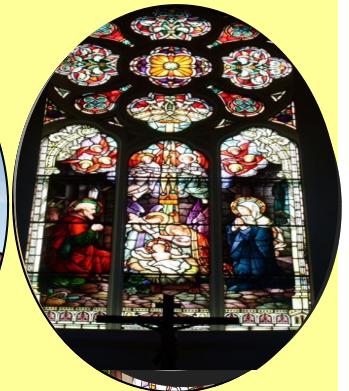

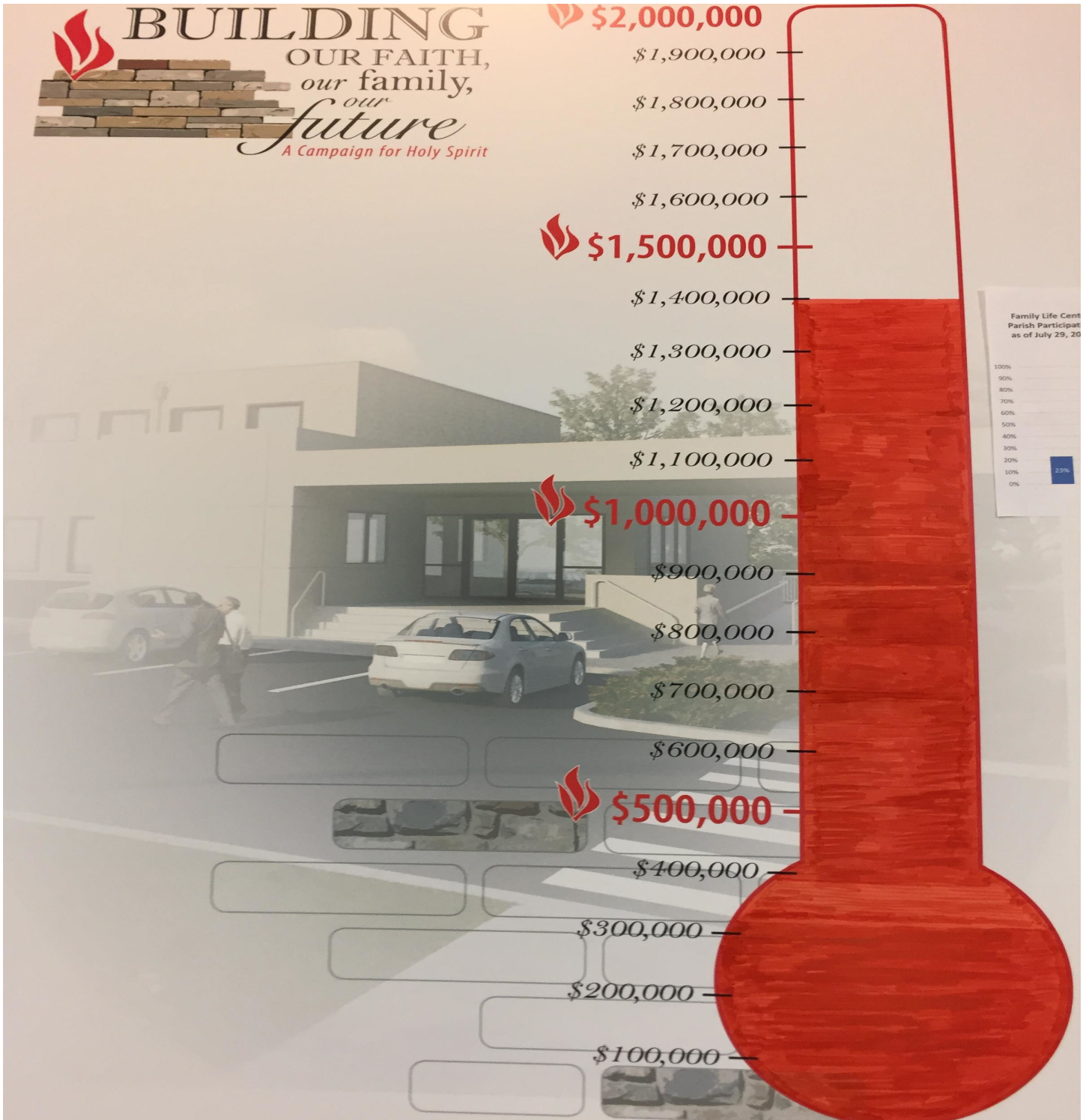
### COMMITMENT WEEKEND RESULTS

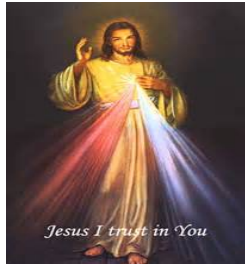

Is there someone in your family, among your friends or neighbors who might be interested in joining our Catholic family? Have you ever wondered -- How does one become a member of the Catholic Faith Community? **The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)** is the process through which the Catholic Church welcomes and initiates new members into its faith community. RCIA is a restored ancient Rite, after Vatican II, designed to welcome and enlighten inquirers interested in knowing more about our Catholic Way of Life. RCIA is the perfect opportunity to gradually become aware of what it means to become Catholic. RCIA involves our entire parish community through its prayer and example, as well as involving sponsors who help to introduce inquirers to the life of the Parish. RCIA is intended for adults who are not baptized, those who are baptized in another Christian denomination, as well as those who are baptized Catholic and who wish to complete their initiation through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

**LITURGICAL CORNER**

**Transfiguration of the Lord**

About a week after his sojourn in Caesarea Philippi, Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them to a high mountain apart, where He was transfigured before their ravished eyes. St. Matthew and St. Mark express this phenomenon by the word metamorphosis, which the Vulgate renders transfiguratus est. The Synoptics explain the true meaning of the word by adding "his face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow," according to the