FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK



FIRST WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

The Holy Father has announced the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly to be celebrated on July 25. Pope Francis has instituted the Church-wide celebration of World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly to honor and celebrate the contribution of grandparents and the elderly to our families and society. Starting this year, it will be held on the fourth Sunday of July, close to the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus.

This is to form awareness of how the elderly – all the elderly, including those who are not grandparents – need a family environment in which to live, and how it is necessary for families to become aware of the role being played by their older members. Pope said, “It is important for grandparents to meet their grandchildren and for grandchildren to meet their grandparents because — as the prophet Joel says — grandparents, before their grandchildren, will dream and have great desires, and young people — taking strength from their grandparents — will go forward and prophesy.”

Pope Francis has chosen the theme for this inaugural year: "I am with you always" (Mt. 28.20). The Holy Father is highlighting that promise of closeness that generations share with each other. Not only are our young people called to be present in the lives of older people, but so too grandparents and elders have a mission to encourage young people on their faith journey. Our little domestic churches are always enriched by the inclusion of grandparents and elders.

PRAYER FOR THE FIRST WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

I thank You, Lord,
for the comfort of Your presence:
even in times of loneliness,
You are my hope and my confidence,
You have been my rock and my fortress since my youth!

I thank You for having given me a family
and for having blessed me with a long life.
I thank You for moments of joy and difficulty,
for the dreams that have already come true in my life and for
those that are still ahead of me.
I thank You for this time of renewed fruitfulness to which
You call me.

Increase, O Lord, my faith,
make me a channel of your peace,
teach me to embrace those who suffer more than me,
to never stop dreaming
and to tell of your wonders to new generations.

Protect and guide Pope Francis and the Church,
that the light of the Gospel might reach the ends of the earth.
Send Your Spirit, O Lord, to renew the world,
that the storm of the pandemic might be calmed,
the poor consoled and wars ended.

Sustain me in weakness
and help me to live life to the full
in each moment that You give me,
in the certainty that you are with me every day,
even until the end of the age.

Amen.

And this celebration of the first World Day of Grandparents and Elderly is to be experienced as a moment of celebration involving all generations. It is not a matter simply of happiness, but of joy born from the knowledge that the Lord is close to the lives of the elderly as well as the young, for God is with us always.

This weekend, the Gospel reading comes from the beginning of the Bread of Life discourse, in which Jesus will reveal that he is the eternally nourishing bread of life (John 6:51). In the portion that we read today, Jesus crosses the sea (6:1), leads a crowd (6:2), and goes up onto a mountain (6:3) – actions that echo Moses' leadership of the people in Exodus. When the crowd is gathered, and Jesus “had given thanks” (eucharisteō), the bread and fish donated by a young boy become a nourishing meal for about five thousand people, with twelve baskets of leftovers. The baskets of leftovers suggest that this bread, broken and shared in thankfulness, continues to nourish the people even beyond the immediate moment.

In keeping with the theme of Grandparents Day, we are invited to reflect on how our grandparents' life experiences might shape our own. We can ask them, “what ‘bread’ of life experiences can you share with me?”

Holy Spirit School Financial Info 2020-21 School Year

The parish assisted the school with \$175,000 cash assistance. The school qualified for \$171,000 assistance from the federal Payroll Protection Plan. The approximate cost to educate a child at Holy Spirit School was \$6,200 per child and school parents paid \$5,300 in tuition and \$530 in other fees.

Synods and Synodality, part 2

The Role of the Synod of Bishops

In the words of Pope Francis, the Synod of Bishops is a body that, “manifests the solicitude of the College of Bishops for the needs of the People of God and for communion among the Churches.” The Synod is a means of gathering information on a particular theme from local Churches. The Synodal Assembly has a “consultative role, offering information and counsel to the Roman Pontiff on various ecclesial questions, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.” (Pope Francis using the words of Pope St. Paul VI). The Synodal Process, then, is to be a suitable instrument to give voice to the entire People of God.

Documents that govern a Synod

There are several documents which govern the workings of a Synod. The Apostolic Letter of Pope St. Paul VI, *Apostolica sollicitudo* (1965), is a general outline for future synods. *Ordo synodi episcoporum* (1966) contains the norms regarding how themes are chosen, organizational details as well as some very specific details for the gatherings themselves. This document is updated to reflect current structure or needs. The Code of Canon Law (1983) has a chapter dedicated to the Synod of Bishops. Most recently, Pope Francis issued *Apostolic constitutio episcopalis communio* (2018) which is the current governing document for Synods. The essential change that Pope Francis made to the previous documents is the inclusion of the entire People of God in both the consultation and implementation phases.

Types of Synod

There are three types of Synods of Bishops:

1. Ordinary General Assembly which is called to reflect on matters that pertain to the good of the universal Church. There have been 13 of these Assemblies called the last one being in 2018, Synod on Young People, Faith, and Vocational Discernment.
2. Extraordinary General Assembly which, like its name, means an exception to what is normally done. This assembly is called to reflect on matters of a more urgent nature.
3. Special Assembly which is called for a particular geographic region and not for the Church Universal. The Synod on the Pan-Amazon Region (2019) would be an example.

The Three Phases of a Synod

Every Synod primary has three phases. The first is a preparatory phase. Normally a preparatory document gathers information from Bishops, congregations of the consecrated, and from the Roman Curia. The second stage is the discussion phase wherein members, experts, auditors, and other people who have been invited attend meetings in Rome. The third phase is the implementation phase wherein the Holy Father, in conversation with the Bishops, create a commission or utilize a current commission to implement the work of the Synod. This is announced by way of an Apostolic Letter.



As the synod process continues in our diocese, more information will be provided the following weeks.


