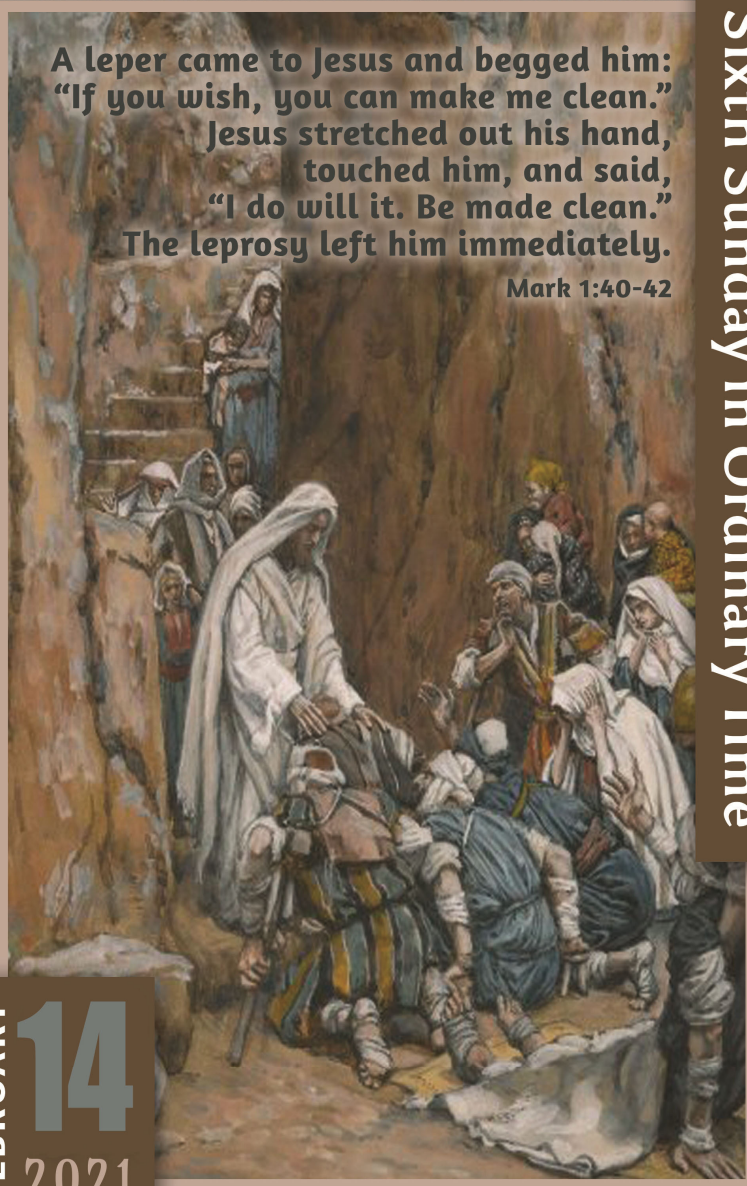

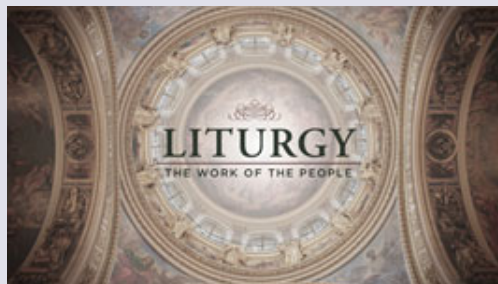

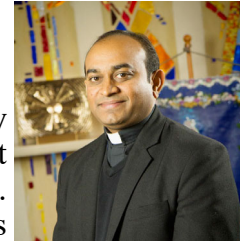

## FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

Beloved of Holy Spirit Family,

It is so wonderful to be back at the parish. I have missed you as I went on my vacation to India to visit my family and friends. Thank you for your prayers, for it was a wonderful time with my family, friends and my religious community. My family extends their greetings to you all especially my mother. She thanks you all for all the love and care you give me.



Wednesday, February 17 we begin our Lenten Journey. Ash Wednesday we have two Masses: 8:30 AM and 7:00PM. Fridays in Lent we gather together in the Church to pray the Stations of the Cross. You could come either at 2:00 PM or at 7:00 PM to pray the Stations of the Cross. Let us make use of this beautiful time to grow closer to the Lord.

Don't give up something for Lent but reflect on how we could change ourselves to be better people. Examine your conscience and find out that one thing that's holding you from becoming better version of yourself. Let's make an effort to become a better version of ourselves as children of God for the Word of God invites us to an ever more authentic conversion of heart.

