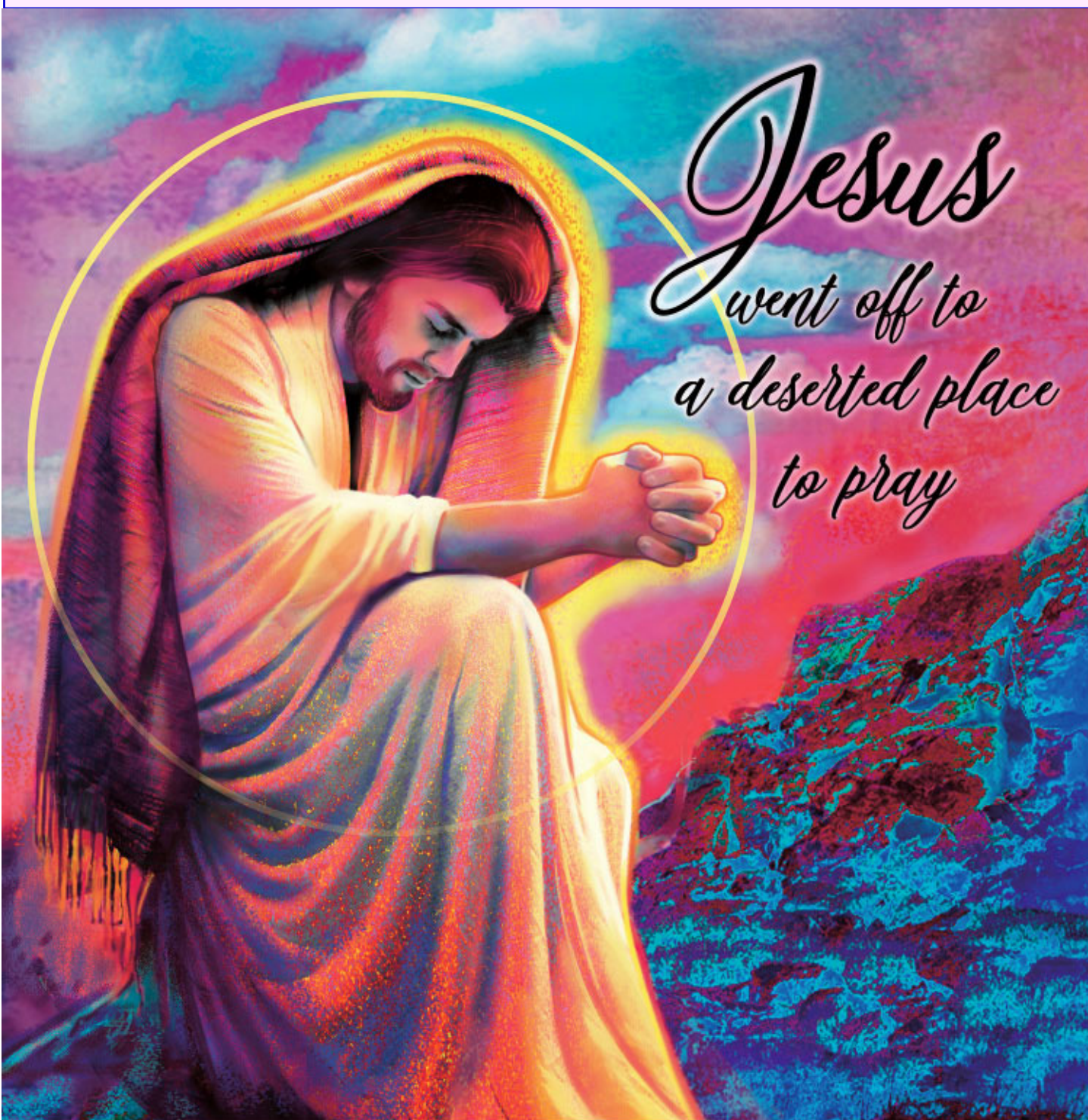

LITURGICAL CORNER

Should parishioners remain kneeling after Communion until all the extra hosts are put back in the Tabernacle?

The general custom has been to kneel until the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the Tabernacle, but it is equally appropriate to sit. The primary consideration should be reverence and meditative prayer. When the Deacon is present, he will purify the sacred vessels i.e. the chalice and ciborium that were used to distribute communion on the table off to the side of the sanctuary. During the purification process, the extra host will have been placed in the Tabernacle by the priest or the deacon.

In many churches, the general custom is to kneel/sit until the priest sits but only after the Blessed Sacrament has been placed in the Tabernacle. To kneel/sit while the vessels are being purified is not required, but the respect it shows should not be discouraged.

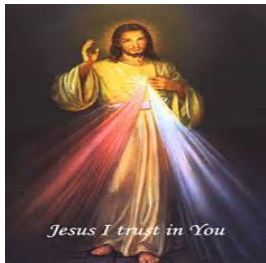
