MID-YEAR FINANCIAL REPORT

FEBRUARY 2019

Enclosed is our Mid-Year Financial Report for the period July 2018 thru December 2018. Highlights of the report include:

Income (excluding Family Life Center)

Total Gross Income for the first six months of this year was \$467,401 vs \$466,393 last year for a slight increase of \$1,008. We are pleased we were able to meet last year numbers since last year was a decrease of \$50,444 compared to the previous year primarily due to the Family Life Center capital campaign.

EXPENSE (excluding Family Life Center)

Total Gross Expense for the first six months of this year was \$411,941 vs \$417,040 last year for a decrease of \$5,099. While most expenses continue to increase, we are pleased to experience this slight decrease in our overall expenses.

FAMILY LIFE CENTER

We have received pledges during this period of \$1,580,153 and pledge payments of \$1,135,253 with 37% of parishioners making a pledge. We also are aware there are those who did not make a pledge but are giving to the FLC. The overall cost of the facility is over \$2.5 million.

We made a request early in December for you to give what you could to the FLC in December and the first week in January to help reduce the loan balance before finalizing the permanent loan in late January. Our goal was to reduce the balance from \$960,000 to \$900,000. We were able to reduce it to \$875,000 thanks to all your support. In addition, the Finance Committee elected to borrow another \$150,000 from our Reserve Account reducing the balance to \$725,000. The goal is to pay this amount back to the Reserve Account over a (3) year period with no interest.

COMMENTS

We are extremely happy with our Family Life Center and the extraordinary amount of use the facility is experiencing each week. This was not possible without the tremendous and generous support you have provided. Thanks again for answering our request to help reduce the loan balance. We are truly blessed in this parish to have so many loving and giving families. Please know you and your support is greatly appreciated.

Thank you for continuously blessing me with your cooperation.
