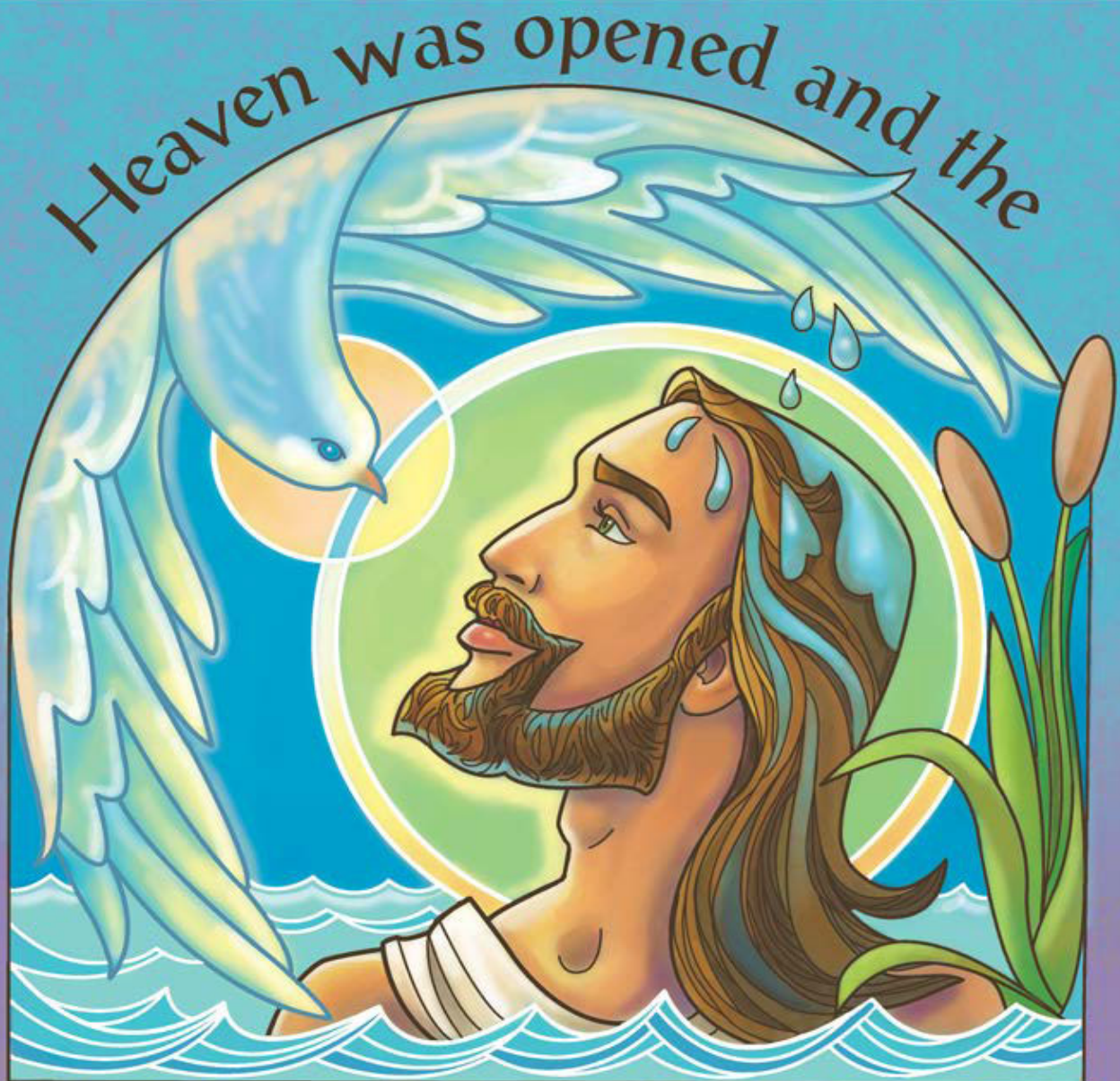

**MIRIAM FUNCHESS**



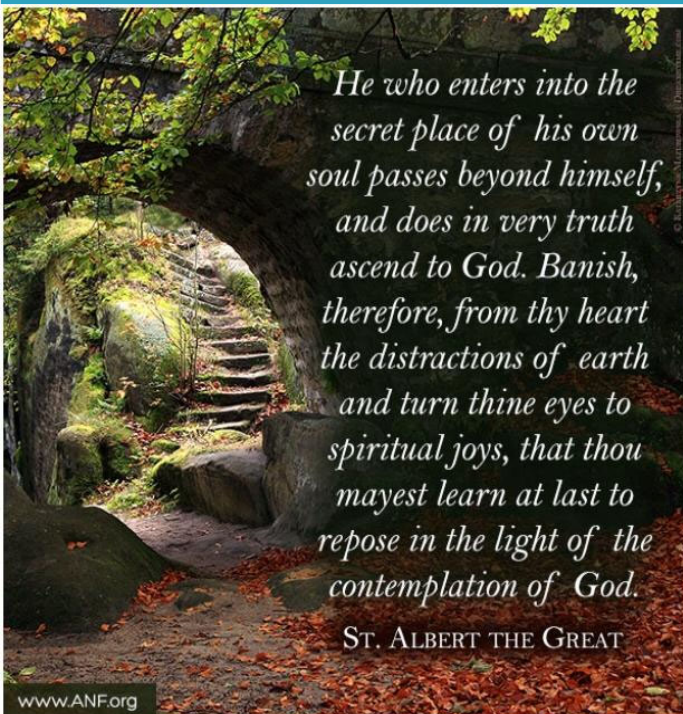
