EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

Preface and Acclamation

- Sanctus or Holy, Holy, Holy
- Angels and saints
- Is. 6: 2-3 and Rev. 4: 8



EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

Consecration

- Praise and thanksgiving
- Epiclesis



EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

Institution Narrative

- Remembrance or Memorial of the Last Supper or institution of the Eucharist
- Matthew, Mark, Luke, 1 Corinthians
- Elevation of Host and Chalice
- Mystery of Faith



EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

Prayer of Unity and Intercessions & the Doxology

- Pray for unity, the pope and the local bishop
- Pray for living and dead
- Intercession of the saints
- Trinitarian Doxology



COMMUNION RITE

- Our Father
- “Deliver us, O Lord from every evil...”

- “For the kingdom, the power...”

- Rite of Peace

- Exchange of Peace

COMMUNION RITE

- Fraction of the Host
- Lamb of God
Acts 2:42
- Prayer of Preparation

- “Lord, I am not worthy...”
