From our Pastor's Desk

Today the church celebrates Trinity Sunday. It's a great mystery, and trying to define the Trinity is like trying to pour all the water of the ocean into a hole in the sand. But certain symbols can help us meditate and reflect on the mystery of the Holy Trinity, like the triangle, the shamrock, the three forms of water, steam and ice which are substantially the same, etc.



But essentially, the mystery of the Holy Trinity revolves around the mystery of love between the three Persons in one God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. And that love is poured out to humanity, who is made in the image of God, so that we can love one another with the love of God who is Trinity.

What did Jesus say in the gospel? God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may not be lost but may have eternal life (John 3:16).

There are three profound moments when the love of God entered into the world, and these are: **1. At Bethlehem when God was with us, 2. At Calvary when God was for us and 3. At Pentecost when God is in us.** These three profound moments symbolize how the love of God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit entered into the world and poured out their love for the world.

So there are many symbols that point to God. At times they point to just one Person of the Trinity, and at times they point to the three Persons in one God.

Our problem is that we learn so many truths but they don't mean anything to us. If they did, they would transform us. One such truth is that God is your father and loves you. He conceived you in his heart before the world was made. He knew your name and chose you for his own (Ephesians 1:3). He wanted a child whom he could love and with whom he could share his life and everything he has.

So, the Creator called you by name. You are his. He will always be with you. You are precious to him, and he will honor you because he loves you (Isaiah 43:1-4). Your parents may forget you, but he will never forget you. He has your image on the palm of his hand (Isaiah 49:15). You are co-heir with his only Son (Gal 4:7).

Why all this? It was to reveal his love for each of us that the Father sent his Son, Jesus. Because, no one knows the father except the Son and those to whom he has revealed him (Matthew 11:28). Jesus is the image of the invisible God and loved his own in the world to perfection (John 13:1).

Who are his own? Anyone who follows the light of his conscience belongs to Jesus even if he does not know him. Those who accept him as Lord and Savior become the children of his Father.

Many of us have been given a false image of God. Many see him as one who punishes and sends to hell, who tries to make life hard for us and sends us trials and sicknesses, who forbids just what we would like to do. He is vindictive and a spoil sport. These are false images of God. If anyone goes to hell, it is their choice, not God's.

The Father welcomes us home like the father in the story of the prodigal son. He is so glad to see him again that he treats him not as a wastrel but as his beloved son (Luke 15:20). This is Jesus' image of the Father. He is the God who gets down on his knees and washes our feet treating us as beloved and honored guests (John 13: 1ff). He is the God who gives himself to us till he can give no more and hangs limp on the Cross having poured out his life for us.

What is your image of God? How do you see him? What is your attitude to him?

FRANSALIANS

Holy Spirit parish is served by the Missionaries of Saint Francis de Sales. We had Fr. Ananda Prasad Maddineni MSFS, Fr. Anthony Bonela MSFS and now Fr. Amar Nath Nagothu MSFS. Missionaries of Saint Francis de Sales are also known as Fransalian Missionaries (Fransalians).

Who are the Fransalians? The Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (M.S.F.S), known as “Fransalians”, is an international Congregation of Latin Rite, founded on October 24, 1838 in Annecy, France by Servant of God, Peter Marie Mermier. The primary patron of the Congregation is St. Francis de Sales and the secondary patroness is Mother of Compassion (Mother of Sorrows). The spirituality of our Congregation is “Salesian” and we belong to the Salesian family though our particular identity is as “Fransalians”. The apostolate of our Congregation is parish mission, foreign mission, education, evangelization and innovative ministries. The Congregation is currently involved actively in pastoral ministry in 33 Countries across 7 Continents of the world. The Generalate (headquarters) of our Congregation is in Rome, Italy.

The Fransalians have been serving the Church in the United States since 1969 beginning with the Archdiocese of Atlanta, Georgia. 72 Fransalian priests currently working in the United States in different capacities. Fransalians are currently engaged in pastoral ministry in different areas of apostolate in 23 Arch/Dioceses of 14 states of the US. Our Provincial House is located at 3887 Rosebud Road, Loganville-Atlanta, Georgia 30052-4656.

We have a lay association called “*Fransalian Associates*” who are men and women who wish to formally associate themselves with the mission and ministry of the religious Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales. Fransalian Associates are lay Catholics in good standing above the age of 18, or any consecrated diocesan or religious clergy who wish to associate with the Fransalians by following the spirit and spirituality of St. Francis de Sales, the Gentleman Saint.

Who is a Fransalian?: A Fransalian is a man called to be a missionary with a vision; an explorer of the unknown; a builder of communities; a sower of God’s words; an enlightened guide to his students; a formator for the unformed; a joyful herald of God’s reign on Earth in the spirit of St. Francis de Sales by following the 7 principal virtues of Salesian spirituality which are simplicity, humility, charity, optimism, gentleness, humanness, and resignation to the will of God in daily life.

