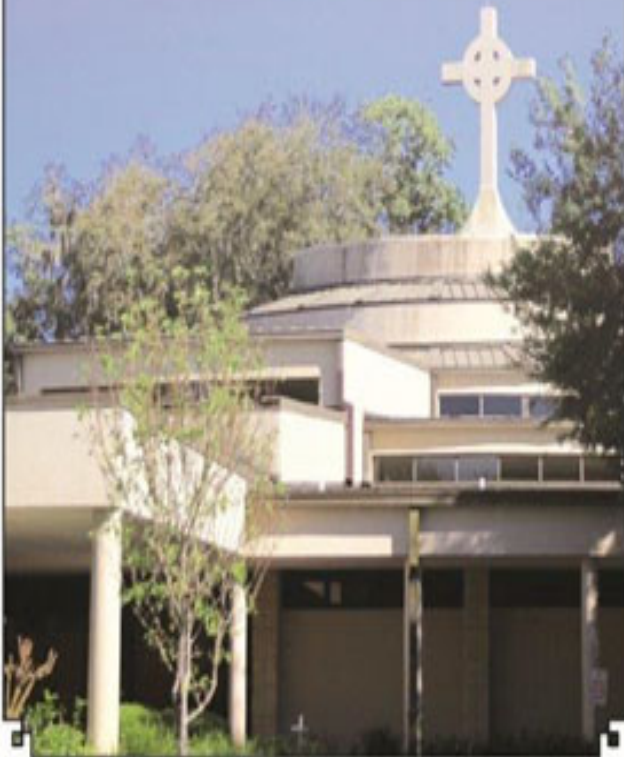

Holy Days of Obligation

The first precept of the Church is to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, and to refrain from work and activities which could impede the sanctification of those days.

A Holy Day is an important feast of Our Lord, Our Lady or other saints that Catholics are morally obliged to observe by participating in the celebration of the Eucharist and by abstaining from unnecessary servile work.

Below are the upcoming Holy Days:

November 1, 2017 - The Solemnity of All Saints.

December 8, 2017 - The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

December 25, 2017 - The Solemnity of the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ.

August 15, 2018 - The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
