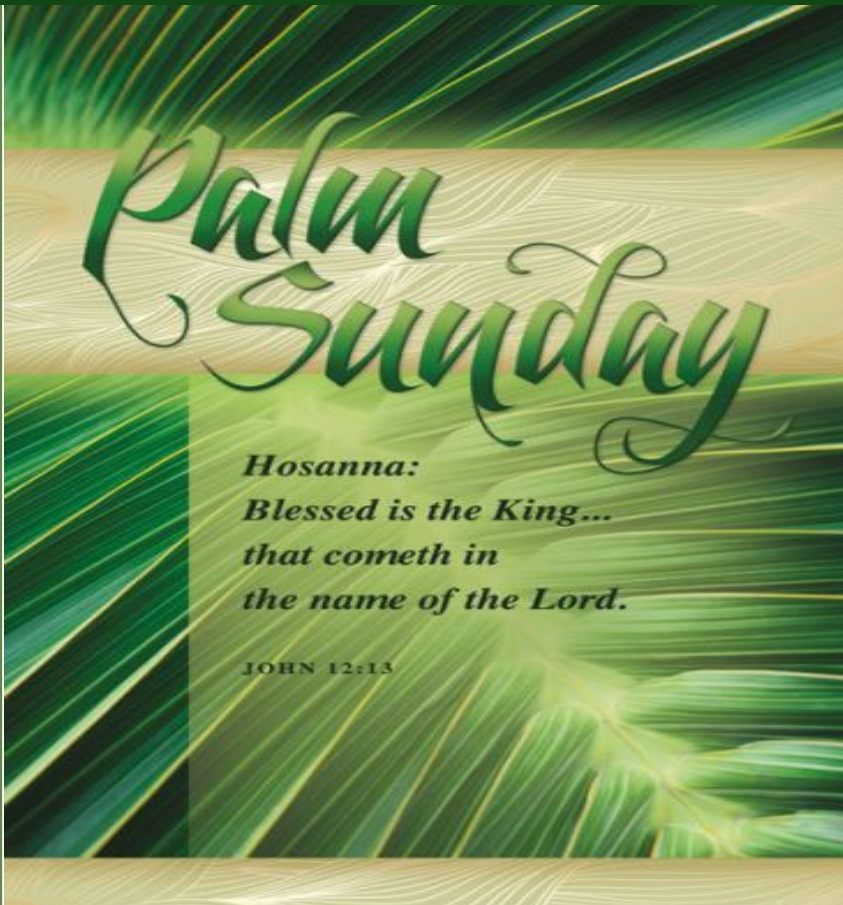

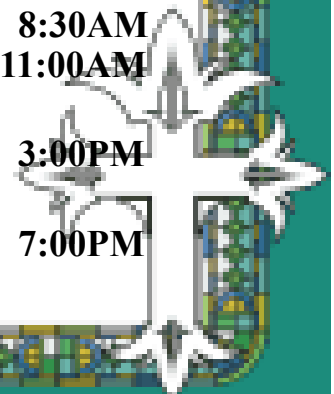

# SUNDAY REFLECTION FROM FR AMAR

Every year, at the beginning of the Mass on Palm Sunday, we are given palm branches, which we bless and wave to commemorate the Lord's entry into Jerusalem. (This year we may not have them). But these palm branches are not some kind of door gift or freebie that the church gives out once a year.



In fact, they are “loaned” to us because a year later we will collect them back to be burnt and used for ashes on Ash Wednesday. (That's have we do back at home).

We bring them back and place it in a prominent place at home or at the workplace or in the car.

It is a sign of our welcoming Jesus into the areas of our lives where we live out our faith.

These sturdy and spiky palm branches remind us to be firm and sturdy in our faith just as Jesus remained sturdy and firm in His Passion because of His love for us.

And those spiky needles of the palm branches remind us that life has its painful moments and there will be times when like Jesus we will cry out: My God, my God, why have you deserted me. But God will never desert us. Jesus suffered and died. But He rose from the dead. So, let us stay close to Jesus and we too will rise from our pain and sufferings.

In the Gospel today, Matthew go to great pains to show us that every event, every happening, every person involved in the passion and death of Jesus fulfills a passage from the Hebrew Scriptures.

The betrayal and abandonment of Jesus by his special friends, the innocent Jesus becoming the victim of religious and political conniving, the darkness and the skies and the dramatic ripping of the Temple veil - all are seen in light of the sacred scriptures of the Jewish people.

The proclamation of the centurion who has witnessed all these events is the surprised recognition from all the clues: “Clearly this was the Son of God.”

With that recognition, Matthew turns our attention back to the fidelity of the women who have been following Jesus from Galilee. They alone remained to witness the fulfillment. All the others had scattered in fear.

We are among the faithful who attend Jesus and will follow him through His passion and death. St. Paul tells us what we must be doing as we journey. We are to learn to live with the attitude that Jesus had toward life and its varied events. Suffering and glory will be so intertwined as to be inseparable.

Learning to accept whatever comes as coming from God's hand and doing it in obedience to the will of the God who is my Father, being willing to put aside any position so as to better love God and my neighbor - all of this is having the attitude of Christ.

May we all be open to learning more about life from Jesus this week.

Let us continue to pray for each other especially for doctors, nurses, first responders, healthcare workers and law enforcement who are helping to care for those inflicted with the Corona virus.