Fransalian Mission: To Witness and Proclaim God’s Kingdom in a spirit of Service to Man. To be effective witness, a Fransalian needs to Read the Signs of Times, Equip himself with Ever Growing Knowledge, be Open to Live the Culture of his People, be Courageous to Respond to their Needs with Missionary Zeal in Solidarity with his Fellow Religious.

Fransalian Vision: Fransalian is a Man of Deep Faith which is Sustained by his Daily Experience of Communion with God and through Realization of God’s presence in his Life, in the Community and in the Events of History. He lives the Fransalian Charism of Joyful Holiness, Confident Optimism, Firm Gentleness, Cheerful Availability, Hospitality, Genuine Humanness and Positive Regard for the others.

Fransalian Prayer: Faith enough to seek You; Regard enough to admire you; Awareness enough to love You; Noble enough to share You; Strength enough to look into Oneself; Affection enough to forsake Oneself; Loyal enough to be honest with Oneself; Ideal enough to inspire the World; Able enough to transform the Community; and Nourishing grace enough to be All to All.

MISSIONARIES OF ST. FRANCIS DE SALES

ST. FRANCIS DE SALES

St. Francis de Sales (1567–1622) is noted for his deep faith and his gentle approach to the religious divisions resulting from the Protestant Reformation. A Doctor of the Church, he is known for his writings on the topic of spiritual direction and spiritual formation, particularly the *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *Treatise on the Love of God*.

Francis de Sales was convinced that God sees humanity as a great and varied garden, each person beautiful in his or her uniqueness. The various callings of life – soldier, prince, widow, married woman – are like the various flowers of the field; God loves them all. Through his or her own calling, each person can find a way to a deeper friendship with his or her creator. Francis approached people with genuine respect and gently guided them to recognize the unique path they would take in life. He made the journey to God joyful and possible for everyone to make. Above all, he advised against despair and the burden of fear.



Go courageously to do whatever you are called to do. If you have any fears, say to your soul: "The Lord will provide for us." If your weakness troubles you, cast yourselves on God, and trust in him. The apostles were mostly unlearned fishermen, but God gave them learning enough for the work they had to do. Trust in him, depend on his providence; fear nothing.

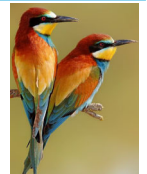

GUIDELINES FOR CELEBRATING PUBLIC MASS

We are glad to let you know that we have resumed our traditional schedule for the public celebration of Mass.

Week day Mass Schedule: Mon - 8:30am, Tue - 8:30am, Wed 7:00pm w/Miraculous Medal Novena, Thu - 8:30am, Fri - 8:30am

Weekend Mass Schedule: Sat - 5:00pm, Sun - 8:15am & 11:00am

Although we are very appreciative of the opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist and other sacraments together, our priority remains to be the safety and wellbeing of all of us.

Important to know:

- The Bishop's dispensation of the Sunday obligation will continue until further notice.
- Those with health risks and concerns should remain home as well as anyone who is ill.
- Holy Spirit parish will continue to provide livestream Mass for those unable to attend in person.

Proper Social Distancing:

- ❖ Those who wish to participate in public Mass at Holy Spirit must wear a face mask or suitable face coverings.
- ❖ The church has been prepared to accommodate the faithful with proper social distancing of 6ft. between individuals. Please be mindful that families can sit together in a pew.
- ❖ Bring your own hand sanitizer or wipes that can be used before receiving Holy Communion.
- ❖ Please **DO NOT** bring items that contain bleach into the church as this will damage the pews.
- ❖ The main doors of the church will open 15 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
- ❖ An usher will direct you to your seat.

Mass Procedures:

- ❖ The holy water fonts remain empty.
- ❖ Please wear your face mask on for the entire duration of Mass.
- ❖ There is to be no physical contact between different households at the Sign of Peace or hand-holding during the Lord's Prayer.
- ❖ Baskets will not be passed during the offertory. You will be able to place your weekly gift in a basket at the exit doors of the Church but we strongly encourage online giving through our website link

- ❖ Holy Communion will only be distributed in the hand for the time being.
- ❖ Use of personal hand sanitizer before communion is strongly encouraged.
- ❖ Ushers will guide the communion line.
- ❖ **Masks should be worn in the communion line. After the minister offers you communion, please step to the side, remove your mask, consume the Eucharist, and then re-mask your face as you return to your pew.**
- ❖ After the final blessing, parishioners must remain in their pew. Ushers will guide your way out.
- ❖ **Please do not congregate outside after Mass.**

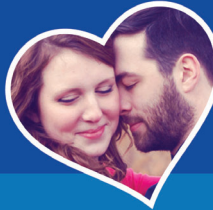
