## From our Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends in Christ,

It's already a month since we began to have Mass open to the public. I wouldn't say that it is the most normal of circumstances for several reasons. Judging by the numbers, people are still hesitant to interact in large groups. We also have to practice social distancing and wear masks during Mass. It might not be the most normal of circumstances, but it is great celebrating Mass with parishioners again!



Even with all these abnormal circumstances, celebrating Mass with people is always better than “Mass online.” Why? The reason might be more theological than you think! While watching Mass online has helped many people stay connected to the parish during the current health crisis, technically, watching Mass is not the same as participating in Mass.

Our faith is incarnational and fully embraces the dignity of what it means to be human (God became man!). By nature, humans are social beings, which means real human interaction is essential to who we are. God's grace works to perfect our human nature, and does so by working with and building upon our human nature. We receive God's grace in a unique way through the sacraments, which require our real presence. Think about the sacraments... you have to be there to receive them! There are no “virtual sacraments.” Remember, the Eucharist is about the real presence, not the virtual presence.

Today we celebrate the real presence of **Christ in the Eucharist**, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Here are some thoughts of St. Francis de Sales on the Eucharist.

Jesus left a distinguishing mark for his community. It is to be love and concern. When we gather it should always be gathering of fellowship marked by love for one another. Figuratively it is a gathering of people who wash each other's feet. This should be manifested in every Church gathering, in every Mass. This is of the essence of the true community of Christ. This is Christ's dream.

What is the reality in our church? What are you doing to realize his dream? In every human celebration, friends eat together. When as the family of the Father, we gather in the Spirit to remember Jesus, he wants us to eat together.

The father who loves us provides the banquet. He sends his Son as our food. There is one bread and one cup. “The bread is my flesh for the life of the world”. Anyone who drinks from the cup has communion “with the blood of Christ”. Jesus is not just one among us. We are one in him, in his body. We are Christ. He lives in us and we live through him. He wants to be everywhere throughout the world in and through his communities.

Can you say our parish is the Body of Christ in our neighborhood? Can people see Jesus living in you?

As these abnormal circumstances continue, please remember that the obligation to attend Mass is suspended. If you are uncomfortable coming to Mass for any reason, please know that you do not have to come for the time being. Be united with your Holy Spirit family through live-stream. Keep reading the scriptures. Keep leaning on your faith. Keep praying.

# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART - 1

## SACRED HEART OF JESUS AND THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY



The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is celebrated throughout the world on the Friday following the Feast of Corpus Christi. Feast day of the Immaculate Heart of Mary falls on the day after the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus because devotion to these two hearts was promoted together as a means of entering more deeply into the mystery of God's love.

### *The Sacred Heart of Jesus*

The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents Christ's divine love for us. A human element of who Jesus is. The devotion especially emphasizes the compassion and long-suffering of the heart of Christ towards humanity. The Sacred Heart of Jesus is not only radiant with love for us, but it is a wounded heart, encircled by thorns, and pierced—the heart we tried to kill, a love we tried to extinguish.

The feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was first celebrated on August 31, 1670 in France. Celebration of the feast spread but it took the visions of St. Marguerite Marie Alacoque (1647-1690) for it to become universal. From the time she was twenty, she experienced visions of Christ, and on December 27, 1673, she began a series of revelations that were to continue over the next year and a half. In them Christ informed her that she was his chosen instrument to spread devotion to his Sacred Heart.

# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART - 2

## *Prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus*

O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you, I love you, and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure, and wholly obedient to your will. Grant good Jesus, that I may live in you and for you. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen

## *Immaculate Heart of Mary*

Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary focuses on Mary's love for God, her maternal love for her son, Jesus, and encourages us to imitate her humility, gratitude, obedience, and adoration. The roses surrounding Mary's heart represent her sinlessness and purity, sweetness, and new life. The sword piercing the top of the heart represents her redemptive suffering as a "spiritual crucifixion."

