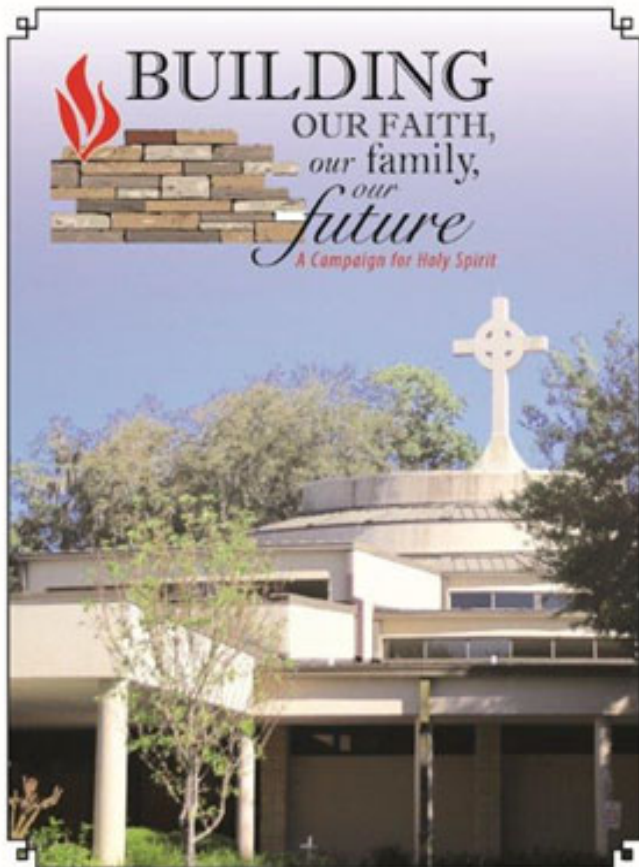

Father Amar answers your Family Life Center FAQs

Father: I use my credit card for almost everything. Why can't I make my pledge on a credit card?

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your interest in donating to the Family Life Center!

The answer is: it is simply a matter of economics. Every time you use a credit card, the store (or our church in this case) pays a fee, usually around 4%. That may not sound like much, but in a campaign where every dollar counts, we are watching expenses carefully. If half of our \$2 million goal were put on credit cards, we would lose \$40,000 in fees to VISA and Master Card!

Also, we do our best to operate your parish on a tight budget and be good stewards of your offerings. If you were to use a credit card it would require our staff to key that information in for each transaction, adding more work on top of their very busy days.

It is far better for you and us to have your bank make your pledge payments with Auto Pay/Bill Pay. In 3 minutes on line you can set up your pledge payments for the full 36 months without costing you or us a penny!

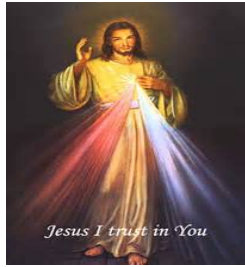

RCIA

Is there someone in your family, among your friends or neighbors who might be interested in joining our Catholic family? Have you ever wondered -- How does one become a member of the Catholic Faith Community? **The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)** is the process through which the Catholic Church welcomes and initiates new members into its faith community. RCIA is a restored ancient Rite, after Vatican II, designed to welcome and enlighten inquirers interested in knowing more about our Catholic Way of Life. RCIA is the perfect opportunity to gradually become aware of what it means to become Catholic. RCIA involves our entire parish community through its prayer and example, as well as involving sponsors who help to introduce inquirers to the life of the Parish. RCIA is intended for adults who are not baptized, those who are baptized in another Christian denomination, as well as those who are baptized Catholic and who wish to complete their initiation through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

LITURGICAL CORNER**St. Lawrence - Deacon of Rome**

Third-century archdeacon of Rome, distributor of alms, and “keeper of the treasures of the church” in a time when Christianity was outlawed. On 6 August 258, by decree of Emperor Valerian, Pope Saint Sixtus II and six deacons were martyred, leaving Lawrence as the ranking Church official in Rome.

Earlier, Pope Sixtus reassured Lawrence that he was not being left behind; they would be reunited in four days. Lawrence saw this time as an opportunity to disperse the material wealth of the church before the Roman authorities could lay their hands on it. On 10 August, Lawrence was commanded to appear for his execution, and to bring along the treasure with which he had been entrusted by the pope. When he arrived, the archdeacon was accompanied by a multitude of Rome’s crippled, blind, sick, and indigent. He announced that these were the true treasures of the Church.

Lawrence’s care for the poor, the ill, and the neglected have led to his patronage of them. His work to save the material wealth of the Church, including its documents, brought librarians and those in related fields to see him as a patron and to ask for his intercession. St. Lawrence is also noted for his incredible strength and courage during his own martyrdom. As a note of interest, the meteor shower that follows the passage of the Swift-Tuttle comet was known in the middle ages as the “burning tears of Saint Lawrence” because they appear at the same time as Lawrence’s feast day of August 10th.

What is WYD?

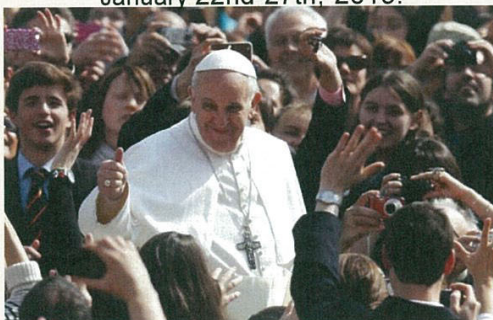
World Youth Day (WYD) is a gathering of young people from around the world to celebrate the love of Christ for humanity.