Vulgate, or "as light," according to the Greek text. This dazzling brightness which emanated from His whole Body was produced by an interior shining of His Divinity. False Judaism had rejected the Messiah, and now true Judaism, represented by Moses and Elias, the Law and the Prophets, recognized and adored Him, while for the second time God the Father proclaimed Him His only-begotten and well-loved Son. By this glorious manifestation the Divine Master, who had just foretold His Passion to the Apostles and who spoke with Moses and Elias of the trials which awaited Him at Jerusalem, strengthened the faith of his three friends and prepared them for the terrible struggle of which they were to be witnesses in Gethsemane, by giving them a foretaste of the glory and heavenly delights to which we attain by suffering.

**Location of the Transfiguration**

Already in Apostolic times the mount of the Transfiguration had become the "holy mount". It seems to have been known by the faithful of the country, and tradition identified it with Mount Tabor. Origen said (A.D. 231-54) "Tabor is the mountain of Galilee on which Christ was transfigured". In the next century St. Cyril of Jerusalem and St. Jerome likewise declare it categorically. Later St. Proculus, Patriarch of Constantinople, Agathangelus and Arnobius the Younger say the same thing. The testimonies increase from century to century without a single dissentient note, and in 553 the Fifth Council of Constantinople erected a see at Mount Tabor (Notitiae Antioch. . . . patriarch.).

### What is WYD?

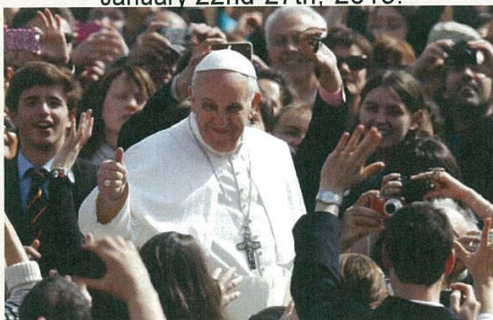
World Youth Day (WYD) is a gathering of young people from around the world to celebrate the love of Christ for humanity.
