



FINANCIAL REPORT


Dear Holy Spirit Parishioners,

I present our Annual Parish Financial Report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, with the hope of providing transparency concerning the stewardship of your sacrificial offerings. The principal source of the funds used to maintain our Parish is the sacrificial offerings of our Parishioners. It is critical, therefore, that all are aware of how your sacrificial offerings are used and the cost necessary to operate the Parish.

CHURCH


INCOME

Income for the church was lower this fiscal year when compared to the budget but was better than last year. Although church attendance was negatively impacted by the COVID virus, the generosity of our parishioners remained strong. We also received a grant from the government under the Payroll Protection Program.



EXPENSE


Expenses for our Church were lower than last year and budget as we exercised fiscal control over our costs in line with the lower revenues



The school also applied for and received a grant under the Paycheck Protection Program from the government. This lowered the need for Church support of the school.

FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2021

IMPROVEMENTS

During this fiscal year, we paid for the replacement of a large portion of the school roof, two school air conditioners and for the renovation of the restrooms in the Church. We also purchased a new lawn tractor. The audio/visual system we installed is a wonderful improvement as we needed to eliminate hymnals in the Church due to the pandemic. The cost of the audio/visual system was fully covered by private individual donations from parishioners.

FAMILY LIFE CENTER (FLC)

INCOME (Pledges received plus contributions)

EXPENSE

Expense for our FLC includes mortgage payments (principal and interest) of 5,771 per month or 69,252 annually. It also includes 15,000 annual property insurance. All other costs are included in our Church expense.

We currently owe 595,553 on the mortgage and have successfully refinanced the mortgage to lower the interest rate at no additional cost. While the three-year Capital Campaign has concluded, we still have the mortgage to pay so we encourage everyone to continue to support our FLC with your contributions.

The parish assisted the school with \$175,000 cash assistance. The school qualified for \$171,000 assistance from the federal Payroll Protection Plan. The approximate cost to educate a child at Holy Spirit School was \$6,200 per child and school parents paid \$5,300 in tuition and \$530 in other fees.


