### *From the Desk of our Pastor*

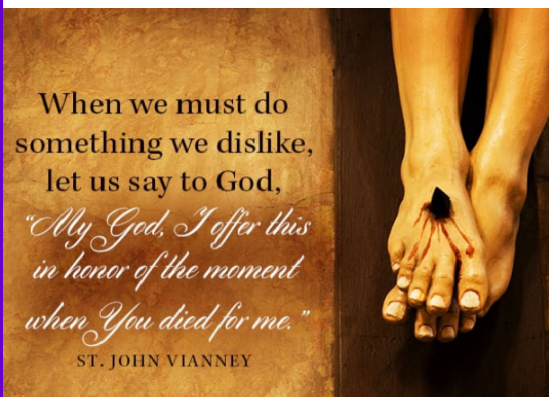
**Here we go again.** This is not a new topic. In the last few months, many have received an email allegedly from me that ultimately enlists the “target” recipient into spending money to buy gift cards and then sending along the card information and receipt to an unknown recipient. This is not a new **SCAM** technique at all in our area or nationwide.

- Sometimes the **SCAMmer** indicates they are one of the priests of our diocese or someone else well known to us who is stuck in some tough situation or overseas and in need of money.

- Others have acted as a member of law enforcement and indicate that by this action the recipient or someone close to them or that they care about can avoid legal action of some sort.

When you hear anything like this, that urgently requires you to provide your personal information, banking data, or obtain money-instruments and pass information to someone unknown to you...alarms should go off in your head.

**Absolutely DON'T do it!**



### **What direction will your Lenten journey take?**

These first days of this holy season are a time to reflect as a community on the path our spiritual journey will take as we prepare to celebrate Easter. “Conversion” is a word we hear often during the season: conversion means “turning”, a U-turn, if our lives have seriously gone against the loving will of God, or a correcting the ship’s direction as we note deviations from love of God and neighbor caused by our selfish motives.

There are three especial practices recommended for Lent, which we can adopt, and add others of our own. The first is *prayer*. The direction to which we turn is God and His Word. There are many forms of prayer that may enrich our lives. The Stations of the Cross and the Rosary are very appropriate. We have the Sacraments: we could celebrate may be one more Mass a week other than Sunday Mass, we need not wait for the rush of Holy Week to make a special confession. We can prepare it throughout the Lent and make it peacefully and joyfully even before the Holy Week. Bible reading in private or in family can enrich family life enormously. Make use of the several programs available: Parish Lenten Mission, Diocesan Eucharistic Congress, Lenten Reflection Books, Best Lent Ever from Dynamic Catholic and many others.

The second important practice is *penance*. It need not stress physical discomfort, though some of it is surely helpful to counteract our tendency to make our life more and more comfortable. We have customary practices like less sugar, no smoking, no drinks, or no meat... Apart from practicing exterior penances, there are interior penances like befriending and forgiving people we do not like, shortening our television time and increasing our family conversation, between husband and wife, and with children and elders, (it may result in rich experiences).

Finally, *almsgiving*, itself a form of penance, it is but much more than that. It is an effort to grow in love with people we normally do not consider. Please share actively in Rice Bowl program. “Love your enemies” our Master commanded. At least, let us not condemn them. And make an effort to befriend marginal and deprived people.

May a personalized Lent lead us to a deep joy of the Easter Hallelujah!

**STEWARDSHIP IN ACTION****DON ZEHNDER**

When Father Anand, MSFS came to Holy Spirit parish, so did Don & Mary Zehnder. They were married in 1959 and had 4 adult children, 2 boys and 2 girls. At the time they felt God pulling them for multiple special reasons! In no time at all Don joined the Knights of Columbus and within three years was elected Grand Knight. Under his leadership, the charitable activities of the Knights in east Arlington grew. Soon he was also serving as a Lector and Extra Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Assisting with the Eucharist has been Don's greatest honor, but his clear and powerful Scripture readings were his gift to our congregation. Mary's calling was to join other ladies to prepare a warm reception each time there was a funeral in the parish. In January, 2017, at Mary's urging, she and Don joined the St. Vincent de Paul Society and this became their ministry together. They teamed up to visit the needy and desperate in our community, finding Jesus in their countless faces and homes. Within a year, Don was asked to lead the SVDP Conference. But Don & Mary's partnership in SVDP and life ended abruptly that year, prior to their 59th anniversary. One son had already died suddenly in 2009 and 1 1/2 months after Mary's death, Don lost his other son. Despite those devastating blows, Don's faith in the Lord did not falter! His self-giving went on. Now that faith is being rewarded in an unexpected way as a lady who shares many of Mary's finest qualities came into his life. Don & Inge Colon will be married March 16 and we look forward to the many years that they will bless our parish.
