Statement on the Events of January 6, 2021

My brothers and sisters in Christ:

Like you, I found the events that took place in our nation's capital this week very distressing. 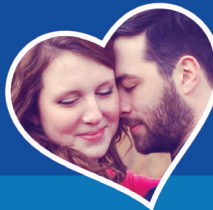
