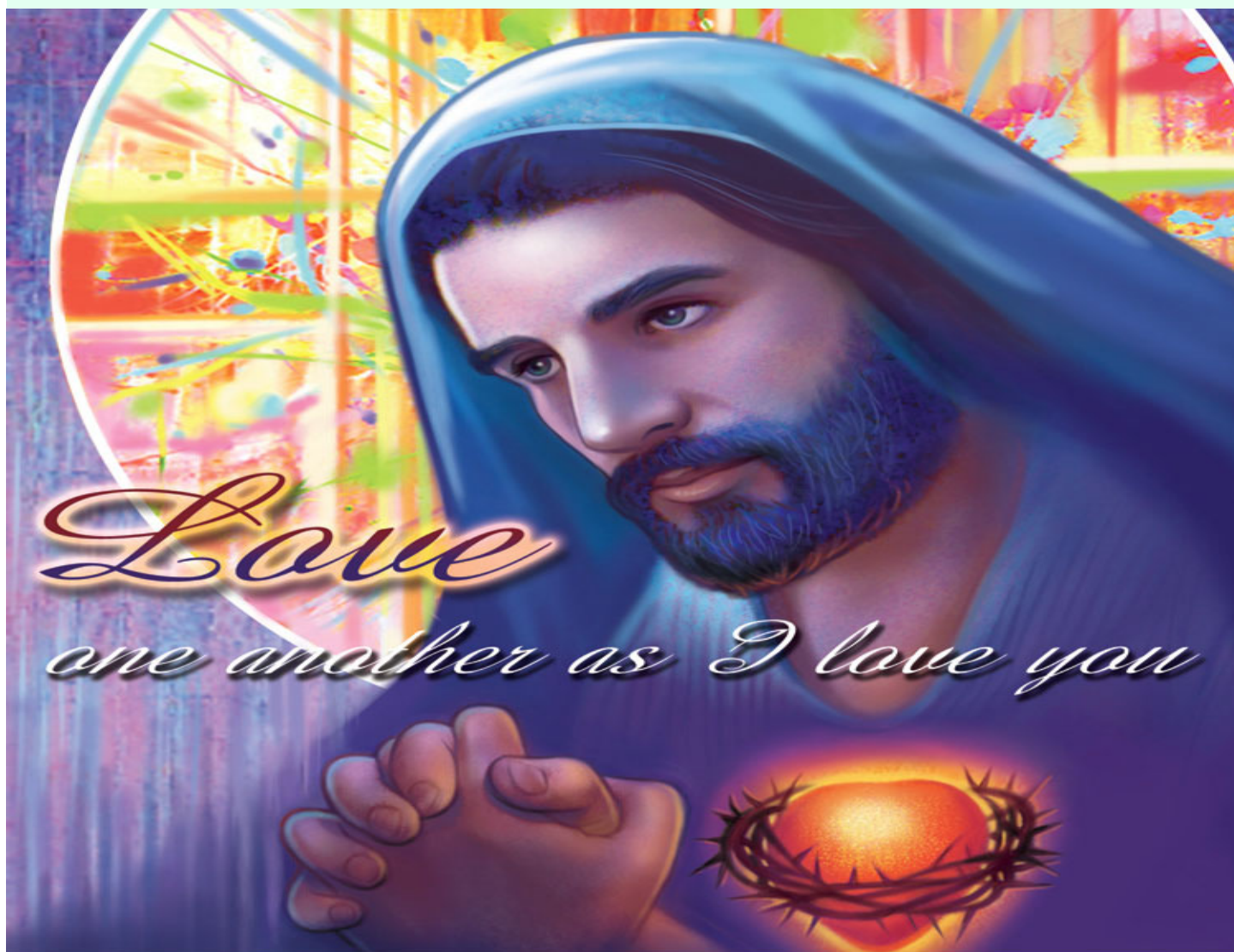


OUR MISSION
