FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Good Friday are days of **Fasting**. Catholics between the ages of 18-59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal). With no eating between meals.

All Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence**. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely. Soups and gravies made from meat are permitted.

LENTIL SALAD

2 bulbs garlic
1 teaspoon olive oil, divided
1 pound dry brown lentils
4 cups water, or as needed to cover
1 pint grape tomatoes, halved
1 bunch fresh parsley, finely chopped
1 bunch green onions, thinly sliced
1/4 cup balsamic vinegar
1/4 cup olive oil
salt and ground black pepper to taste
Add all ingredients to list

Directions

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C).

Peel outer skins from garlic bulbs and cut about 1/4 inch from the top of each bulb to expose cloves; place each bulb onto a piece of aluminum foil, drizzle each with about 1/2 teaspoon olive oil, and wrap garlic bulbs in the foil. Place wrapped bulbs into a baking dish. Bake garlic in the preheated oven until soft, about 30 minutes. Let bulbs cool.

Place lentils into a 5-quart pot and cover with water; bring to a boil. Reduce heat to medium-low and simmer until lentils are tender but not mushy, about 15 minutes; stir occasionally. Drain lentils in a fine-mesh strainer and rinse with cold water to cool; drain again.

Break garlic bulbs apart and squeeze cloves to release cooked garlic. Place garlic into a large salad bowl and add grape tomatoes, parsley, and green onions. Whisk balsamic vinegar with 1/4 cup olive oil, salt, and black pepper in a small bowl. Fold lentils into tomato mixture and pour dressing over salad; gently toss to coat. Keep refrigerated until serving time.

Liturgical Corner**Could you walk a mile in Jesus's shoes?**

The Stations of the Cross bring us closer to Christ as we meditate on the great love He showed for us in His most sorrowful Passion!

You can pray the Stations of the Cross (also known as the Way of the Cross) alone at any time, but people most often pray them in a group setting Friday nights during Lent.

Tradition traces this loving tribute to our Lord back to the Blessed Mother's retracing her son's last steps along what became known as the Via Dolorosa (the Sorrowful Way) on His way to His Crucifixion at Calvary in Jerusalem.

Pilgrims to the Holy Land commemorated Christ's Passion in a similar manner as early as the 4th century A.D. The Stations of the Cross developed as a devotion in earnest, however, around the 13th to 14th centuries.

It became a way of allowing those who could not make the long, expensive, arduous journey to Jerusalem to make a pilgrimage in prayer, at least, in their church! Although the original number of stations varied greatly, they became fixed at 14 stations in the 18th century.

The Stations of the Cross themselves are represented by a series of 14 sculptures covering our Lord's Passion and they are meant to be "stopping points" along the journey for prayer and meditation.

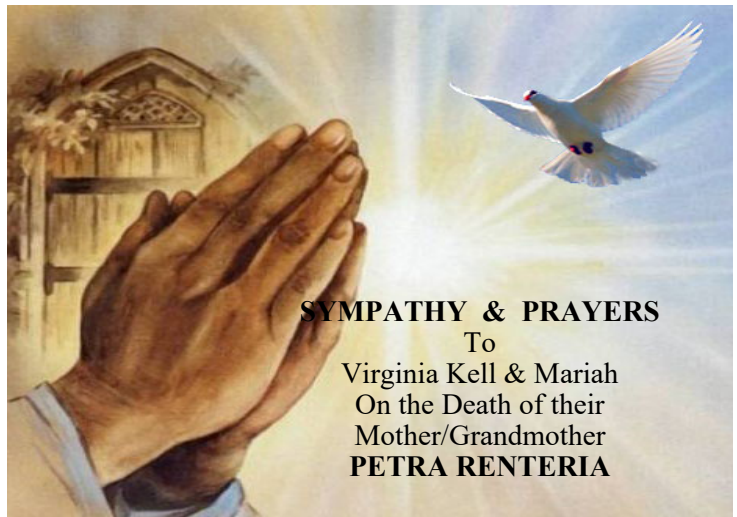

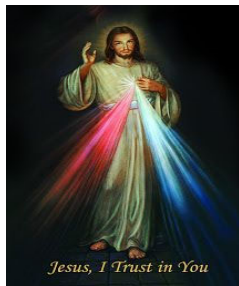

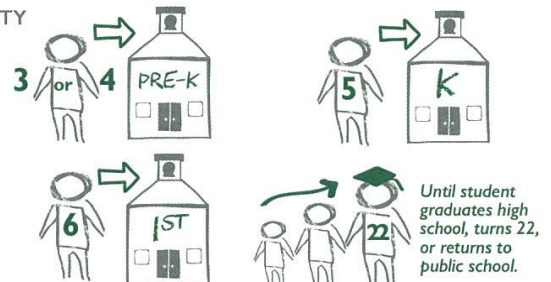
