**Happy Thanksgiving!!!** I pray your week is full of great memories with family and friends.

As we celebrate “Thanksgiving Day,” let us remember that it is not a day's affair, to be celebrated on the fourth Thursday of every November. Actually, for a believer – every day is to be a Thanksgiving Day. It is to be a way of life for a child of God. It should never be for us 'once in a year matter,' but a daily sending of our thanks to God.

In order to be thankful, must we be reminded, what to say, every time God gives us those things for which we pray? No! We shouldn't have to be told to say, 'Thank you!' 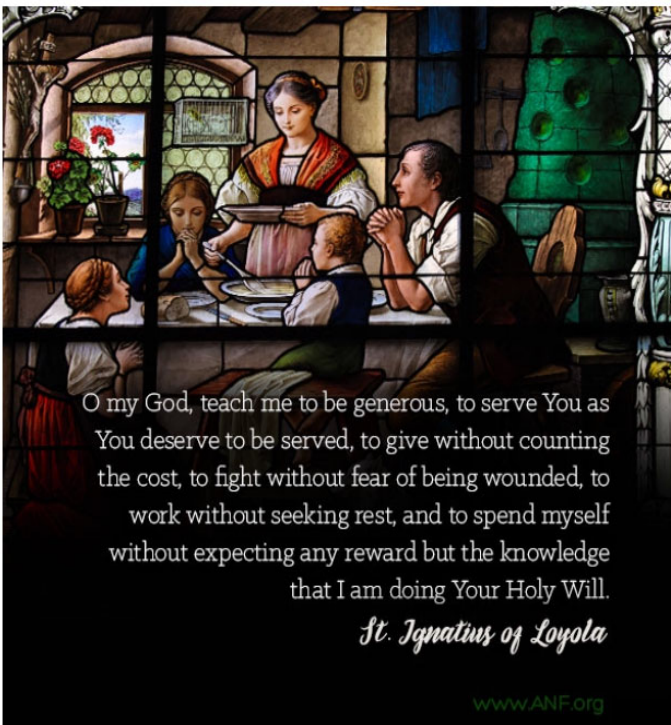
### HELP NEEDED

### HOW GRATEFUL ARE YOU???

From “The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic,” by Matthew Kelly.

There are seven billion people on the planet. If you imagine the whole world being in one village of just 100 people, this is how the numbers would shake out.

57 of those 100 people would come from Asia, 21 from Europe, 9 from Africa, 8 from N. America, and 5 from S. America.

51 would be women, 49 would be men.

6 of the 100 people would own and control 50% of the world’s wealth. 5 of these 6 people would be U.S. citizens . (that’s you and I folks)

One of the 100 people would have just been born and another would have just died.

Only 7 of those 100 people would have been to college.

33 would be Christians, and 67 would be non-Christians.

80 of the 100 would be living in substandard housing.

31 would be unable to read or write.

24 would be living with no electricity.

71 would not have access to the internet.

39 of the 100 people would be living on less than \$2 a day.

One-third of the group would be dying from lack of food, one-third would be dying from lack of justice, and one-third would be dying from over-eating. (Pages 75-76 Kelly, M. 2012)

So, how blessed do you feel right now? How grateful to our Lord should we be every single day?
