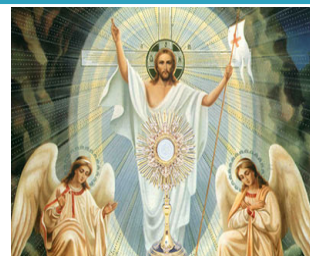
Living Marriage – Protecting the Bond
