From Your Pastor!

“When we die with Christ, we rise with him.”

God has given us the gift of faith which strengthens our relationship with Him. He has revealed Himself to us through various ways. He made a way for his people in the sea and delivered them from the bondages of Egyptians. Did all those miracles that God performed make a lasting impact on the faith aspect of the people? The obvious answer is, ‘No!’ Therefore, eventually God revealed Himself through His Son; but they preferred darkness and rejected the light.

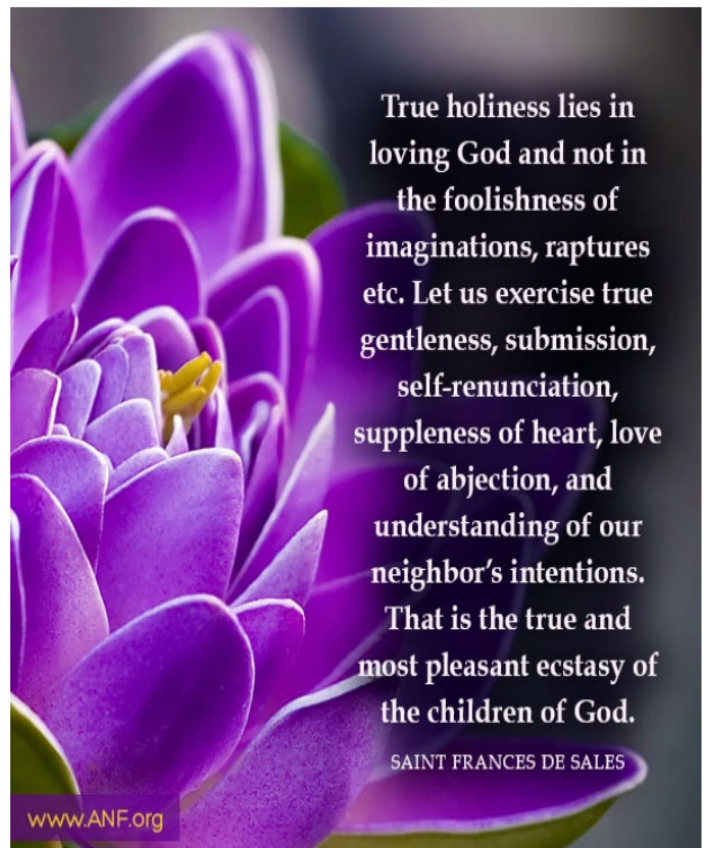
We get a ray of hope from St. Paul’s experience of the risen Lord. When Jesus revealed himself to Saul, he believed in Him and through this faith Saul became Paul, the apostle of Christ. He participated in Jesus’ resurrection by becoming like Christ in his suffering and death. Paul’s personal experience of the risen Lord changed his entire life. Paul confesses this faith by showing his total commitment in his mission. We too have received God’s revelation in our lives. Do we have enough faith and courage like St. Paul to express God’s love among the people?

Only the faith of the faithful keeps Christ alive in the midst of the people. Only when they express it to others in the society, it will bear fruit. Down the history, all the messages of God fulfilled their mission by revealing God even to the non-believers. Many a time, we lock up this message of God within ourselves. Are we ready to acknowledge God’s wonders in our life and share the unique gift of faith, which we have experienced in our lives? This faith goes beyond evidence and involves us into a personal relationship with God.

One of the participants in the Eucharistic Congress was sharing that he was atheist and just trying to be

good to his wife before their children attended the congress with his wife last year. Now, he comes back saying the event changed him. He says he met Christ there. Meeting Christ changed his life and now his family means completely different. With Christ in the family, family means lot more to him. Now he is a believer who shares his faith with others joyfully. He met Jesus person to person, I mean, he has been touched by His love. He is not the same.

Have you met Jesus? If you have, you will make your own the words of St. Paul: I look on everything as so much rubbish if only I can have Christ and be given a place in him. All I want is to know Christ. Do you?



True holiness lies in loving God and not in the foolishness of imaginations, raptures etc. Let us exercise true gentleness, submission, self-renunciation, suppleness of heart, love of abjection, and understanding of our neighbor’s intentions. That is the true and most pleasant ecstasy of the children of God.

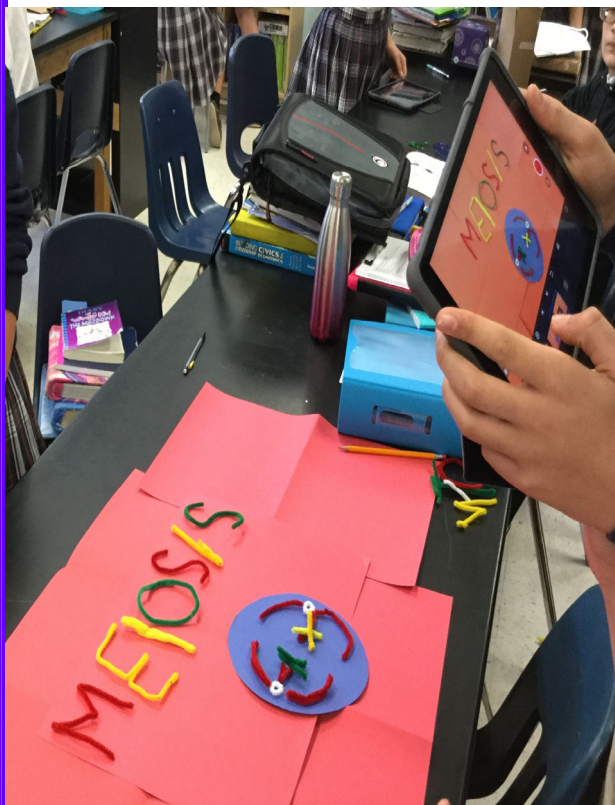

The sacrifice of Christ and the sacrifice of the Eucharist are one single sacrifice. According to the Council of Trent, the victim is one and the same. The only difference is the manner of offering: once bloody on the altar of the cross, now offered in an unbloody manner on the table of the altar. (CCC#1367)

Statement on Holy Ghost Father William Malone

Credible allegations of sexual abuse of a minor have been made against Father William Malone, a Holy Ghost Father who served in the Diocese of St. Augustine from January 1982 to March 1992.

The abuses occurred in the early 1980s at Sacred Heart Parish in Jacksonville.

A thorough review of the allegations was conducted by an independent investigator. Based on his report, the Diocesan Review Board found the allegations to be credible. The report has been shared with local law enforcement. Bishop Felipe Estévez has met with the victim to express his deep sorrow for the pain the victim has suffered, and he apologized on behalf of the church.

Father Malone served as an associate pastor at Sacred Heart Parish in Jacksonville from 1982 to 1991, and associate pastor at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in Palm Coast from 1991 to 1992. He moved to the Holy Ghost Fathers community in Long Island, N.Y. in March 1992. In Sept. 1993 he returned to the Ireland Province of the Holy Ghost Fathers where he remained until his death in 2003.

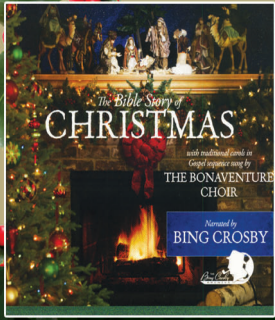

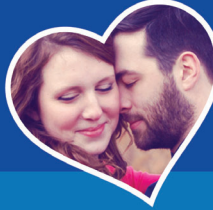
