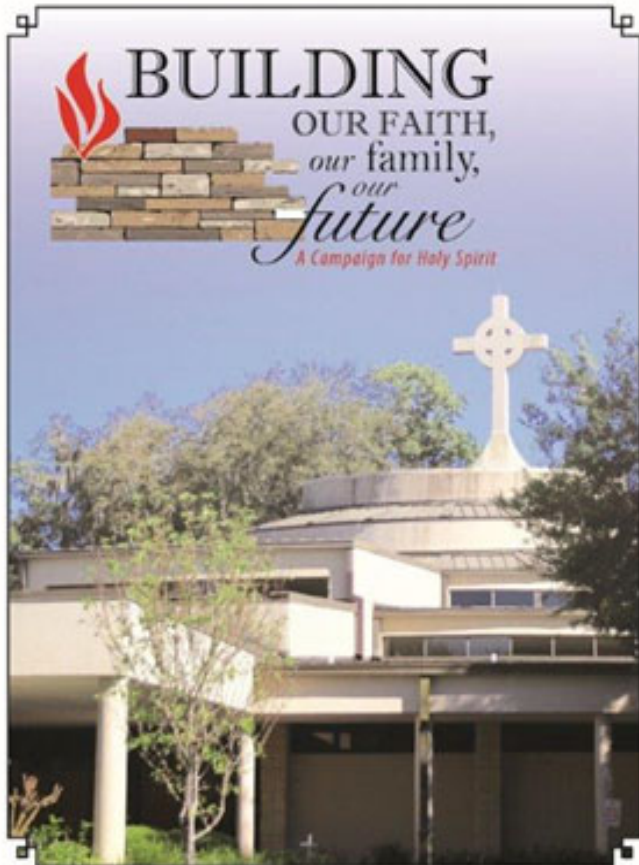

### Father Amar answers your Family Life Center - FAQs

**Father, I made a pledge and want to start paying on it? How should I do it?**

**Dear Parishioner:**

Thank you for making a gift for the future of our parish! If you are planning to pay your pledge over the next 36 months you can do it a number of ways. You can always stop by or send a check in the mail to the parish office with "Family Life Center" written on the memo line. You can use Bill Pay or Auto Pay as described in another note in our bulletin. Or you can use the monthly envelopes, which contain a "Building Fund" envelope in the package every month. Due to advance printing that envelope will still be there in the August package. Starting with the September envelopes, the building fund envelope will be replaced with a "Family Life Center" envelope. In addition, for people who may not receive our monthly envelope packages (and we hope you will sign up for them) we will have special Family Life Center envelopes available soon for distribution. Any of these methods will work. Just be sure we know who the donation is coming from so we can credit your account.

## **ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT**

### **FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017**

August 2017

The following is our Financial Report for fiscal year 2016-2017, July 2016 thru June 2017.

Highlights of this report include;

#### **Income**

Total gross income this year was \$1,371,358 vs \$1,156,753 last year. This year included \$377,564 of Building Fund/Family Life Center contributions. All Building Fund collections since July 1, 2016 have been set aside for the Family Life Center. Also we began receiving FLC pledge payments in May 2017. Last year included \$45,600 in non-recurring donations for special projects. We are very grateful for your generous contributions and donations this year.

#### **Expense**

Total gross expense this year was \$937,965 vs \$1,108,367 last year. Last year expense included \$123,875 for Rectory mortgage payments and the payoff of the mortgage in June 2016. We were debt free this year and experienced less repair/renovation expense on our facilities.

#### **Debt History**

Our Gym was built in 2005 and loan paid off in 2011. Our Rectory was purchased in 2008 and loan paid off in 2016

#### **Family Life Center**

We are very excited about the reality of soon having a Family Life Center for our Parish. Our thanks and appreciation to all for your support of our FLC and the Capital Campaign to pay for it. We have received pledges for almost \$1.5 million and payments for \$300,000 have been received through July. The expense for construction will be increasing monthly so we encourage everyone to make their pledge payments as early as possible. Construction has begun and the building is expected to be completed mid to late Spring 2018. Thanks again for your support.

While I was not your Pastor this past year I want to express my personal appreciation for your generous financial support and faithful stewardship to our Parish. We are very blessed to have so many faithful and dedicated parishioners giving of their time, talent, and treasures. May God bless you and your family.

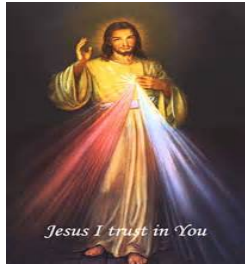
### Parishioners,

**RCIA**

Is there someone in your family, among your friends or neighbors who might be interested in joining our Catholic family? Have you ever wondered -- How does one become a member of the Catholic Faith Community? **The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)** is the process through which the Catholic Church welcomes and initiates new members into its faith community. RCIA is a restored ancient Rite, after Vatican II, designed to welcome and enlighten inquirers interested in knowing more about our Catholic Way of Life. RCIA is the perfect opportunity to gradually become aware of what it means to become Catholic. RCIA involves our entire parish community through its prayer and example, as well as involving sponsors who help to introduce inquirers to the life of the Parish. RCIA is intended for adults who are not baptized, those who are baptized in another Christian denomination, as well as those who are baptized Catholic and who wish to complete their initiation through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

**LITURGICAL CORNER****St. Lawrence - Deacon of Rome**

Third-century archdeacon of Rome, distributor of alms, and “keeper of the treasures of the church” in a time when Christianity was outlawed. On 6 August 258, by decree of Emperor Valerian, Pope Saint Sixtus II and six deacons were martyred, leaving Lawrence as the ranking Church official in Rome.

Earlier, Pope Sixtus reassured Lawrence that he was not being left behind; they would be reunited in four days. Lawrence saw this time as an opportunity to disperse the material wealth of the church before the Roman authorities could lay their hands on it. On 10 August, Lawrence was commanded to appear for his execution, and to bring along the treasure with which he had been entrusted by the pope. When he arrived, the archdeacon was accompanied by a multitude of Rome’s crippled, blind, sick, and indigent. He announced that these were the true treasures of the Church.

Lawrence’s care for the poor, the ill, and the neglected have led to his patronage of them. His work to save the material wealth of the Church, including its documents, brought librarians and those in related fields to see him as a patron and to ask for his intercession. St. Lawrence is also noted for his incredible strength and courage during his own martyrdom. As a note of interest, the meteor shower that follows the passage of the Swift-Tuttle comet was known in the middle ages as the “burning tears of Saint Lawrence” because they appear at the same time as Lawrence’s feast day of August 10th.
