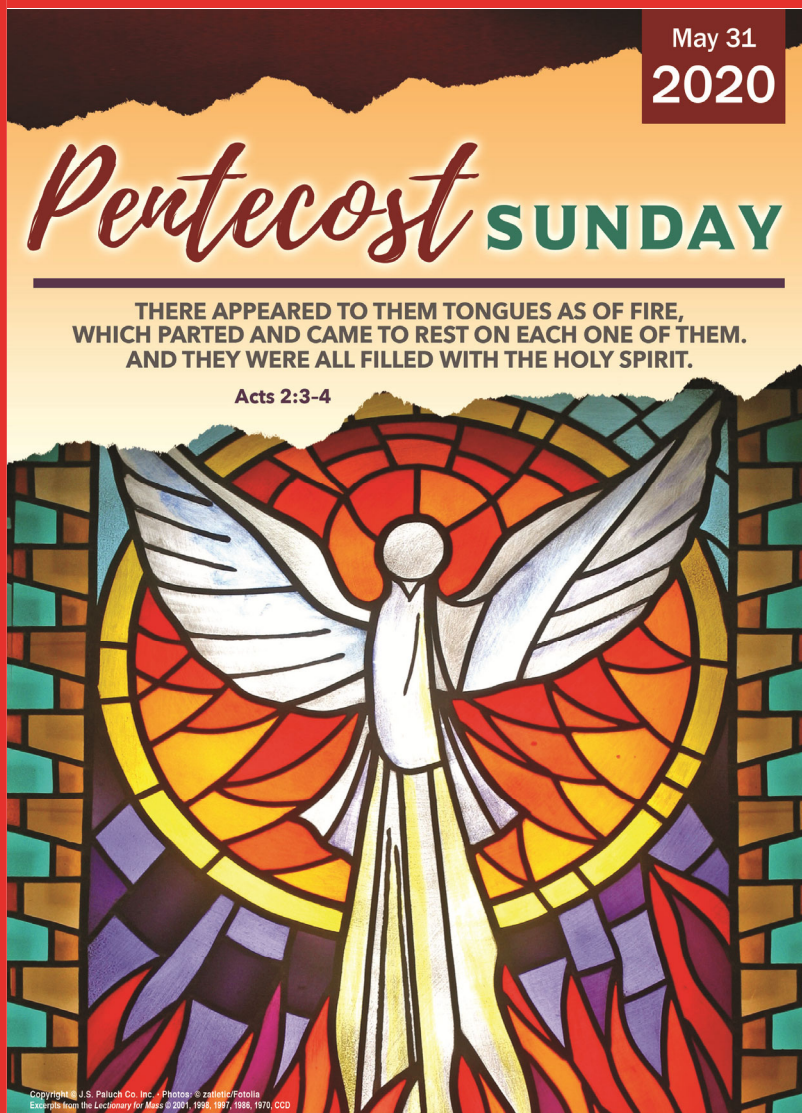

From our Pastor's Desk

PENTECOST SUNDAY: GOD'S POWER IS IN YOU.



Two weekends ago we began to have Mass open to the public for the first time in over two months. I wouldn't say that it was the most normal of circumstances for several reasons. We have to practice social distancing and be limited to 25% capacity. And judging by the numbers, people are still hesitant to interact in large groups. We also have to wear masks during Mass. It might not be the most normal of circumstances, but it was great celebrating Mass with parishioners again!

Today is Pentecost, the day of the great gathering and the day of the great sending out. And it is our Parish Feast Day. It is very different this year. Normally, we would have international feast to celebrate this joyous day. However, due to the current Coronavirus pandemic, we will have to postpone this to a future date TBD.

What was the setting of the first Pentecost? When Jesus died the disciples were shattered. Their lives had collapsed. They sat there dazed and despondent in the upper room. They had forgotten that Jesus had said, "It is better for you that I go away... if I go away, I will send another Helper to you." Jesus came among us and offered his life so that when raised to the right hand of the Father he could send the Holy Spirit. Remember, on his Resurrection day his first act was to breathe on his disciples and gave them the Spirit.

What about us? Each of us has been baptized in the Holy Spirit. But it is not enough just to know this. We must experience it. The Holy Spirit is God's Love and the Source of God's power. He is in you and in me. This fact should become a dynamic reality. As he changed disciples from being fearful and despondent into being people of great wisdom, knowledge and courage, so he must change us.

How is this to come about? After Ascension the disciples with Mary the Mother of Jesus spent their time in earnest prayer. If we want to have the experience of the Spirit in our lives, we need to pray for him daily. Each day we need to be anointed by him. Daily we need to grow in our capacity to receive him.

We are the disciples of this generation and we need to be filled again and again as were the first disciples. (Acts 4: 23ff). It is the longing to receive the Spirit and the desire for the Spirit to recreate us that will bring about miracles in our lives. The Father longs for the Spirit to come into our lives with power: "how much more will the Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him" (Luke 11: 13).

What happens then? When the Holy Spirit comes into a person and into a family, great things happen. First, they experience the fruits of the Spirit coming: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, humility, gentleness, self-control.

There will be more fruits too: Compassion for one another, meekness, bearing with one another and forgiving one another and harmonious living together. They will have a great love for the Word of God and will pray with gratitude. Through the Holy Spirit we can overcome every kind of sin and addiction. This is not by our own efforts, but because the Holy Spirit is within us. The difference between a person with the Spirit and without is the difference between mid-day and mid-night.