St. Francis de Sales wrote in his **Introduction to the Devout Life**: "There is scarcely anyone without some imperfections." (Part 3, Chapter 22)

We have a good handle on the imperfections, vices, idiosyncrasies and even the sins of those with whom we work, we play, we neighbor and we live each day. Most days we overlook them. Some days we put up with them. Other days, we might even make excuses for them. Occasionally, we dwell on – maybe even magnify – them.

Sometimes it is necessary to draw attention to things in other people that blemish their potential for happiness, health, and holiness. Sometimes we need to take the risk to name the sins, the faults and the wounds in others that prevent them from being more of who God calls them to be.

The weekend's Scriptures contrast two quite different methods for doing this. One approach draws attention to others' sins to isolate them, ostracize them or distance them from the community. The other approach – Jesus' approach – is to draw them even more closely into the life of the community, to create a space in which the "unclean" can experience healing, strength, and a new lease on life.

**Ask yourself the question:** When you do draw attention to the imperfections, the warts, the blemishes of others, why do you do it? To distance yourself from them? To embarrass them? To humiliate them? Or are you reaching out, reaching into the heart of others? Is your goal to create a space of truth in which they can experience healing, forgiveness, reconciliation and strength? Do you intend it as an opportunity for a new beginning?

Let us be clear and unambiguous about our own sin and weakness. Be clear and unambiguous about our own need for healing and forgiveness. Be clear about our own need for friends who will not only sometimes tell us what we want to hear about ourselves, but who will consistently have the courage to tell us what we need to hear about ourselves.

# ASH WEDNESDAY - THE BEGINNING OF LENT

**There will be 2 Masses on Ash Wednesday (Feb 17)  
8:30am & 7:00pm.**

Again, **Ash Wednesday is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation.** (And, of course, Bishop Estévez has dispensed the diocese from the requirement to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.)



## **A SAME BUT DIFFERENT ASH WEDNESDAY IN 2021**

**The past year has been filled with different ways of living as well as worshipping. There are fewer people in church. No holy water in the font. Communion only in the hand. No coffee and doughnuts. Yet we still worship and pray.**

**Instead of giving ashes as a cross on the forehead – which has been deemed unsafe in this time of the COVID-19 pandemic -- we can still receive them by sprinkling on the top of the head (permitted by our ritual rules of the Church). We will look a little cleaner, yet we will still be called to repentance and conversion of heart. We will still bear ashes home to begin the disciplines of Lent, just not in the manner we have been used to over time.**

# LENT

A SEASON OF RENEWAL

When God drove our first parents from the Garden, he reminded Adam, “you are dust, and to dust you shall return” (Gn 3:19). We hear these words each year on Ash Wednesday, when the priest places ashes on our foreheads, a reminder of our mortality and the seriousness of the Lenten pilgrimage we are about to begin.

Ashes and dust amount to the same thing. Neither is particularly pleasant, and both remind us God used some pretty unattractive material when he created us. Lent reminds us how much Christ took on through the Incarnation and what he offered up to us on the cross.

The **40 days of Lent** offer us an opportunity to imitate what Jesus did in the desert for 40 days: He prayed and fasted in preparation for His public ministry. The Church asks the faithful to perform works of prayer, fasting and almsgiving during the Lenten season in imitation of Christ and for the good of our souls. This “spiritual spring training” makes us stronger if we embrace these practices with mindfulness and generosity.

If you haven’t gone to **confession** in a while, Lent is the perfect time to reconcile yourself with God and the Church. Most parishes have communal penance services with prayers and Scripture readings, followed by the opportunity for individual confession (a necessity for absolution of mortal sins). Or you can also make a private appointment with a priest.

**Preparation** for confession should include an examination of conscience, which means you think back on sins you have committed since your last confession.

What happens during confession depends on the priest and the person. Most people still start with the formula: “Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been (state the number of months or years) since my last confession.”

If you can’t remember the words or you don’t recall how long it’s been, don’t worry. Just tell the priest it’s been a long time, and he will guide you through the process.

What you will **experience is the healing gift of God’s love**, the chance to start over with a clean conscience, and an overwhelming sense of gratitude.

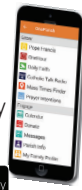

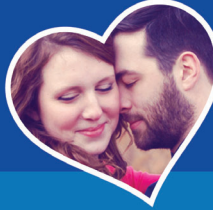
