
St. Augustine, Patron of Our Diocese

Feast Day on August 28

According to St. Augustine, we need not pray for what we need because God already knows what we need before we even ask. Instead, we ought to pray, he suggests, to increase our desire for God, and so that we might be able to receive what He is preparing to give us.

Here is St. Augustine's prayer
to the Holy Spirit:

Breathe in me O Holy
Spirit, that my thoughts
may all be holy.
Act in me O Holy Spirit,
that my work, too, may be
holy.
Draw my heart O Holy
Spirit, that I love but what
is holy.
Strengthen me O Holy
Spirit, to defend all that is holy.
Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit, that I always may be
holy. Amen.



FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

BELIEVE OR LEAVE?

During the past few Sundays, we have listened to Jesus speak of himself as the living bread come down from heaven. He has made it abundantly clear that we must eat his flesh and drink his blood, or we will not have life within us.

Today we hear the disciples respond to all that Jesus has said. Some find his words hard to believe and walk away from him. With a note of sadness, Jesus asks the Twelve: "Do you also want to leave?" We heard Peter speak for himself and the Twelve: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of everlasting life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." What a profound act of faith!

Peter responds from his experience of God in Jesus, as Joshua had done before him. It may have been difficult to understand what Jesus was saying to them, but Peter and the Twelve were convinced by what they had seen and heard that Jesus was the Holy One of God. They would put their faith and trust in him, knowing that they would eventually come to a better understanding of all that Jesus was telling them.

Jesus continues to ask his question. You and I have opportunities to respond. Each of us has experienced difficult moments in life that make Jesus' words hard to accept. Jesus repeats his question: "Do you also want to leave?"

The Church is enlivened or weakened by its members' choices. The greatest act of witness that you give this week is coming to Mass today. Your neighbors may not talk to you, but they know exactly where you go on Sunday. The greatest weakness of our time is that we have many grumblers in our faith. So many disciples are wavering in their faith. They have their own agendas rather than the Church's teaching and leadership.

We are gathering in the Church not just because we have nowhere else to go or nothing else to do. We come to Church to give a whole-hearted and enthusiastic affirmation to our faith. We are more like apostles that say there is nowhere else for us to be. We have already gone so far with you Lord that we know no other kind of life, nothing else or no other place is so safe and satisfying.


