GUIDELINES FOR USE OF FAMILY LIFE CENTER

Our Family Life Center is presently open for parish ministry meetings and functions. Following the formal dedication on Sunday, September 16, the center will be opened for expanded use by the entire Parish. Many have already inquired about the use of the FLC so the following guidelines are being issued to assist in your future planning:

1. All uses of the FLC must be scheduled in advance with the church office. If there are no conflicts, date of request will be honored. Request forms are available in the office.
2. Request must be submitted and approved for each event with the exception of recurring ministry/parish board meetings which only require an initial request.
3. The church office will assign space/meeting rooms in the FLC to insure efficient use.
4. Recurring parish meetings and events will be given priority. These include but not limited to; ministry and committee meetings, faith formation, youth ministry events, family nights, and funeral and wedding receptions for funerals/weddings held in Holy Spirit Church.
5. Next in priority will be celebrations of milestone life events for parish members and members of their immediate family. Events include; birthdays limited to 1st, 18th, 21st, and all birthdays 50th and older, Baptisms, First Communion & Confirmation, Baby Showers, Quinceanera, Holy Spirit School Graduations, Wedding Anniversaries, and Retirements.
6. Non-profit & charitable groups with a parish sponsor (i.e. Catholic Charities dinner or WQOP fundraiser, etc.) will be accepted.
7. The pastor will have final approval of all requests.
8. For events other than parish meeting/events, a cleaning fee and damage deposit may be required in addition to insurance coverage. Details of these charges will be reviewed for each event.

I invite all of you to come and enjoy our Family Life Center over and over again. It is yours and many of you have worked hard to make it a reality. First and foremost it is here to serve the needs of our parish and I want to insure that all those needs are met. Please feel free to contact the office if you have questions.

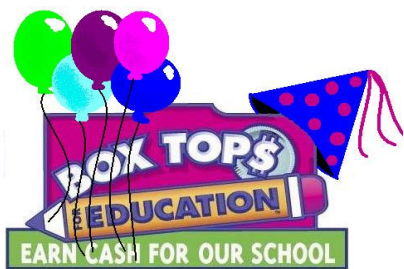
