





FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

DO WE RECOGNIZE WHO WE ARE WITH WHEN AT THE EUCHARISTIC TABLE?



Best wishes for a good start to the school year: Back to school time is usually a time of excitement, nerves, and new starts. As we continue to face the challenges of the pandemic, we want to recognize the challenges, changes, and decisions of this school year. We are praying for all decision-makers, parents, staff, teachers, students, and everyone involved in the education field.

We will start the new school year with greater hope and enthusiasm as we leave behind the pandemic. Education can conquer our fears and disposition of uncertainty as it provides us a vision of hope, peace, change and transformation. As Valiants we can overcome whatever barriers that come our way.

And let us remember that the Lord will always be with us in our journey. He has been with us during these trying and extraordinary times. He will certainly continue to guide and protect us as we move on with faith in our hearts. I am keeping all of you, students, parents, teachers, staff and administrators in my prayers.

All the best for a great 2021-2022 school year!

Who is sitting at the table with us? William Barclay, in his book on the Gospel of John, tells of two great and famous friends: T.E. Lawrence and Thomas Hardy. Lawrence served time in Britain's Royal Air Force as a lowly airman. He often visited the Hardys, and one day he happened to visit while in uniform. At the same time the Mayoress of Dorchester was also visiting the Hardys. The Mayoress took great offence at having to share her visit with a common soldier. And having no idea who the lowly airman was, openly resented his presence. Speaking in French to Mrs. Hardy, the lady arrogantly said that never had she had to "sit down to tea with a private soldier."


Lawrence, not one to sit idly by, responded to the Mayoress in perfect French: "I beg your pardon, Madame, but can I be of any use as an interpreter? Mrs. Hardy knows no French."

Do we recognize who we are with when at the Eucharistic table? We are with Jesus who gives himself to us.

In John 6: 41-51 Jesus says that He is the Bread of Life. In this passage John clearly borrows a language from the Eucharistic meal experienced by the early Christians. John wanted his community and Christians through the centuries to make the connection between the Bread of Life and Jesus Christ.

The murmuring of the Jews in this Gospel is the same as the grumbling of the Israelites in the desert just before God gave them manna to eat. God had given them the food they needed to continue journey.

Jesus repeats God's invitation made to the Jews in the Exodus and to Elijah in the Book of Kings. Jesus is drawing us to the Father as well, and in the language of the Eucharistic meal, the Gospel of John tells that the best food of all has been offered to us for our own journey. John hopes we recognize who is sitting at the table with us.

Holy Spirit School Financial Info 2020-21 School Year

The parish assisted the school with \$175,000 cash assistance. The school qualified for \$171,000 assistance from the federal Payroll Protection Plan. The approximate cost to educate a child at Holy Spirit School was \$6,200 per child and school parents paid \$5,300 in tuition and \$530 in other fees.
