

HOLY SPIRIT PARISH MISSION

The Church of the Holy Spirit is a welcoming, multi-cultural and multi-generational Roman Catholic faith community, rooted in Scripture and Tradition, nourished by the Sacraments, and empowered by the Holy Spirit to be light to our world by: Praying and celebrating as a Eucharistic Community, Instructing children and adults in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Serving the less fortunate with unconditional love & generosity and Protecting human life in all its stages.

FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Good Friday is a day of **Fasting**. Catholics between the ages of 18-59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal). With no eating between meals.

All Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence**. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely. Soups and gravies made from meat are permitted.

FINAL LENTEN FISH FRY

The Men's Club will host its final Fish Fry of this year's Lenten Season on Friday, March 23rd from 5pm to 7 pm in Msgr. Heslin Hall. The cost is \$8 from ages 7 years and up, while 6 years and under are free. This will also be the final chance to purchase a chance for a \$600 cruise certificate. ALL profit from the Fish Fry will go to the FLC Building Fund. Some come enjoy good food, wonderful fellowship and a chance to win a cruise.

**Lenten Orzo Salad**

1 pound orzo
 ¼ cup canola oil (or plus 2 tablespoons olive, divided)
 ½ cup pine nuts
 ½ cup currants
 ½ cup white wine (divided)
 1 medium onion (thinly julienned)
 3 cups spinach (flat leaf, tightly packed and julienned)
 3 garlic cloves (chopped)
 ½ teaspoon nutmeg
 to taste salt and pepper
 1 tablespoon dijon mustard
 ¼ cup lemon juice
 ½ cup oil-packed sun dried tomatoes (chopped)

**Instructions**

1. In a small sauté pan, combine currants and ¼ cup white wine and bring to a boil. Remove from heat and let sit for 10 minutes while currants absorb the wine. Then drain off excess wine and set aside.
2. In a medium sauté pan, heat 1 tablespoon oil and sauté onion over medium heat until deeply caramelized (deep golden brown in color). Add spinach, garlic, nutmeg and cook spinach just until wilted, gently turning. Drain off liquid and set aside.
3. Prepare the dressing: In a small bowl whisk together mustard, lemon juice and remaining white wine. While whisking slowly, drizzle remaining oil into the bowl.
4. In a large bowl toss orzo, currants, pine nuts, sun dried tomatoes, and onion and spinach mixture with the dressing. Add salt and pepper to taste. Makes 16 servings.

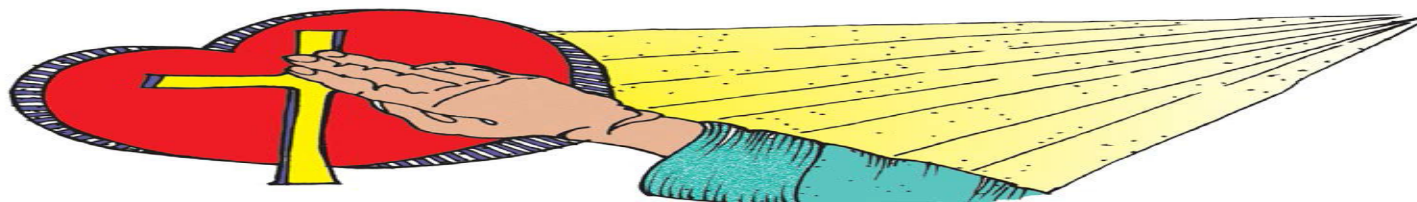
