HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC CHURCH FINANCIAL REPORT JULY THROUGH DECEMBER 2020

Dear Holy Spirit Family,

We are blessed with so many people who give generously of their time, talent and treasure. Many times, it is in quiet ways that go unnoticed. And that's just how they like it! It's good for us to say thank you when we see these quiet stewards at work.

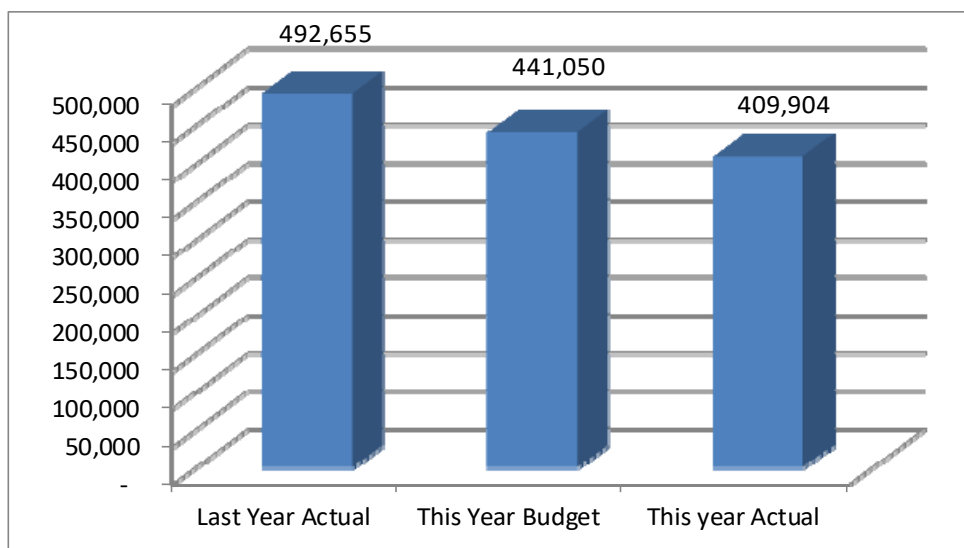
Thank you all who have been able to continue your financial support of Holy Spirit Parish. This unusual year has affected all of us. Our income for six months ending in December and what we predict for the current six months is startling but realistic. By the end of 2020 we were down 17%. This trend is continuing well into the rest of the year's budget. We realize the need to discover avenues to reduce costs as we head through the winter to spring.

With the help of Finance Council, I am happy to present you our Mid-term Financial Report for the past six months (July through December 2020).

CHURCH

INCOME

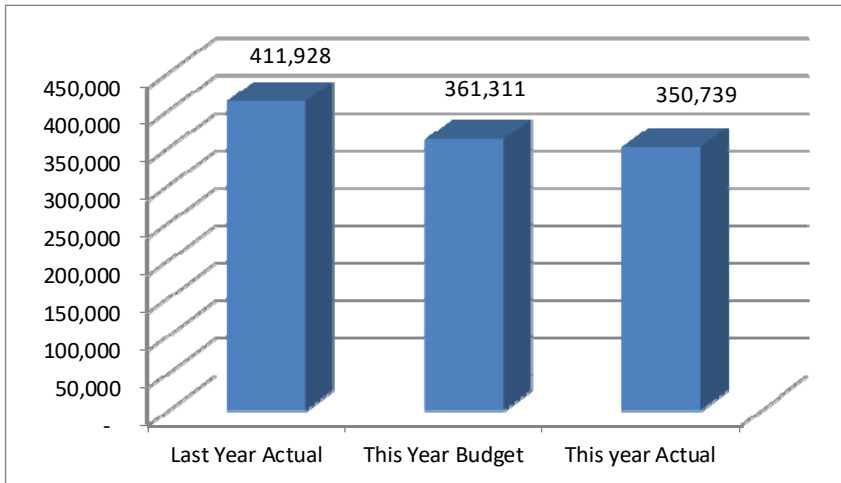
As I already mentioned, income for the church was substantially lower this six-month period when compared to both last year and to the budget. This was primarily due to the COVID-19 pandemic as both church attendance and collections were lower.