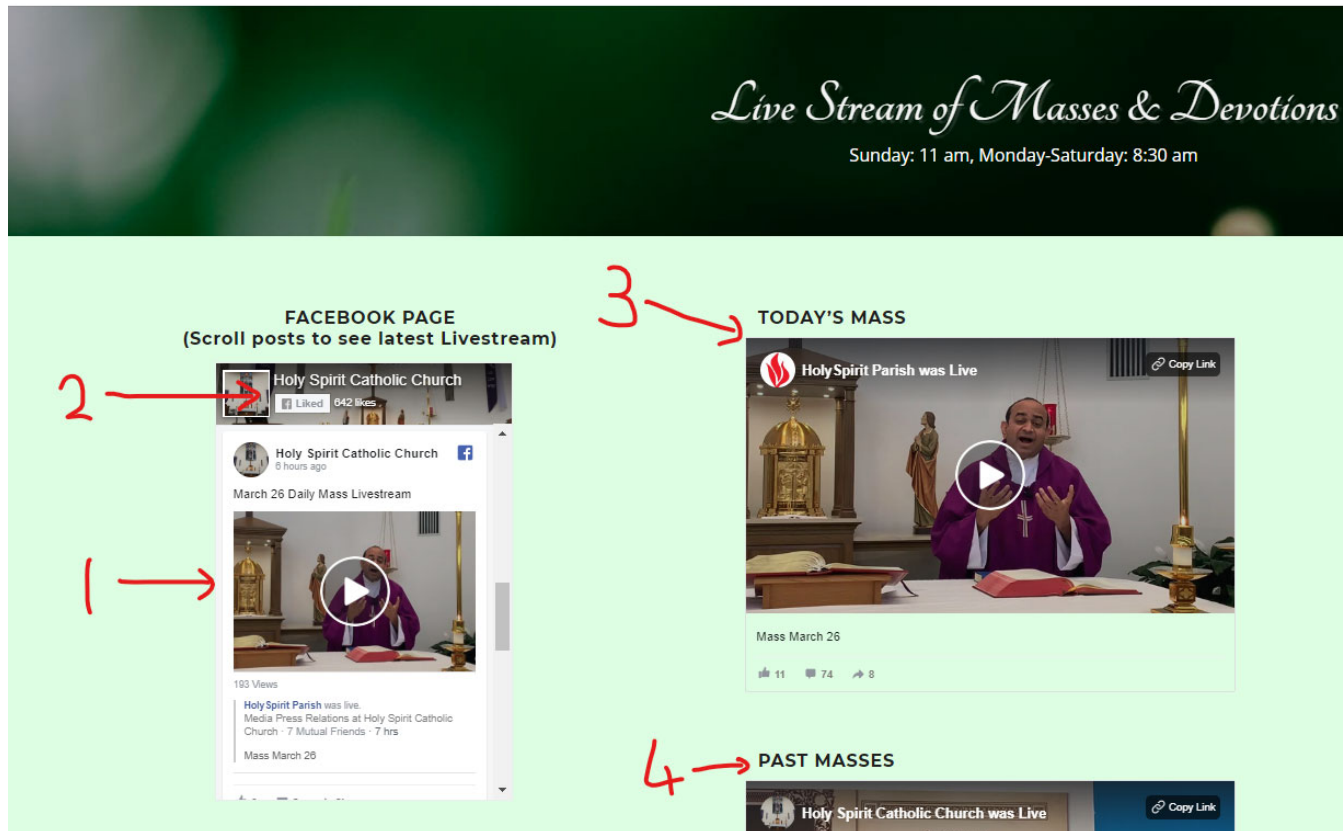
# LIVE STREAM INSTRUCTIONS & TIPS

Our website uses the feed/posts from Facebook Live to livestream.

You **do not need** a Facebook account to see our live stream as our videos are public.

See the highlighted items 1 - 4 on the image below and their explanations to understand how to best use it.

**1. Watch livestream on the website within the Facebook feed** - This is a direct feed to our official church Facebook page. Whatever is posted there shows up within this container on the site. Usually, the mass video goes live as soon as the mass starts, and within a few minutes, it will appear in this section as the latest item. This is real-time and you can directly click on/expand the video post and see the live stream on the church website.

**2. Use the website to go to the Facebook page and see live stream there.** Alternatively, users can click on the Facebook page banner image/name (where the likes are shown) and it will open up a new window where they can browse Facebook and see the live stream on the Facebook site.

**2. "Today's Mass" section on the website:** As soon as the mass goes live, the video link from Facebook is posted here as quickly as possible (usually within a few minutes). However, the internet servers take some time to update and propagate to the users' devices and may not update the earlier cached webpage version, so it is possible people will not see this update for quite some time, maybe up to an hour or more. This delay is beyond our control. This separate section is useful for viewers watching today's mass at a later time of the day.

**3. "Past masses" section on the website:** These are videos of the last 2-3 masses. They are available on our Facebook page among the posts, but these direct links help to get to it quickly. This section is always up to date.

We are still working out the kinks of our live streaming system and in case you happen to see any content not up to date in real-time, please click on the Facebook links available on the website which will take you directly to Facebook to watch the live stream there. Thank you for your patience and we are working on having these delayed issues sorted out soon!
