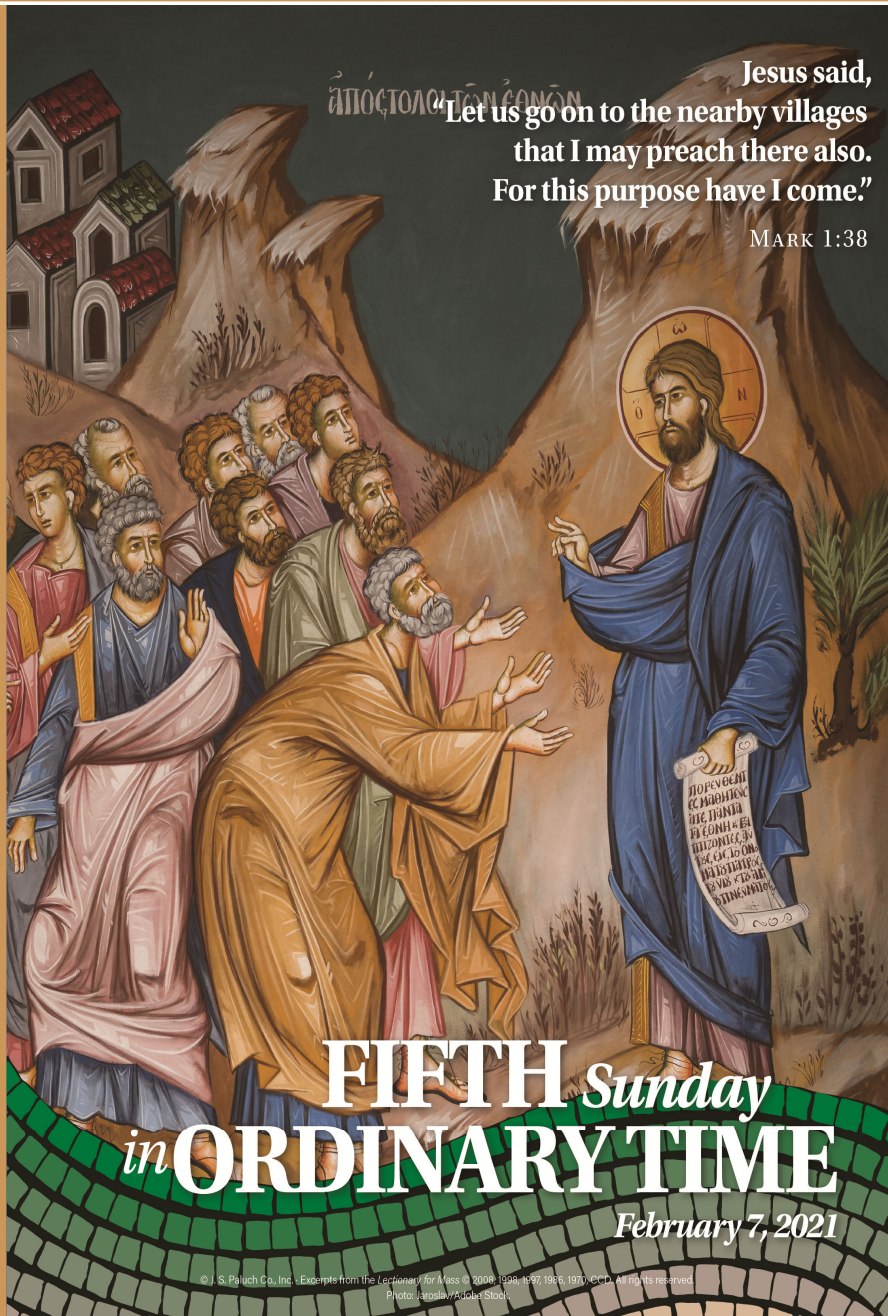

## **A SAME BUT DIFFERENT ASH WEDNESDAY IN 2021**

The past year has been filled with different ways of living as well as worshipping. There are fewer people in church. No holy water in the font. Communion only in the hand. No coffee and doughnuts. Yet we still worship and pray.

Instead of giving ashes as a cross on the forehead – which has been deemed unsafe in this time of the COVID-19 pandemic -- we can still receive them by sprinkling on the top of the head (permitted by our ritual rules of the Church). We will look a little cleaner, yet we will still be called to repentance and conversion of heart. We will still bear ashes home to begin the disciplines of Lent, just not in the manner we have been used to over time.

Step Up For Students has scholarship programs for Florida schoolchildren, including two income-based scholarships and a scholarship for children with certain special needs.

## Income-Based Scholarships

Two income-based scholarships are available: the **Florida Tax Credit Scholarship** and **Family Empowerment Scholarship**.<sup>\*</sup> Both scholarships give students an option to find the best schools to meet their K-12 learning needs. Please review the income guidelines to see if your family qualifies.

## Special Needs Scholarship

The **Gardiner Scholarship** helps Florida families customize education for their children with certain special needs who are ages 3 through 22. The scholarship includes 17 diagnoses, including autism spectrum disorder, anaphylaxis and intellectual disability. Parents can use scholarship money toward a combination of approved programs and providers that best meet their children's unique learning needs.

## FOR THE AWARENESS OF THE FAITHFUL

Please be aware that there are churches that call themselves “Catholic” but are not in full communion with the Holy Father Pope Francis nor do they recognize his authority. This is provided for your awareness as your parishes are proximate to the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX) church or chapel. The bishop’s guidelines regarding Catholic Churches of the diocese are not embraced by the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX) chapel as they operate here in the Diocese of St. Augustine without the permission of the Ordinary and they are not fully in communion with Rome. Although Pope Francis continues initiatives in order to bring the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX) into full communion, we are not there yet.

This means that the Masses offered by the priests of the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX) are valid, but illicit. While it is true that participation in the Mass at chapels of the Society of St. Pius X does not of itself constitute ‘formal adherence to the schism’ (cf. *Ecclesia Dei* 5, c), such adherence can come about over a period of time as one slowly imbibes a schismatic mentality which separates itself from the teaching of the Supreme Pontiff and the entire Catholic Church.

We hope that parishioners understand the relationship of the Church and the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX) regarding their attendance, Mass, and the sacraments. If it is the *extraordinary form* of the Mass you seek, parishioners will do well to attend Masses offered by parishes of the diocese and celebrated by a priest who is in good standing with the Roman Catholic Church. Even if some further resolution to the status of the SSPX community is achieved, Catholics in the Diocese of St. Augustine are strongly encouraged to attend their local parish to fulfill their Sunday obligation.

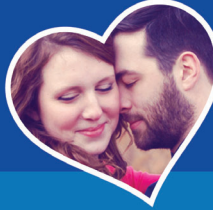