Where do you stand? Why not surrender to the Spirit now and invite him earnestly into your life? Spend time in prayer for him daily. Then you will experience the new life.

Do you believe that your happiness is in your hands?

MASS RESUMPTION GUIDELINES - 1

As of this week Bishop Felipe Estevez, Bishop of St. Augustine, has granted us permission to begin the re-opening of public Masses! However, the dispensation from the obligation to attend is still in effect. There is no obligation to attend Mass in the Diocese of St. Augustine. Our Live Stream will remain available for the 11am Sunday Mass and the weekday Masses.

We had our first public Masses at Holy Spirit on Saturday, May 16th at 5:00pm and Sunday 8:15am and 11am.

Daily Masses resumed to the regular schedule i.e. at 8:30am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and at 7pm on Wednesday.

Holy Hour of Adoration: Tuesday & Friday 3:00 - 4:00pm.

These procedures will be re-evaluated weekly depending on the COVID19 situation in the state of Florida and country. If you would like to attend Mass, please read through this message. Thank you for your patience and compliance.

CAPACITY & SEAT RESERVATION

- ◆ For now, Masses will be limited to 25% capacity.
- ◆ In order to accommodate this limited seating, parishioners must reserve their seats **ONLINE ONLY** before each weekend.
- ◆ Registrations for each weekend will open the prior Monday at 10am, and ends on Thursday 4pm or when we meet our maximum capacity.
- ◆ For seat reservations please visit our parish website at www.holyspiritchurchjax.com.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

- ◆ Wash your hands.
- ◆ For ages 2 and up, face coverings are required on our campus and for the duration of Mass.
- ◆ Bring your own hand sanitizer or wipes that can be used before receiving Holy Communion.
- ◆ Please **DO NOT** bring items that contain bleach into the church as this will damage the pews.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

- ◆ Masks (for ages 2+) should be worn as soon as you exit your vehicle. In case that you will not have a mask, the parish will provide you what you need by donation.
- ◆ Arrive at least 15 minutes before Mass begins to stand in line 6 ft. from each other.
- ◆ The main doors of the church will open 15 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
- ◆ The church will be seated to fill the open pews from front to back. An usher will direct you to your seat.
- ◆ You may be sharing a pew with another household, but social distance is required between the households (6 ft).
- ◆ The holy water fonts remain empty.

MASS RESUMPTION GUIDELINES - 2

MASS PROCEDURES

- ◆ Masses will be celebrated as you have seen on the Live Stream with reduced volunteer lay ministers. There will be no altar servers.
- ◆ Communion will be distributed by clergy and assigned Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion.
- ◆ Please wear your face mask on for the entire duration of Mass.
- ◆ There is to be no physical contact between different households at the Sign of Peace or hand-holding during the Lord's Prayer.
- ◆ Baskets will not be passed during the offertory. You will be able to place your weekly gift in a basket at the exit doors of the Church but we strongly encourage online giving through our website link
- ◆ <https://giving.parishsoft.com/app/giving/holy1166175>

COMMUNION PROCEDURES

- ◆ Bishop Estevez has asked that communion be received in the hand only for the time being.
- ◆ The precious blood will not be offered to the congregation.
- ◆ Use of personal hand sanitizer before communion is strongly encouraged.
- ◆ There will only be two communion lines in the church maintaining a 6ft. distance between households.
- ◆ Ushers will guide the communion line.
- ◆ Masks should be worn in the communion line. After the priest offers you communion, please step to the side, remove your mask, consume the Eucharist, and then re-mask your face as you return to your pew.
- ◆ For those who participate in Mass via live stream, Holy Communion will be distributed by the Ten Commandments in the Portico for 30 minutes following each weekend Mass. The mask requirement, explained above, will also apply to those coming for Communion.

DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

- ◆ After the final blessing, parishioners must remain in their pew. Each person will depart the church after Mass in an orderly manner, from the back to the front. And the Ushers will guide your way out.
- ◆ You can drop your weekly offertory in the special baskets when you come in for Mass or when you depart.
- ◆ Clergy will not shake hands; they will wave as you exit.
- ◆ Please do not congregate outside after Mass.

CHURCH CLEANING PROCEDURES

- ◆ Our church will be completely sanitized with a viral disinfectant on Friday May 15 prior to re-opening. Thanks to our parishioner, Mark Tolleson, owner of Process Master.
- ◆ We will continue to implement cleanliness and sanitation practices, including disinfecting pews between every Mass.
- ◆ Disinfecting will be done for bathrooms, door handles, and other frequently touched surfaces that occur throughout the day.
- ◆ Please follow the CDC recommendations regarding your own health. If you fall into an "at-risk" category, please stay home and join us by Live Stream.
- ◆ Any weddings, funerals, and baptisms that are scheduled will all be in accordance with the Diocese of St. Augustine and the protocol.

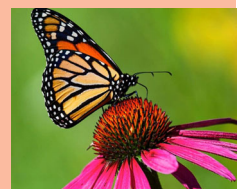

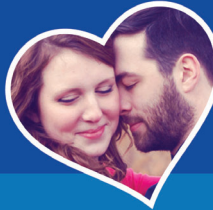
