


HOLY COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND



PALM SUNDAY: PASSION OF THE LORD

Today we begin the most sacred week of the Christian calendar.

We heard Isaiah's Servant Song proclaimed to us. The Servant represents the sufferings of the exiled community of ancient Israel in Babylon. In the midst of their suffering, the Servant speaks a word of hope to the community: "The Lord God is my help; therefore, I am not disgraced."

In Mark's account of the Passion, Jesus' last words from the Cross are the opening words of Psalm 22: "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me"? Jesus was identifying himself with the suffering people of every age. Jesus has taken upon himself the sufferings and sins of every person who will ever live.

In the midst of all his suffering, Jesus knew his Father's love.

Perhaps his last cry in a loud voice indicated that he was identifying himself with the last words of Psalm 22: "You, O Lord, be not far from me; O my help, hasten to aid me." Then Jesus breathed his last. We know that his Father heard the voice of his suffering Son – and has greatly exalted him.

Jesus wants each of us to know that he has shared in our sufferings – for he is our brother. He invites us to join our sufferings to His – for the salvation of the world.

Let us be with Jesus, our brother and Savior, during this Holy Week. We celebrate several important liturgies during this week. I would like to personally invite you to celebrate with me these very special liturgies of the year. And the schedule:

Wednesday, March 31 @ 11AM **Chrism Mass** at Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine. Due to COVID-19 safety precautions, this event is not open to the public. It will be live-streamed on the Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine's Facebook page.

Holy Thursday, April 1 @ 7:00pm – **Mass of the Lord's Supper** followed by Holy Hour of Adoration.

Good Friday, April 2 @ 1:30pm - **Divine Mercy Novena**, 2:00pm - **Living Stations**, 3:00pm – **Celebration of the Lord's Passion**.

Holy Saturday, April 3 @ 8:30 pm – **Easter Vigil**

Easter Sunday, April 4 @ 8:00am, 9:30am & 11:30am – **Easter Mass** with **Easter Egg Hunt** after the 11:30am Mass.

PALM SUNDAY

Jesus showed his love for us

WEEK OF MARCH 28

Note: The Passion Reading for Palm Sunday is very long, so you might want to read only the Procession reading (Mark 11:1-10).

REFLECTION:

When Jesus came to the city of Jerusalem, people treated him like a hero, waving palm branches and cheering. Just a few days later, many of those same people would turn against him and cry out for his death. They followed the crowd because they were afraid, instead of standing up for what they knew was right.

PRAYER:

Jesus, every time we fail to stand up for those who are treated unfairly, we are like the crowd in Jerusalem that turned their backs on you. Help us to have the courage to stand up for others and to always speak the truth. We ask this in your holy name. Amen.

ACTIVITY:

Jesus said that whatever we do for another person, we do for him. Who, in your community, needs someone to speak up for them or show support in other ways? Could it be a family who came to the U.S. from another country? Someone of a different religion? Someone who doesn't speak English?

Check out social service and faith-based agencies in our community and discuss as a family how you might be of support to one family or individual who could use your help.

Good Friday is a day of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal) with NO eating between meals.

AROUND OUR PARISH

PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING

In the past year, many changes have occurred not just in the world but in our parish family. The pandemic has changed the way we come together. Our pastor, Fr. Amar, and our pastoral staff has been very busy with the help of many people to reach parishioners in a variety of ways. Technology and social media has been utilized better. Masses continue to be live-streamed. As we began to open up, ministries met via Zoom. Now, there are combination meetings where some people meet in person (following the guidelines) with other people joining the meeting via Zoom. Fr. Amar is very busy reaching out to parishioners in various ways such as phone calls, home blessings, meeting outside, letter writing, reflections in the bulletin, offering resources on the website, adding an extra Mass on Sunday morning, sacraments and so much more all while being very aware and conscientious about keeping our parishioners safe from the virus.

Moving forward, some activities are planned for the coming months.

- Welcoming all who come to Mass and providing safe distance protocols within the parish buildings as well as having overflow seating in the FLC during Mass
- Effectively recruit new volunteers - we are in great need of ushers, greeters, and Eucharistic Ministers - current volunteers are willingly serving but they are few
- International Feast - Plans are underway for May 23rd at the soccer field behind the school - food, fun and fellowship to celebrate our annual feast.
- Respect Life Prayer Garden - An island in the parking lot is being transformed into a prayer garden in memory of Msgr. Heslin to honor our belief that all life is sacred from conception to death
- Multipurpose Shelter - In the area now enclosed by the white fence in front of the gym entrance, a shelter will be in place to serve our parish in many ways. Drive by food giveaways, cookouts and more activities
- Praying of the Rosary Saturday's at 10:00 am. via Zoom - prayer intentions for the youth
- Watch for 30 second videos on the website and before Masses
- Reach out to others - make a phone call - check on your neighbors - drop off a bulletin




Sustain, strengthen and protect all caregivers. Bless them as they offer compassionate care and show selfless courage in the face of risk.


