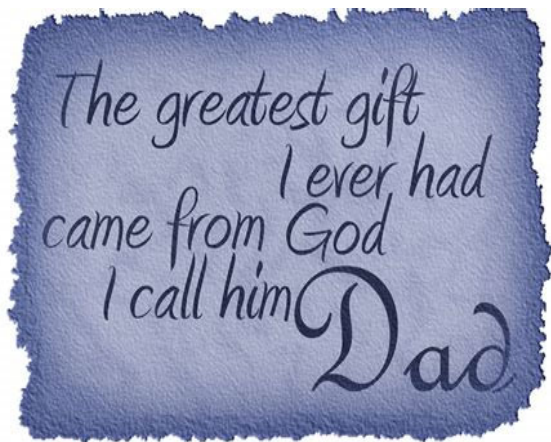

From Bishop Felipe Estevez

After due consultation, discussion and prayerful discernment between the Diocese of Saint Augustine and Missionaries of Saint Francis de Sales (MSFS Order/Fransalians), the Diocese entrusts the administration, management, and pastoral care of Holy Spirit Parish (including Holy Spirit School) to the Fransalians (MSFS Order) for a period of five years. This term of service may be renewed as needed on mutual agreement.



Be a Witness of Charity!

Our diocese will take up the **Peter's Pence Collection (PPC)** the weekend of June 23-24. This global collection supports the Holy Father as he reaches out in mercy and charity to people who are suffering. Your generosity will help Pope Francis ease the suffering of some of the most marginalized throughout the world and show them the tender love of God.

Pope Francis challenges us to look at those around us with the eyes of mercy. He says, "We encounter so many weary and oppressed people today . . . And how is our heart? Is it merciful? And our way of thinking and acting, is it inclusive?" (Jubilee Audience, Nov. 12, 2016). I invite you to reflect on how you feel moved to answer the call to mercy.

In Iraq, many people still live a nightmare of war and violence. This has left many displaced, including young people in the midst of their studies. Without an educated population, it will be difficult for the country to gain stability. But with the support of your diocese to the PPC, the Archdiocese of Erbil, in Iraqi Kurdistan, has received funding for 10 scholarships for young displaced persons. With this help, the students can complete their university education and move

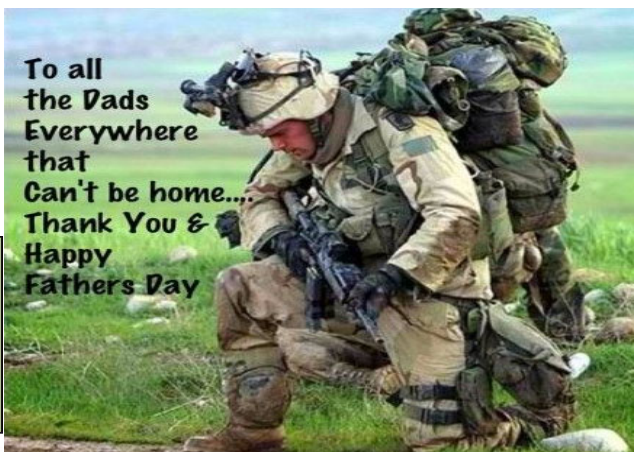
RETRouvILLE PROGRAM

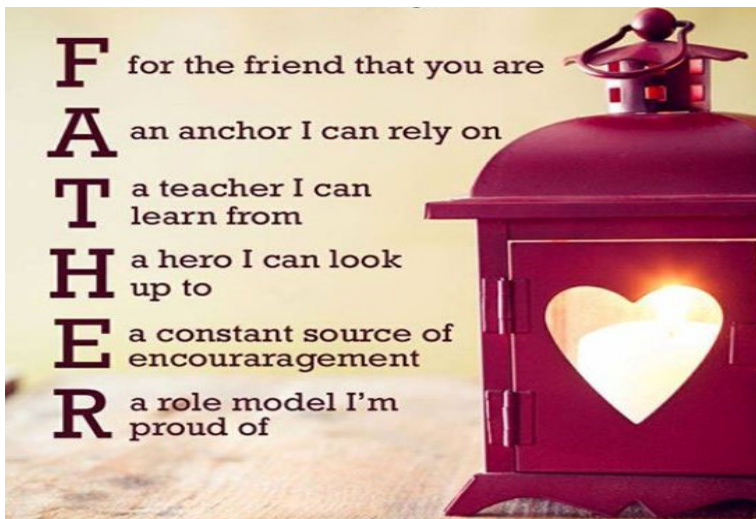

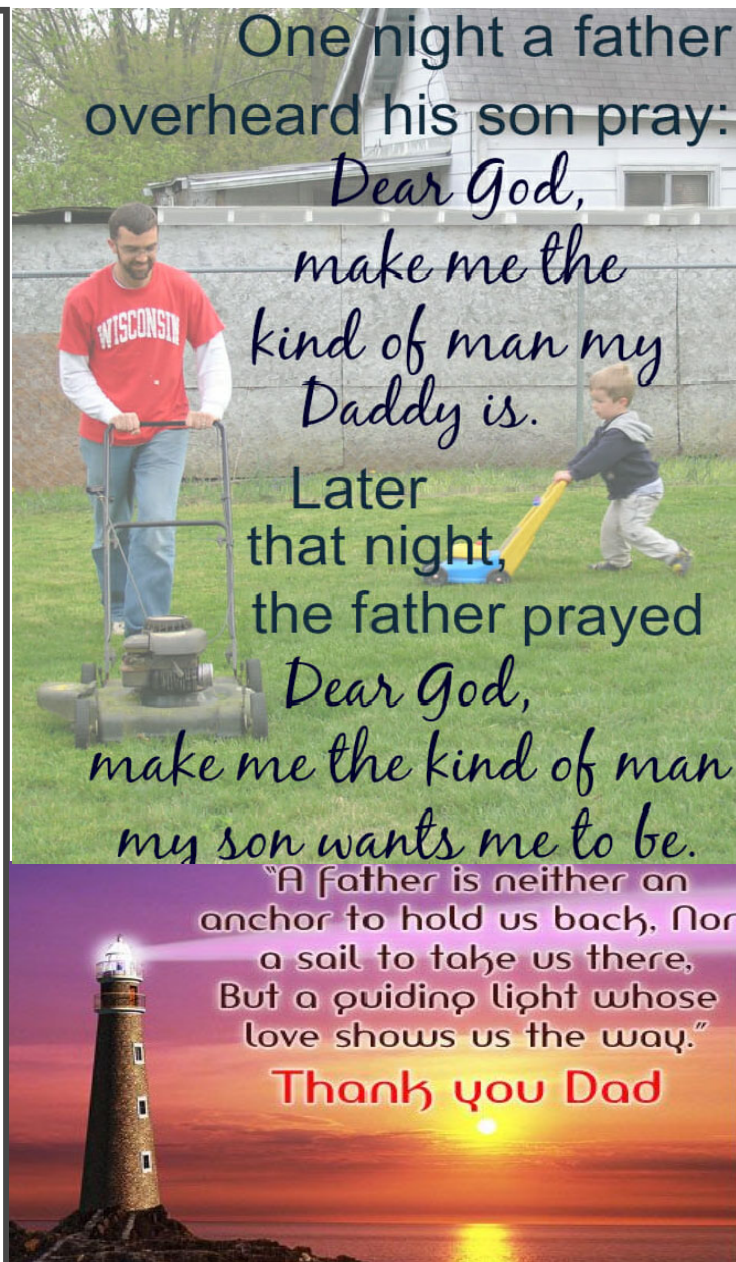
