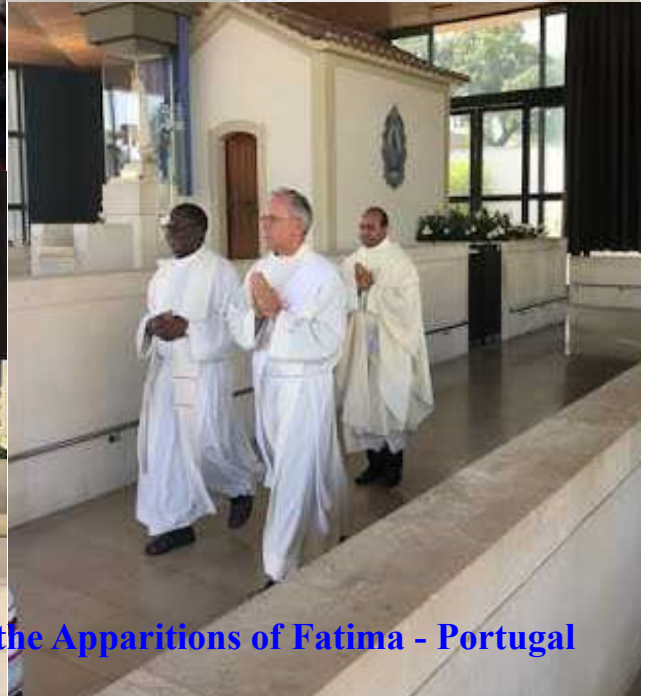

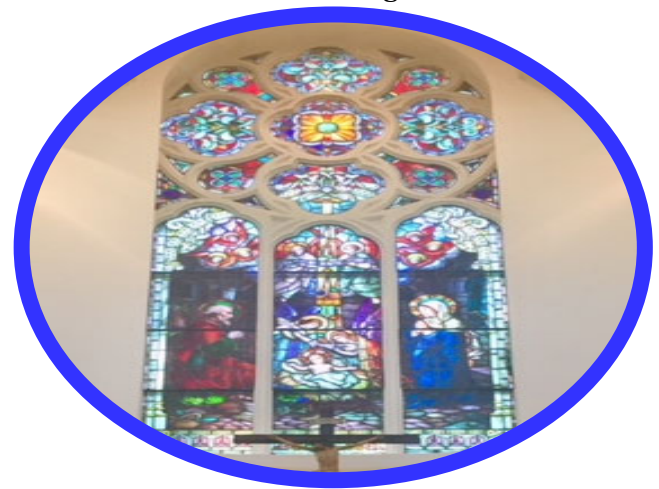

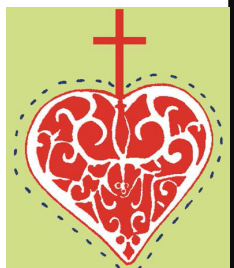

## Prayer Services for Our Church in This Time of Crisis

In Mark's Gospel, when Jesus was asked by the Apostles why they could not drive an unclean spirit, Jesus responded that "This kind can only come out through prayer." (Mk 9:28) That is where our Church is today. The Body of Christ has not been able to drive out the evil spirit of clergy abuse, and we now realize the truth of Our Lord's words that to do so calls for the prayer, the prayer of all of its members.

At Holy Spirit we will have two opportunities to solemnly pray for the Church and for all victims of sexual misconduct, especially those who have been victimized by clergy and laity:

- ◆ **On Friday September 14, the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, at 7:00 pm there will be a Holy Hour during which we will pray for the Church and those who have been victims of abuse by clergy and other members of the Church.**
- ◆ **On Saturday September, the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows, at 12:00 Noon, there will be a Rosary Service for the same intentions.**
- ◆ **In addition to these public prayer services, you are encouraged to fast on these two days as well. As in Lent this is one full meal and two smaller meals when combined are not equal to the full meal.**

Please attend one or both of these prayer services and consider fasting for this intention. We ask your continued prayers for the Church in this time of crisis.

