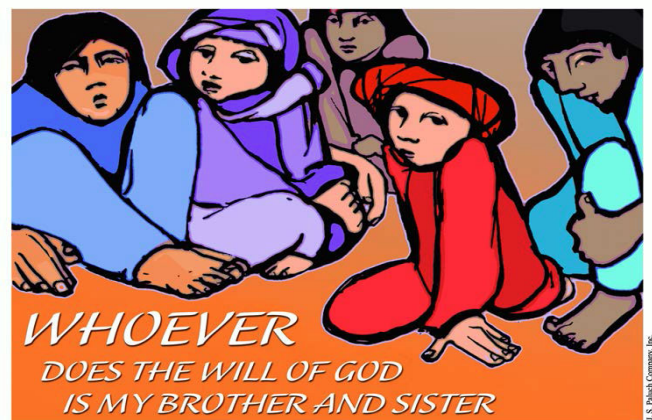
HS VPK PROGRAM

DID YOU KNOW?

2nd thru 8th grade students at Holy Spirit School took the national Iowa Assessment in March. This test is administered to all Catholic school students in the state of Florida. There are two main scores reported in Reading and Mathematics for every grade level. Holy Spirit classes scored higher than the state average in 10 of the 14 areas tested. They also scored higher than the average for the rest of the Diocese of St. Augustine in 9 of the 14 areas.
