

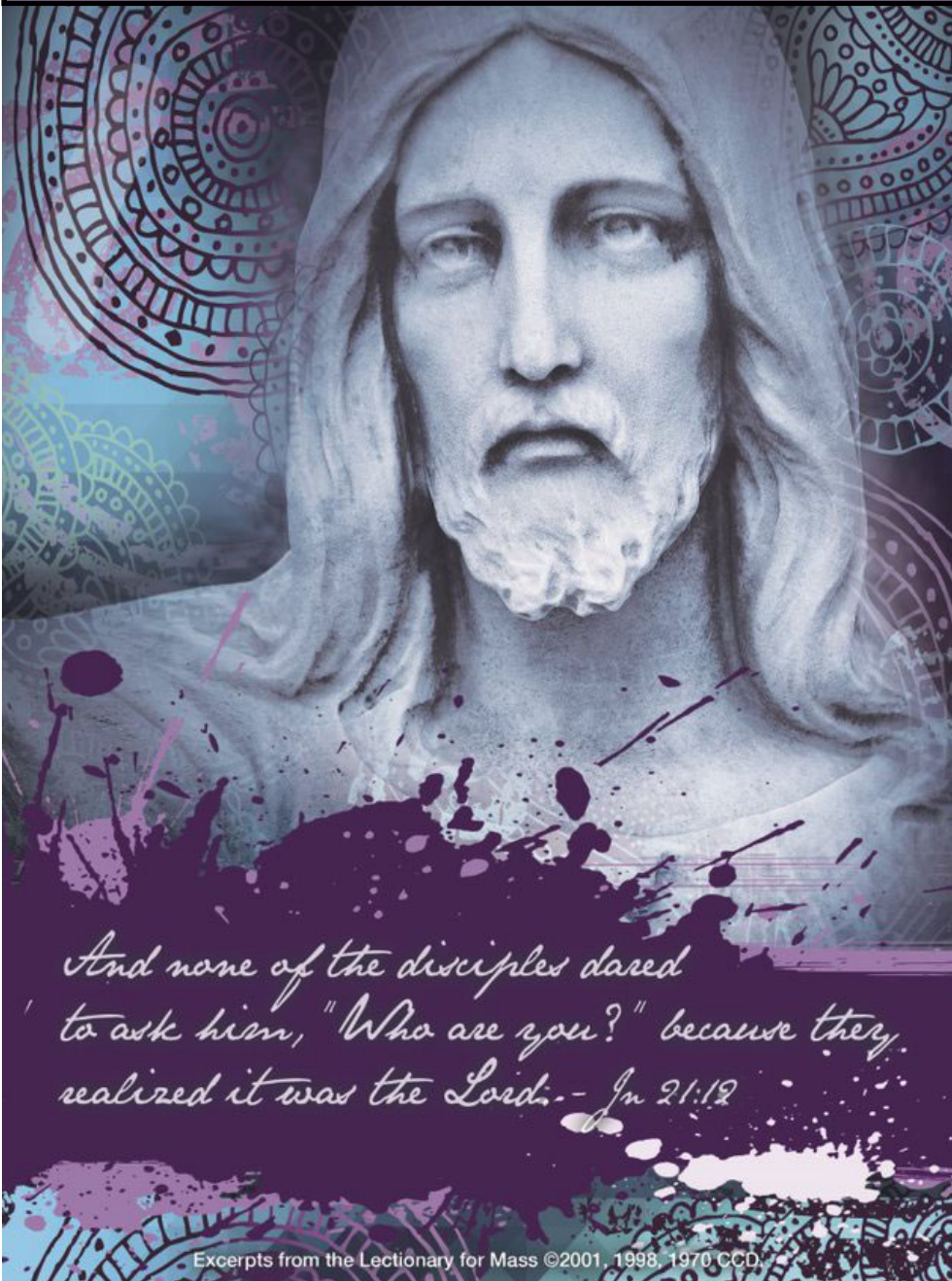

From the start the parents had the whole family involved in parish life in addition to their faithful attendance at mass on Saturday evening and holy days. As a family they participate spring and fall in beautifying the parish grounds. Both Steven and Marlene attended Holy Spirit school from pre-K thru grade 8 and then moved on to Bishop Kenny. For several years Steven was an altar server here and became an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) at both Bishop Kenny and Holy Spirit. He now attends UCF and remains active in his faith there. Marlene's activities and achievements are remarkable for one so young and are a reminder of what is possible when we allow the Holy Spirit to lead! Since 2011 she has sung in the choir at 5pm mass. In 2013 she began volunteering each summer at Vacation Bible School. In 2016 she became a CCD teacher, teaching third grade this year, and also helps conduct retreats for second and eighth graders preparing for the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. At Bishop Kenny she became an EMHC and also serves in that role in our parish. In the last month Marlene became the youngest member of the newly formed Parish Pastoral Council. Together, these acts of stewardship are an outstanding commitment to her faith and parish, made even more remarkable when you consider that Marlene is a high school senior, taking AP level courses! She will graduate this year and attend UNF. William and Maria set the bar high for their family and gave their children the example and encouragement they needed to aspire to lofty goals spiritually, socially and academically. Beloved Parishioners,

As members of the Church, **Jesus calls us to be disciples.** This has astonishing implications:

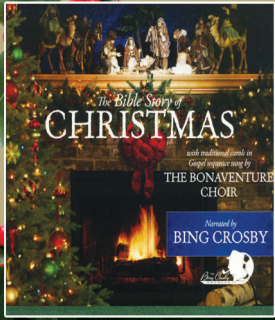
