## FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

### THE GOOD SHEPHERD:

Today, we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday. As we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, we also celebrate Vocation Sunday and the Church is called to pray for more vocations to the priesthood. I request your prayers for me and for all the priests and seminarians that we will continue to serve you with the love of the Good Shepherd. And I pray for you too, that if God calls you, or calls your son to serve in the priesthood, you will make that sacrifice.

In the Gospel, Jesus is telling us about himself and his relationship with his disciples. "I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."

You and I know what a good shepherd Jesus is. He loves us so much that he willingly died on the cross for all his sheep down through the ages. All of his sheep are sinners and his loving death has freed us from our sins, and his resurrection has given us a share in his new life.

Jesus tells us more: "I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father." Because Jesus has loved us and called us to be his disciples, he has invited us into a special intimacy with him: the same intimacy he shares with his Father -- a divine intimacy.

How can anyone pass up that invitation?

The more we open ourselves and respond to Jesus' invitation, the more we realize how life changing our response is. And we are not alone. All disciples around us and in our world are making the same effort we are, allowing that divine intimacy to transform the way we live our daily lives. Our efforts support the working of grace in all.

The Eucharist we share nourishes our divine intimacy with Jesus and with one another. Our good shepherd gives us his body to eat and his blood to drink and he promises us eternal life.

As we allow the divine intimacy to grow within us, the words of St. John offer us encouragement. "Beloved: See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God...We are God's children now; what we shall be has not yet been revealed. We do know that when it is revealed we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is."

Let us keep our minds and hearts focused each day on the intimate invitation of Jesus and respond generously.

# FISCAL MID-YEAR REPORT



Society of St. Vincent DePaul, Inc. Holy Spirit Conference

## Fiscal Mid-Year Report

We thank our Pastor Fr. Amar, the Holy Spirit Parish Community, SVdP St. Paul's Conference, SVdP Santa Maria Del Mar Conference, Oceanside District Council, and St. Augustine Diocese Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul for all the support that we have received since our September 30, 2020 fiscal year-end report.

**In the last six months we have received a total of \$35,113.00:**

**\$7,313.00 in donations from the blue poor boxes at the church entrances.**

**\$6,800.00 from our St. Vincent DePaul Members.**

**\$21,000.00 from various St. Vincent de Paul Conferences and Councils.**

**With these donations, we were able to provided \$30,000.00 in assistance to families in our community as follows:**

Rental assistance:	<b>76 Families</b>	<b><u>\$23,063.00</u></b>
JEA payment:	<b>22 Families</b>	<b><u>\$5,579.00</u></b>
Other assistance:	<b>5 Families</b>	<b><u>\$1,358.00</u></b>

We provided **110** bags of food to the above families valued at **\$4,400.00**.

We partnered with the Knights of Columbus and other Holy Spirit Parishioners to distribute food for those in need. Over **25,000 pounds** of food donated by our Knights of Columbus, Farm Share and Feeding Northeast Florida valued at over **\$44,000.00** were distributed during this pandemic in the **Holy Spirit Church** sponsored food drives.

During the pandemic, we have been doing telephone interviews instead of visiting families in their homes. We listen and talk to our neighbors about their hardships and concerns. They are tired and we give them comfort, they are troubled and we assist them, they are hungry and we feed them, but most important we give them hope and faith in the Lord.


