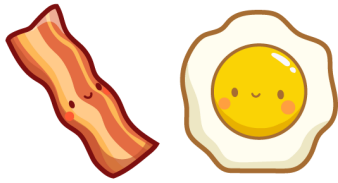

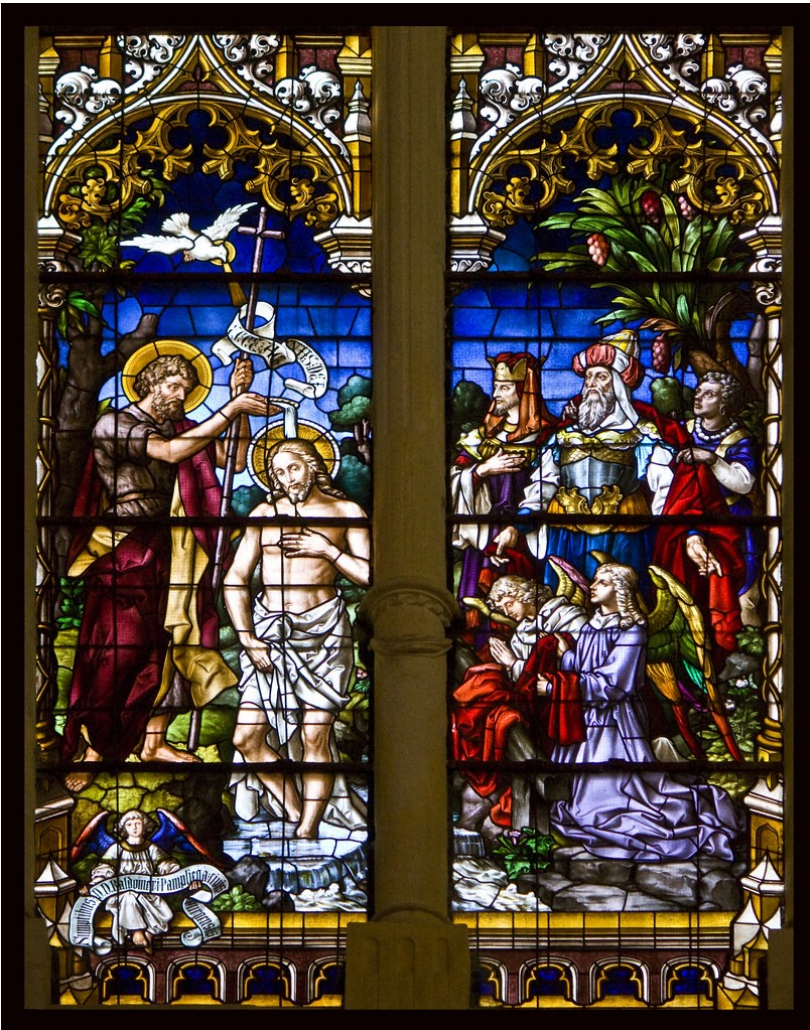

HIS PRESENCE IS ALWAYS WITH US!

Today we celebrate the Baptism of Jesus, which marks the beginning of his ministry. Jesus' cousin, John the Baptist, has just said that his baptism with water will be followed by one mightier than he whose sandals he is not worthy to untie. Jesus will baptize with the Holy Spirit and with fire. This scene is followed immediately by Jesus' coming to John and asking for John's baptism by water. Interesting.



Although he was like us in all things but sin, Jesus humbled himself and chose to do what his fellow Jews who were sinners were doing. Jesus had John baptize him in order to identify completely with us. What an awesome example of humility!

He identified with those he came to be with. He associated with all; he ate with all. It was a hallmark of Jesus' life that he would be present to anyone who sought his presence. During Christmas season, we celebrated God's presence with us as a child. As we end Christmas season today, with the feast of Baptism of the Lord, we are reminded that Jesus is present in our lives as a baptized adult.

Here is an adult Jesus who is absolutely faithful in love, who knows the pain of a broken world, whose great desire is to lift up the down-hearted, to rescue those who wander in darkness, to bring the fullness of life to everyone and to save the world.

His presence is always with us. Do we recognize it?

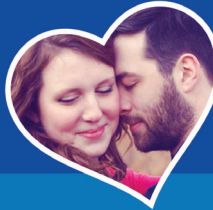