#### LISTENING AND RESPONDING

There are three interwoven themes in today's readings: listening to God, faith vs. good works, and losing our life in order to find it. How are they related?

The Suffering Servant of Isaiah undergoes much distress and ridicule, but is able to bear it because he has listened to the promptings of God day after day. The psalm tells us that God listens, too. God hears our prayers for help and is always ready to save us. As our faith deepens, so does our desire to do the works of justice and charity that build up the reign of God. God directs our actions in ways we often cannot see, and we don't always see the results. We are called upon in faith to trust that what we do is enough, and that willingness to listen to God's promptings will lead us in the right way.

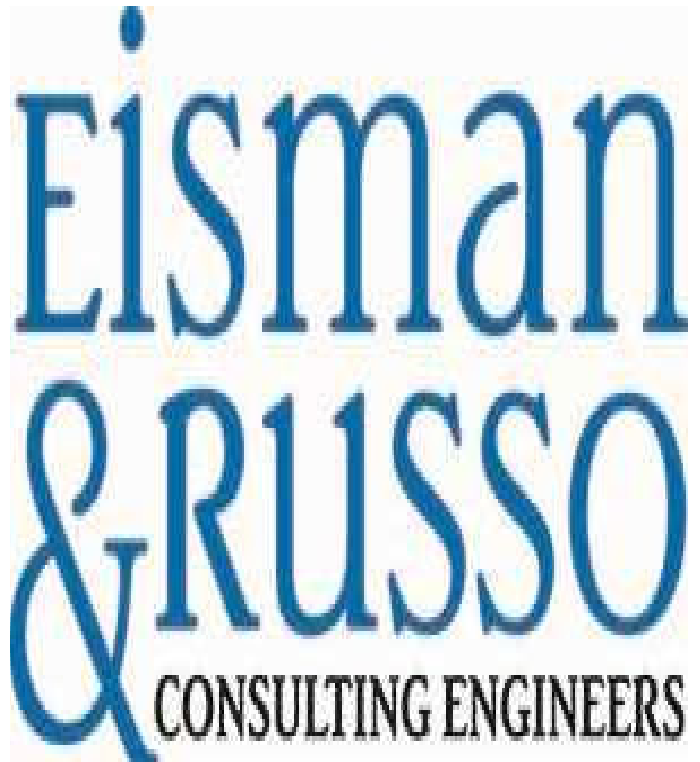

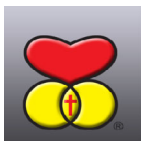

## **GUIDELINES FOR USE OF FAMILY LIFE CENTER**

Our Family Life Center is presently open for parish ministry meetings and functions. Following the formal dedication on Sunday, September 16, the center will be opened for expanded use by the entire Parish. Many have already inquired about the use of the FLC so the following guidelines are being issued to assist in your future planning:

1. All uses of the FLC must be scheduled in advance with the church office. If there are conflicts, the first request will be honored. Request forms are available in the office.
2. Request must be submitted and approved for each event with the exception of recurring ministry/parish board meetings which only require an initial request.
3. The church office will assign space/meeting rooms in the FLC to insure efficient use.
4. Recurring parish meetings and events will be given priority. These include but not limited to; ministry and committee meetings, faith formation, youth ministry events, family nights, and funeral and wedding receptions for funerals/weddings held in Holy Spirit Church.
5. Next in priority will be celebrations of milestone life events for parish members and members of their immediate family. Events include; birthdays limited to 1<sup>st</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and all birthdays 50<sup>th</sup> and older, Baptisms, First Communion & Confirmation, Baby Showers, Quinceanera, Holy Spirit School Graduations, Wedding Anniversaries, and Retirements.
6. Non-profit & charitable groups with a parish sponsor (i.e. Catholic Charities dinner or WQOP fundraiser, etc.) will be accepted.
7. The pastor will have final approval of all requests.
8. For events other than parish meeting/events, a cleaning fee and damage deposit may be required in addition to insurance coverage. Details of these charges will be reviewed for each event.
