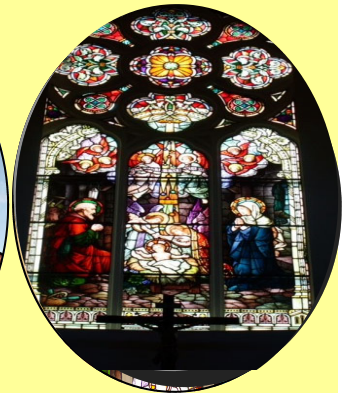

FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of **Fasting**. Catholics between the ages of 18-59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal). With no eating between meals.

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence**. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely. Soups and gravies made from meat are permitted.

LITURGICAL CORNER

Adult Religious Education

It is probably safe to say that most cradle Catholics have a religious education that was instructed years ago during their grade and middle school years. However, now that we are adults and have a bit more life experience under our belts, isn't it time to move toward our creator through additional knowledge and meaningful adult reflection with others? Isn't it time to take our faith a little deeper, discovering Jesus a second time and the understanding our Catholic faith more fully?

Adult religious education programs in parishes continue to invite participants to deepen their understanding of the faith and their personal relationship with Jesus Christ. It is in knowing Jesus intimately that we will be able to accept his call to discipleship.

One such way to gain a deeper knowledge of Jesus is to read scriptures in the Adoration chapel! This is probably the easiest format because it is on your own timeline.

Holy Spirit offers free Bible Studies between the 8:15am and 11am masses on Sunday. These studies are conducted in an open forum, open conversation format. There is also the RCIA program which is a bit more structured. It is conducted weekly and is freely open to any and all confirmed Catholics who would like to just listen to the teachings.

If you would like to dive into a certification delivered educational program, the diocese offers the Ministry Formation Program which is a three-year program to prepare lay ministers for greater leadership in the Church.

Take a leap and become a better Catholic by gaining a higher level of religious education through the many programs that are offered in your parish and your diocese.

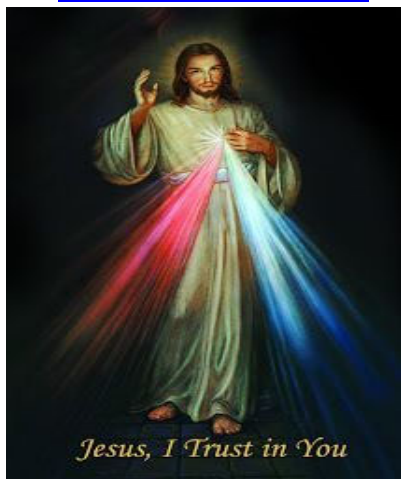

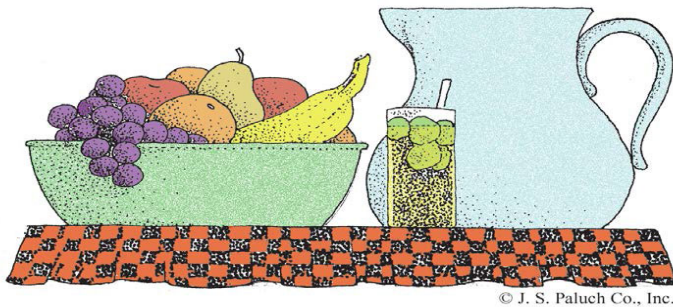

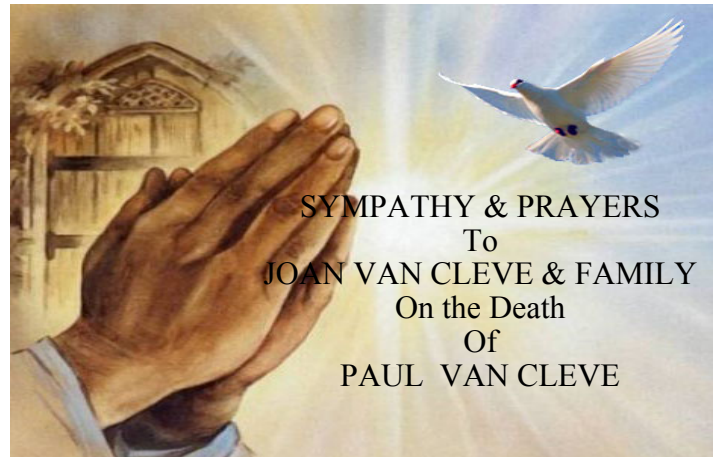