MID TERM FINANCIAL REPORT

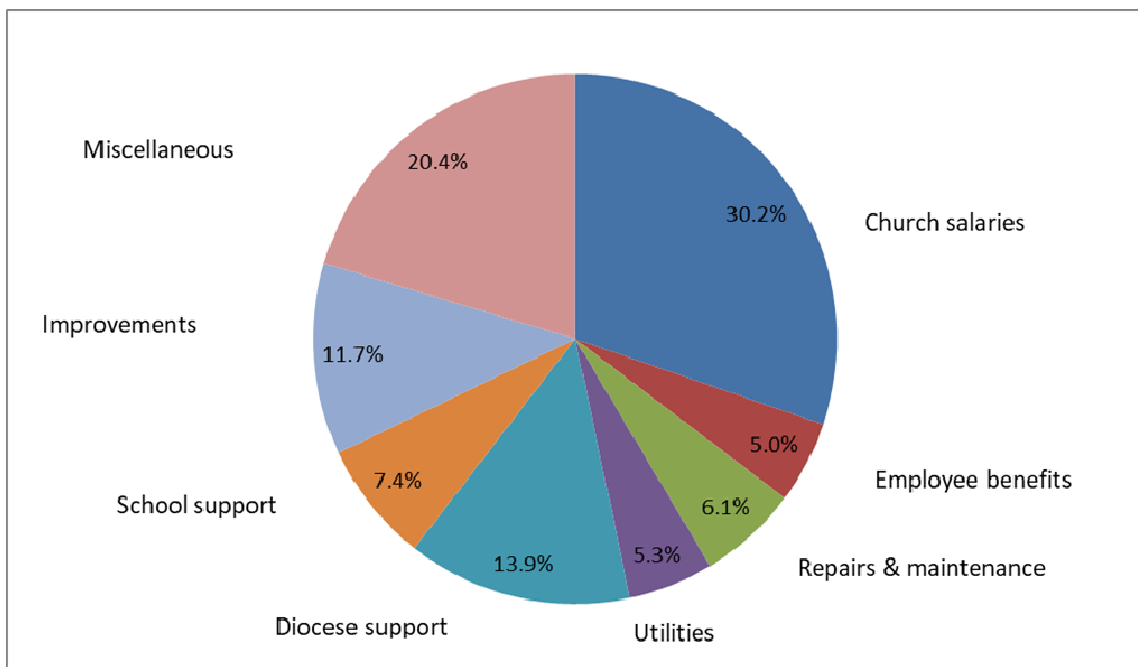
EXPENSE

Expenses for our Church were lower than last year and budget as we exercised fiscal control over our costs in line with the lower revenues.



Past experience shows that although income exceeds expense for the first six months of the fiscal year, the second six months typically has income lower than expense. Both the Church and school applied for and received grants under the Paycheck Protection Program from the government. This lowered the need for Church support of the school.

MID TERM FINANCIAL REPORT

IMPROVEMENTS

During this period, we replaced a large portion of the school roof and two school air conditioners and also renovated the restrooms in the Church. The audio/visual system we installed is a wonderful improvement as we needed to eliminate hymnals in the Church due to the pandemic. The cost of the audio/visual system was fully covered by private individual donations from parishioners.

FAMILY LIFE CENTER (FLC)

INCOME (Pledges received plus contributions)

This year-to-date budget.....	\$44,500
This year to date actual.....	\$60,509

EXPENSE

Expense for our FLC includes mortgage payments (principal and interest) of \$5,771 per month or \$69,252 annually. It also includes \$15,000 annual property insurance. All other costs are included in our Church expense.

We currently owe \$619,395 on the mortgage and have successfully refinanced the mortgage to lower the interest rate at no additional cost. While the three-year Capital Campaign will soon be over for most pledges, we still have the mortgage to pay so we encourage everyone to continue to support our FLC with your contributions.

The Finance Council and I will continue to monitor the situation and will do all we can to keep within our budget. Historically we know what to expect in the coming year/months. That has changed. We must plan prudently. I am satisfied that we have worked at reducing expenses and can maintain a balanced budget. My hope lies in our dependence and trust in God and His work here at Holy Spirit. With you, we can not only survive these days but thrive. As we try to look for new and effective ways to engage and enrich you, we trust in your support.

Please keep our parish in your prayers and may God bless each of you and your loved ones.

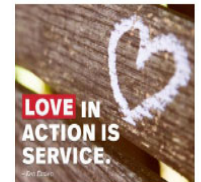

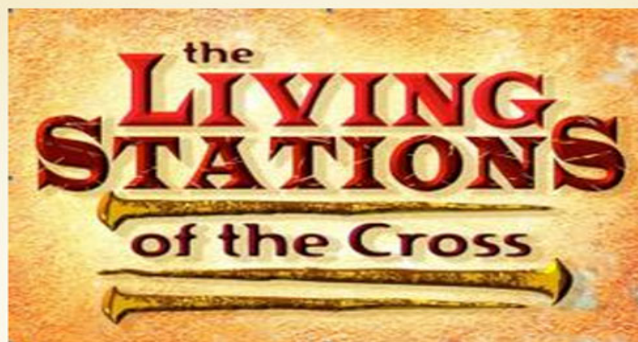

LENT

A SEASON OF RENEWAL

“The next day he took out two silver coins and gave them to the innkeeper with the instruction, ‘Take care of him. If you spend more than what I have given you, I shall repay you on my way back.’” — Luke 10:35

Our almsgiving has the power to transform the world. During Lent, CRS Rice Bowl invites you to reflect on some of the lives that are changed through Lenten almsgiving.

We all want to be “Good Samaritans.” When we see our sister or brother suffering, we are moved by compassion. We want to help. We are inspired to give.

Almsgiving is central to how we practice Lent. Almsgiving flows from prayer and fasting. We reflect on the needs of the world and how God is calling us to meet those needs through prayer. We make room for the needs of others—and for God’s Holy Spirit to work within us—through fasting. Through a recognition of the world’s needs and a personal commitment to act, we then give alms.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal) with NO eating between meals.

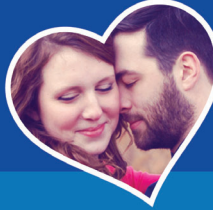
