


## ANNUAL ORANGE TICKET RAFFLE

# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

## SHARING THE DIVINE LIFE?

The Lord challenges us: "Love your enemies, do good to those who dislike you, bless those who speak ill of you and pray for those who mistreat you." "Be merciful just as your heavenly Father is merciful."


We all know how difficult this is to do. We'll never be able to do it without God's grace, without learning to be very conscious that God is present with us each day, without asking God for the strength of his grace many times each day. The invitation of Jesus to love those who get in our face, who know how to push all our buttons, goes against our natural feelings of irritation and anger. Jesus seems to be asking too much.

What Jesus is asking of us is to be all that grace enables us to be. By our baptism, we have been given a share in the life and love of God. By grace, we are children of our heavenly Father. Divine life is in us, and that life enables us to live as Jesus lived. Jesus is asking us to learn to live by the new life we have been given.

St. Francis de Sales recommends several practices that can help us remember the strength of divine life within us.

Begin the day with a short prayer of awareness: "My God, you are here loving me today; help me to remember you're with me as we go through the day." Then, talk with God about the grace I will need to deal with particular people in my life who can irritate me or have mistreated me. During the day, when I know I'm going to meet such a person, I ask God's help that I may relate with that person in a way that is pleasing to God. Then, each evening, thank God for the times when grace gave me strength and ask pardon for the times, I forgot to ask for God's help and failed because I tried to do it on my own.

The key is learning the discipline of remembering that I share divine life. When my prayer leads me to greater awareness of God's loving presence each day, then I will more likely become dependent on the grace God makes available to me. Then the challenge that Jesus offers – to love my enemies – is not so impossible for me to try to meet. I can meet it because I trust in God who lives in me.

## Scholarships for Florida School children

Step Up For Students believes that every child deserves the chance to succeed. Through the administration of several scholarship programs, Step Up For Students empowers parents to pursue and engage in the most appropriate learning options for their children. With the help of a Step Up For Students scholarship, you could send your child to a Catholic school near you.



### SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program give parents the ability to choose a school that best meets their children's needs by providing a scholarship to attend an eligible private school.

#### Who is eligible?

Students in grades K-12 who meet one or more of the following:

- Financial need: Eligibility is determined by household income. For example, a family of four could have an income of nearly \$100,000 annually to qualify.
- Dependent children of a reservist or an active-duty member of the United States Armed Forces
- Children currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Siblings of students participating in the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities

#### What is available?

- A scholarship worth roughly \$7,000 to cover the cost of private school tuition, books, registration, testing and more.

### SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS WITH UNIQUE ABILITIES

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) allows parents of students with unique abilities to personalize the education of their children by directing scholarship dollars toward a combination of programs and services offered by approved providers.

#### Who is eligible?

- Students 3 years old to high-school graduation or age 22 (whichever comes first)
- Children with one of 22 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities

#### What is available?

- A scholarship worth, on average, \$10,400 to cover the cost of private school tuition, instructional materials, home education, tutoring and more.



## Common Questions about Giving 2022 Bishop's Annual Stewardship Appeal

- If I make a check out to my parish or place my gift in the collection basket at a weekly Mass, will my pledge be credited?  
Your gift will be processed more quickly if mailed directly to the Diocese each month. All checks must be made out to BASA (Bishop's Annual Stewardship Appeal) to be credited to your parish's participation goal.
- Can I give stocks or securities to make my gift?  
Yes, please contact the diocesan Fiscal Office at (904) 262-3200 to make arrangements and to fill out a letter of intention for donating stocks or securities.
- Can I give a gift from my IRA or donor advised fund?  
Yes, please provide the funding agent with the diocesan mailing address (11625 Old St. Augustine Road, Jacksonville, FL 32258) and have them indicate BASA 2022 on the check or letter accompanying your gift.
- Will I receive a pledge reminder?  
Yes, everyone who makes a pledge will receive a monthly reminder that will include the total pledge, total paid, and remaining balance, by mail. For those gifting by credit card and ACH debits, they will receive gift payment receipts via email.
- When will I receive a letter for income tax purposes?  
All donors of eligible gifts of \$200 or more will automatically receive tax documentation of BASA gifts in January of the following year. For gifts under \$200, donors can request tax documentation at any time.