As far back as the thirteenth century, devotions to the Heart of Mary were popular. In the midst of WWII, Pope Pius XII put the whole world under the special protection of our Savior's mother by consecrating it to her Immaculate Heart. In 1944 he decreed that in the future the whole Church should celebrate the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary as we know it today.

## *Novena Prayer to the Immaculate Heart of Mary*

O Most Blessed Mother, heart of love, heart of mercy, ever listening, caring, consoling, hear our prayer. As your children, we implore your intercession with Jesus your Son. Receive with understanding and compassion the petitions we place before you today, especially ... (special intention).

We are comforted in knowing your heart is ever open to those who ask for your prayer. We trust to your gentle care and intercession, those whom we love and who are sick or lonely or hurting. Help all of us, Holy Mother, to bear our burdens in this life until we may share eternal life and peace with God forever. Amen.

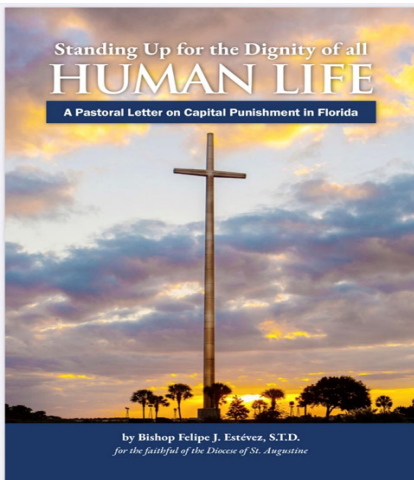

## GUIDELINES FOR CELEBRATING PUBLIC MASS

We are glad to let you know that we have resumed our traditional schedule for the public celebration of Mass.

**Week day Mass Schedule:** Mon - 8:30am, Tue - 8:30am, Wed 7:00pm w/Miraculous Medal Novena, Thu - 8:30am, Fri - 8:30am

**Weekend Mass Schedule:** Sat - 5:00pm, Sun - 8:15am & 11:00am

Although we are very appreciative of the opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist and other sacraments together, our priority remains to be the safety and wellbeing of all of us.

### Important to know:

- The Bishop's dispensation of the Sunday obligation will continue until further notice.
- Those with health risks and concerns should remain home as well as anyone who is ill.
- Holy Spirit parish will continue to provide livestream Mass for those unable to attend in person.

### Proper Social Distancing:

- ❖ Those who wish to participate in public Mass at Holy Spirit must wear a face mask or suitable face coverings.
- ❖ The church has been prepared to accommodate the faithful with proper social distancing of 6ft. between individuals. Please be mindful that families can sit together in a pew.
- ❖ Bring your own hand sanitizer or wipes that can be used before receiving Holy Communion.
- ❖ Please **DO NOT bring** items that contain bleach into the church as this will damage the pews.
- ❖ The main doors of the church will open 15 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
- ❖ An usher will direct you to your seat.

### Mass Procedures:

- ❖ The holy water fonts remain empty.
- ❖ Please wear your face mask on for the entire duration of Mass.
- ❖ There is to be no physical contact between different households at the Sign of Peace or hand-holding during the Lord's Prayer.
- ❖ Baskets will not be passed during the offertory. You will be able to place your weekly gift in a basket at the exit doors of the Church but we strongly encourage online giving through our website link

- ❖ Holy Communion will only be distributed in the hand for the time being.
- ❖ Use of personal hand sanitizer before communion is strongly encouraged.
- ❖ Ushers will guide the communion line.
- ❖ **Masks should be worn in the communion line. After the minister offers you communion, please step to the side, remove your mask, consume the Eucharist, and then re-mask your face as you return to your pew.**
- ❖ After the final blessing, parishioners must remain in their pew. Ushers will guide your way out.
- ❖ **Please do not congregate outside after Mass.**
- ❖ We will continue to implement cleanliness and sanitation practices, including disinfecting pews between every Mass.

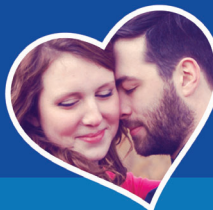
