### *From the Desk of our Pastor*

Beloved of Holy Spirit Catholic Community,

It is so wonderful to be back at the parish. I have missed you as I went on my vacation to India to visit my family and friends. Thank you for your prayers, for it was a wonderful time with my family, friends and my religious community. My family extends their greetings to you all especially my mother. She thanks you all for all the love and care you give me. All of my time was great except, when I was leaving: it wasn't easy to leave when mom is in tears of sending her youngest away. But that's the vocation.

Speaking of vocation, what a wonderful set of life-vocation stories in today's Scriptures.

Isaiah experiences (sees) the Lord of hosts in the Temple. He is humbled: "Woe is me, I'm doomed. I'm a man of unclean lips." The ember carried by the seraph removes his wickedness. And Isaiah is ready to go forth: "Here I am, send me!"

Jesus has confronted Paul on the road to Damascus. Paul acknowledges that he is not worthy to be an apostle. And yet he preaches faithfully: "By the grace of God I am what I am."

Peter reluctantly puts out into deep water at the command of Jesus – and witnesses nets so full that they are breaking. He kneels before Jesus in great humility: "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Jesus gently tells him not to be afraid: "From now on you will be catching men." Peter and his mates leave everything and follow Jesus.

Each of these encounters with God became life-changing. Isaiah will speak God's word for his lifetime, whether he is accepted or rejected. Peter and Paul engage in "catching men" for the rest of their lives until they are ultimately killed for their preaching.


How many times in their lives as apostles would they be asked again to "put out into deeper water and lower your nets"? Often their security was not to be found near the shoreline but with Jesus in the deep water.

Jesus' invitation always seems to be "put out into deep water." As we grow older, the invitation to let Jesus live in us more fully leads us into the deeper waters of our own life and that of our community. We can only fill our nets with the grace of God when we're willing to leave our own security and trust in the invitation to come deeper.

Like Isaiah, the Lord will remove our sins and failings that keep us close to shore and prepare us to go deeper. Like Peter, we will hear Jesus gently tell us: "Do not be afraid."

May our willingness to put out into the deep with Jesus lead us to be able to say with St. Paul: "By the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me has not been ineffective."

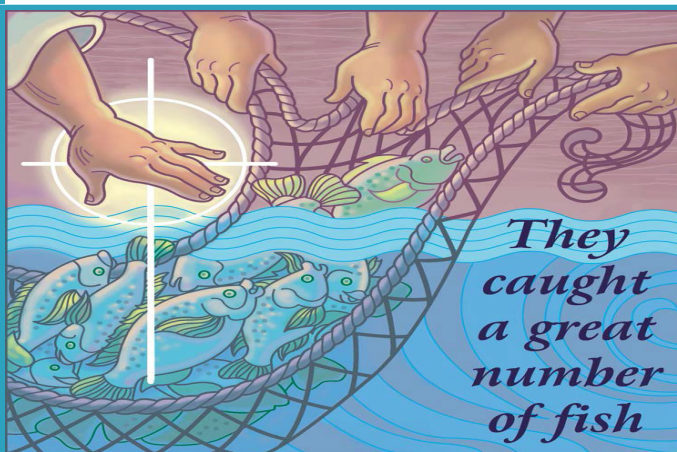

In 1975, with three young children still to raise, Joyce became a widow. Today has 8 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

For 10 years, starting in 1996, Joyce began to do grocery shopping for Msgr. Heslin and cooked 4 meals a week for him. Around that time she became very active in the CCW and served 2 terms as their president. When Father Anand came to Holy Spirit, he took note of this lady who was always at mass and asked her to be the Parish Sacristan.

Joyce prepares the altar and books for masses, insures that everything needed for the mass, benediction, funeral or wedding is where it is supposed to be, trains the altar servers in their duties and coordinates with outside parties who will be participating in special ceremonies. She makes sure that the church always has a supply of hosts and wine. She makes sure that everyone involved in any given liturgy is prepared and all of the pieces are in place so that the priest may place all of his focus on celebrating the liturgy in a correct and respectful manner. Without hesitation, Joyce does this job 365 days a year as an unpaid volunteer! She is quick to acknowledge and thank others for their help, but for over 12 years, 3 very happy and grateful missionary priests have called her both "Mom" and, somewhat playfully, "Mother Superior" in recognition of her special place in their hearts and the parish.

Joyce is a frequent lector on Sundays and weekdays and an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, even conducting a regular communion service at the Atrium nursing home. There she gives thanks, proclaiming that, "God has blessed her so much more than she deserves" and asks Jesus to help her to continue serving Him.

Thank you, God for the gift of Joyce and thank you, Joyce for answering His call. We are blessed to have such a "Mom" and "Mother Superior"!!
